It was moved by Vice Chairperson Yabuta, seconded by Mr. Chang and unanimously carried to approve the above application subject to meeting all licensing requirements. The Executive Officer informed Mr. Armstrong that the licensing branch will send more information for the licensing phase such as the appropriate fees and bond requirements.

Executive Officer's
Report:

a. Guard Employee Registration Statistics

Total applications received as of 9/9/13	8,572
Total licensed	6,567

Chairperson Inouye recognized and thanked the Application Review Committee members Ray Galas and Kenneth Chang for reviewing the applications.

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the department is currently working with Fieldprint, the Criminal Justice Data Center and the Hawaii Information Consortium to offer online application for guard employees. This system will allow applicants with no background check matches to be licensed faster. The new system requires 3 indicators to positively identify the fingerprints of the applicant such as social security number, date of birth and name. The Executive Officer asked Deputy Attorney General Tam if the online application can include date of birth information since the current application does not require this information. Deputy Attorney General Tam responded that the department can require date of birth information online because the possibility of a criminal record overrides the privacy issue.

b. Updated Examination Reference Material

The Executive Officer informed the Board that the following three references listed for the private detective exam are out-of-print. Two of the three have newer editions and the other can be found online.

The Process of Investigation, 2nd Edition Charles A. Sennewald and John K. Tsukayama Butterworth-Heinemann, 2001 (3rd edition is okay as study material.)

Security Investigations, A Professional's Guide Larry G. Nicholson PH.D. Butterworth-Heinemann, 2000 (No new edition but book can be purchased online.)

Introduction to Security, 7th Edition Robert J. Fischer and Gion Green Butterworth-Heinemann, 2004 (9th edition is okay as study material.)

The Exam Branch recommends that the exams be updated as soon as possible with updated and relevant references. The Executive Officer asked licensee members to provide recommended references which are available and which will be used to update board examinations.

Act 208 (SLH 2010)
and Any Matters
Relating to its
Implementation:

a. Curriculum Review Committee

1) American Guard Services, Inc.

The Board reviewed the amended curricula submitted by American Guard Services, Inc. and it was moved by Vice Chairperson Yabuta, seconded by Mr. Chang and unanimously carried to approve the American Guard Services, Inc. curriculum.

b. Ad Hoc Committee Report

- 1) The Executive Officer informed the Board that Senator Baker is contemplating legislation to remove the sunset date for HRS Chapter 463-10.5 and the annual four hours of classroom instruction (continuing education) for the first renewal period of June 30, 2014. She is also not opposed to repealing the CE requirement provided employers conduct the annual four hours of continuing education. Senator Baker wants to require random audits to ensure that employers are conducting continuing education classroom instruction. The Executive Officer added that for random audits the computer randomly selects license numbers and licensees are sent letters asking for verification of continuing education.

Mr. Chang stated that there may be companies who after meeting the registration requirements, will be hard pressed to meet the CE requirements for 2014 and who will be unable to keep up with the continuing education requirement. He concurs that the continuing education requirement should be dropped from the first renewal cycle. Deputy Attorney General Tam added that perhaps two hours of continuing education instruction per year would be fair as compared to four hours of continuing education instruction per year.

Senator Baker will not consider removing background checks from the registration requirements. She felt that this is the integral piece of the legislation. It was also not Senator Baker's intent that after July 1, 2013 guard employee applicants who had not received their guard cards, not be able to work. Thus she did concur with the Board's position in dealing with the backlog.

- 2) Barbara Krieg's email from the Department of Human Resources Development ("DHRD") regarding draft proposal to amend HRS 463-10.5 – Guard registration

The Board reviewed Barbara Krieg's email regarding 1) exemption for public employees from the classroom training requirements and 2) extension of the length of time for valid registration for such employees as presented in the following proposed revisions:

SECTION 1. Chapter 463-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

"(h) The following exceptions to the guard registration requirements shall apply to State and county public employees acting in a guard capacity.

- (1) State and county public employees shall not be required to complete the eight-hour and four-hour classroom instruction specified above, provided that the employer submits certification to the Board of Private Detectives and Guards that the employer provides training to its employees that is comparable to, or exceeds the curriculum requirements specified in this chapter and in the board's rules;
- (2) State and county employees shall be required to renew their guard registration once every six years."

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Deputy Attorney General Tam stated that the state agency can submit their training curricula to the Board for approval. Mr. Chang stated that the state employees should go through the same training and minimum requirements of Act 208, SLH 2010.

After further discussion it was moved by Vice Chairperson Yabuta, seconded by Mr. Chang, and unanimously carried to oppose the draft proposal to amend HRS 463-10.5 for the following reasons:

- The eight (8) hour mandatory training covers topics that all persons acting in a guard capacity should know. The topics are general and are applicable to all types of guard employees (i.e., private, retail, hospital, hotel, etc.). Act 208's training requirements are the minimum that guard employees must obtain and employers are free to impose additional training requirements on their employees.
- The four (4) hours of continuing education required may be repealed in future legislation.
- Any employer may currently provide the Board its curriculum for review and determination that their curriculum meets or exceeds the Board's curriculum. The State and County employers may currently do this.
- It would be an administratively difficult to have different renewal dates for the same class of registrants. The

registration scheme under Act 208 does not tie an applicant to a particular employer. The Board does not ask an applicant for information on the applicant's employer because the registration is issued to an applicant in his or her individual capacity. Applicants and registrants are free to move from employer to employer, and the Board does not (and cannot) track each applicant's employer(s). The registrations are therefore "portable". Establishing different renewal dates dependent upon the applicant's employer will pose major licensing hurdles.

3) Memo to the Board from Spike Denis

At its August 15, 2013 Board meeting the Board asked Mr. Denis to provide the Board documentation of agency staff shortages, single guard as opposed to multiple guard service. Mr. Denis informed the Board that he sent 4 questions to 10 principal licensees that represent approximately 90% of the licensed guard industry. The results below are from approximately 66% of the contract security agencies.

Q1: Approximately how many guard sites are there?

A1: 770

Q2: Of these sites, how many are staffed with only one security guard at a time?

A2: 550

Q3: How many are staffed with an experienced/registered guard who might supervise a trainee?

A3: 282

Q4: What are your current financial consequences due to lack of speedy registration process?

A4: The data set revealed that unbillable overtime (losses) has increased by an average range of 75% to 420% weekly for the period mid-July through August 2013 over 2012. This amounts to approximately \$40,000 per week net losses for the data set. The industry's previous report that requested regulatory relief, the projected weekly losses due to lack of processing resources were only projected at \$17,000 per week for those companies with unbillable overtime.

Mr. Denis commented that he did not ask if anyone was on the verge of bankruptcy.

Mr. Denis added that although registration applications from early to mid-July are now appearing on the PVL website, the industry continues to suffer from the lack of registered employees until the board can apply resources which have been allocated to process registrations. The inability to provide highly profitable temporary guard services with only 24 to 72 hours notice because the industry simply does not have registered personnel and the delay or deferral necessary to meet client demands for new long-term contracts with less than 90-day notification in general is compounding the unbillable overtime.

Mr. Denis asked the Board about the status of the hiring and training of the two clerk positions that have been approved. The Executive Officer responded that the temporary positions have been offered to employees within the State first and the Licensing branch is currently waiting for the list from the Department of Human Resources and Development ("DHRD"). There has been no word yet from DHRD. Vice Chairperson Yabuta asked about emergency hire. The Executive Officer responded that emergency hire is not possible because the position is available to civil service employees first and then outside if no response from within.

Mr. Denis asked the Board "What are the impediments and factors that have caused the delay in being able to bring additional resources on line?" The Executive Officer informed the Board that the industry's concern was expressed to Senator Baker and Senator Baker was also informed that the delay in processing time is mainly due to the 40 -50% of the background checks that need additional review. 20% of the background checks have convictions that require Board review. Mr. Denis asked if the criminal list can be published because the only solution seems to be more scrutiny by the employer prior to registration. The Executive Officer responded that the industry cannot rely on the list because there are other deficiencies that also delay the application review process. Such as no high school verification, one check for multiple applications, no residence address and no statements and documentation for "yes" answers to application questions number 4 and 5.

Robin Medeiros from Star Protection Agency stated that his company is in dire straits. He is paying double overtime and his guards are working 70 hour weeks as he is trying to honor his existing contracts. He is currently losing \$14,000 a month and will not consider any contracts beyond 90 days.

Mr. Burgwinkel from G4S Secure Solutions added that he currently has \$14,000 per week of non-billable overtime hours and he is not extending his government contracts. His future obligations are the Sony Open which requires 80 plus guards and the NFL Pro Bowl requires 200 plus guards. The smaller local companies will probably go out of business.

Mr. Denis stated that the only solution seems to be more checks by the employer to ensure that the guard registration applications are complete.

The Executive Officer said she will work on a notice as to how employers can screen guard registration applications to help expedite the application process. The memo will include the following items:

- 1) Make certain all required documents are submitted (training certificate, verification of high school or equivalency).
- 2) If an employee answers "Yes" to questions 3, 4, or 5 of the application, insure the employee submits all of the documentation required on pages 2 and 3 of the "Requirements & Instructions – Guard Registration".
- 3) Employees should be told to answer "Yes" if they have any criminal convictions. If any conviction is revealed, a deficiency or deferral will be sent requesting the required documentation and statements if not originally submitted. Sending deficiencies, awaiting documentation to clear the deficiency, and Board review may add approximately 4 weeks to the process.
- 4) If the high school educational documentation is in question, use the "Statement of Educational Background" form. Remember it must verify at least 4 years of work experience. If an employee has only worked with you for 2 years, the applicant must obtain as many statements from former employers needed to verify at least 4 years. The forms must be signed and notarized.

- 5) Fees for the guard registration is \$73.00. If your company is submitting fees for your employees, use separate checks. Using a single check for multiple employees may result in delays if one applicant does not "clear" the review.

The Executive Officer also asked for suggestions as to how to get the notice to the unregulated industry. Mr. Denis responded that the information can be distributed through the Ad Hoc Committee and property management companies but the notice has to be sent to the bars and restaurants also. Mr. Denis stated that the restaurant association has misinformation regarding guard employees because they are not in the security industry and suggested the notice be sent to the Hawaii Hotel Association.

Deputy Attorney General Tam informed the guests that Senator Baker was given the industry proposal allowing applicants to continue working even if they submitted their applications after July 1, 2013. Senator Baker said that was not the intent of the legislation.

The Executive Officer added that when the State receives the FBI reports, some of the information received is incomplete and limited. Even if there are no convictions, the Board must ask for the outcome of the arrests.

Vice Chairperson Yabuta opined that the Board along with the industry needs to find resolve because if there are no guards available, the situation will affect the police departments.

Industry members asked whether they could meet with the Director of DCCA to discuss the delays in bringing additional resources to address the backlog. The Executive Officer advised them that they are welcome to schedule an appointment with the Director. Mr. Denis thanked the Board and indicated that the industry members intend to discuss the matter with the Director.
