Discussion on Amendments The Committee reviewed and approved the Rules Committee minutes of October 10, 2013.

To Chapter 16-115, HAR, & Chapter 464, HRS:

The Committee reviewed and discussed the draft prepared by Mr. Kobashigawa relating to sections 16-115-58, 16-115-59, 16-115-89, 16-115-94, and 16-115-96, HAR. In regards to section 16-115-58, HAR, the Committee recommended changing the teaching load from 20 to 18 semester hours per year and from 30 to 39 quarter hours per year for lawful experience credit for third, fourth, fifth year or higher courses. The hours are more reflective of the current teaching loads.

In regards to section 16-115-59, HAR, the draft reflects deletion of the specific IDP requirements as they are no longer current and there will be changes in the future. Therefore, the section would require fulfilling the NCARB IDP requirements without specifying the individual training requirements.

For sections 16-115-89 and 16-115-96, HAR, the Committee recommended landscape architect examination applicants be able to register directly to CLARB to take the L.A.R.E. and establish a CLARB record.
