16-115, HAR, & Chapter 464, HRS:

Section 16-115-24(b), amending language, "; or if applicable, be currently designated as a model law structural engineer;".

The Committee had a lengthy discussion on electronic signatures as proposed in section 16-115-9(e) and stamping of plans as proposed in section 16-115-9(c)(3). As proposed in section 16-115-9(c)(3), only one original set of plans is required to have every sheet stamped and contain the original signature or have a digital signature. Ms. Sakata stated that it may not be feasible to have a digital signature on every sheet as the process to place a

digital signature may be burdensome. The Committee also discussed whether only the title page should contain the stamp and original signature or digital signature.
