## Legislation: a. <u>House Bill No. 1072, H.D. 1 Relating to Prescriptive Authority for</u> Certain Psychologists

Executive Officer Ferrer reported that Dr. Jill Oliveira Gray met with Representative Nakashima's office and that Ms. Oliveira Gray stated that there were no substantive changes.

After discussion, it was determined that the following changes be made to the revised draft:

On page 7, lines 14 – 16 shall read as follows:

""Primary care provider" means a physician or osteopathic physician licensed in Hawaii pursuant to section 453-2, or an advanced practice registered nurse with prescriptive authority pursuant to section 457-8.6."

On page 9 lines 5 – 6 shall read as follows:

"that is <u>designated</u> by the American Psychological Association's Committee on <u>Designation</u> or the"

		On page 13 lines 17 - 18 shall read as follows
		"§465-F Prescriptive authority privilege; exclusionary formulary. (a) A prescribing psychologist shall <u>not</u> prescribe"
		Executive Officer Ferrer will contact Dr. Oliveira Gray of the Board's previous determination:
		The Board requested that the verbiage from the previous version of the draft be used. Language to section <b>465-F Prescriptive</b> <b>authority privilege; exclusionary formulary</b> to reflect the correct use of "exclusionary formulary."
		The Board noted that the use of "exclusionary formulary" in the current draft is incorrect. The exclusionary formula is a list of <b>prohibited</b> drugs. Page 14, lines 3 – 10 states that, "The exclusionary formula shall not include narcotic drugs, opiates, or any drug classified into schedule I, II, or III pursuant to chapter 329; provided that the exclusionary formulary may include stimulants for the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder regardless of the stimulants classification."
