**Ralph S. Inouye Co. Ltd. ("RSI")** – RSI requests a determination on whether they, licensed in the "A" General Engineering and "B" General Building classifications, may bid as the prime contractor for a project which consists of nine rail stations, and have two or three "B" General Building contractors as subs. Each "B" sub will be responsible for construction of two or three of the nine rail stations under RSI as the prime.

RSI's questions are as follows:

- (1) May the prime contractor hire a sub-general possessing a "B" General Contracting license to construct complete, the stations for which it has

been assigned responsibility to complete, provided said sub-general hires subcontractors for specialty work it does not possess on their own or automatically under HAR section 16-77-32?

- (2) In doing so, may the sub-general directly engage and subcontract with any specialty subcontractor to complete the portions of the work of the stations under its responsibility even if it does not possess those specialty licenses either automatically or on its own?

Recommendation: The answer is “yes” to both questions above.

**City and County of Honolulu (“C&C”)** – The C&C requests a determination whether a C-44 Sheet metal contractor license is required to install louvers which are factory made with coating and weep holes in one frame.

The Board recommended that the “B” General Building, C-5 Cabinet, millwork, and carpentry remodeling and repairs, and C-44 Sheet metal contractors can perform this work.

Mr. Dwayne Arelliano of the Glaziers Local 1889 stated that they have been installing this type of louvers in some of the buildings in town; and therefore, felt the C-22 contractors can also install this type of louvers. A manufacturer makes these for the glaziers to install. He feels that the metal louvers are like a window. Metal жалусies and louvers are the same, except that one is fixed and one is not, and each has different uses such as security and ventilation.

After further review of the specifications, Chairperson Lau stated that according to the specifications, the louvers are under Division 8, “Doors and Windows”, and they appear to be architectural openings that are similar to windows. Therefore, he felt the C-22 contractors could also perform this work. Chairperson Lau commented that the Board looks at each scope inquiry on a case-by-case basis and reviews the specifications if provided, and sometimes more than one trade or contractor in the industry can perform a particular project.

Mr. Suehiro stated that he was not present at the June 9, 2014, Applications Committee meeting.

Ryan Takahashi of HEMEP stated that after review of the applicant list, he wanted to present information on an applicant, specifically Brandon Kajihiro applying as RME for Circuit Builders in the C-13 Electrical and C-63 High voltage electrical classifications.

Chairperson Lau recused himself from discussion as he is the owner of Circuit Builders.

Mr. Takahashi stated that Mr. Kajihiro is an apprentice in the IBEW training program and is not licensed as an EJ; therefore, this seems to conflict with the requirements for a contractor license applicant to have supervisory experience.

Robert Aquino of the Hawaii Electricians Training Fund ("HETF") stated that Mr. Kajihiro was an indentured apprentice in the program since 2004, completed the minimum program requirement of 10,000 hours in 2010, but did not complete the program as a licensed electrician.

Executive Officer Tamanaha stated that under the Board of Electricians and Plumbers, the EJs need to verify 5 years and 10,000 hours to become a licensed EJ. However, the completion of apprenticeship training or a license as an EJ is not a requirement to obtain a contractor's license.

Terry Ihara of HETF stated to be classed as a journeyman electrician, they need to complete 800 hours of education and 10,000 hours of in the field training.

DAG Tam stated that the Board considers the experience certificates of the applicant, and his apprentice status in a training program is not relevant. Mr. Aquino stated that the applicant is registered as an apprentice in the HETF program.
