Old Business: Collaborative Agreement

The Chair asked Ms. Keefe, who will be attending the NABP 110th Annual Meeting in Phoenix, Arizona, May 17-20, 2014 to find out what NABP is doing with the Drug Quality and Security Act regarding compounding. He stated an MOU was

written a long time ago but it was never activated. One of the things the

Committee has to work on besides collaborative agreements is the miscellaneous

permit and information on the MOU will help the Committee carve out the permit categories.

The EO stated there was a bill this past legislative session to regulate Durable Medical Equipment (DME) providers. It was first going to the Department of Health, but they didn't want. Unbeknownst to the EO, the DCCA was then asked to take it but said they didn't want it. Right now DME providers on the mainland cannot ship to Hawaii residents without an out-of-state pharmacy permit, however DME providers in State do not require licensure at all. So that is another disparity in the laws and rules that needs to be addressed. The EO will do research on the DME bill that was introduced this past session and provide information to the Committee.

The Chair stated he will work on language to make statutory changes to the miscellaneous permits section.

The EO stated she will work on getting information from the Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy University of Hawaii @ Hilo, pharmacy students regarding collaborative agreements, definitions, language, and samples of collaborative agreements.
