Minutes of Previous

Minutes of the November 21, 2013 Meeting

Meeting:

It was moved by Ms. Berkey, seconded by Mr. Tetsutani, and unanimously

carried to approve the minutes as circulated.

<u>Chair's Report</u>: The Chair reported that he had appeared before the legislature regarding

the motor vehicle mechanic certification program, and answered

questions asked by the legislators.

Executive Officer's

Report: None.

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Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters: Chairperson Chow called for a recess from the meeting at 1:38 p.m. to deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") chapter 91.

In the Matter of the Motor Vehicle Mechanic's License of CHRIS N. SOUTHICHACK, Respondent; ARP 2010-72-L - Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order, and Petition for Disciplinary Action Against Motor Vehicle Mechanic's License

It was moved by Ms. Weite, seconded by Mr. Sasuga, and unanimously carried to approve the settlement agreement, in which:

- 1. Respondent admits that he violated:
  - (a) HRS §437B-11(6) failure to comply with this chapter to it; to wit: HAR §16-87-11(e) - registration of motor vehicle repair dealer shall be limited to the specialties or areas of certification in which the dealer and the dealer's full-time employees, or both, have been registered or certified as mechanics by the board;
  - (b) HRS §437B-11(6) failure to comply with this chapter or rules adopted pursuant to it; to wit: HRS §437B-11 – no motor vehicle mechanic shall engage in the repair of motor vehicles unless that person is also licensed as a motor vehicle repair dealer or unless that person is in the employ of a motor vehicle repair dealer; and
  - (c) HRS §437B-15 failure to give written estimate for a job prior to commencement of the job, unless waived in writing by customer.
- 2. Respondent agrees that this settlement agreement is intended to resolve the issues raised in RICO's investigation in ARP 2010-72-L.
- 3. Respondent enters into this settlement agreement as a compromise of the claims and to avoid the expense of a hearing.

#### 4. Terms of Settlement

- Respondent agrees to pay a fine in the amount of TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$2,000.00).
- If Respondent fails to fully and timely comply with the terms of this settlement agreement, Respondent's license shall be automatically revoked upon RICO's filing of an affidavit with the Board attesting to such failure. In case of such revocation, Respondent understands that Respondent cannot apply for a new license until the expiration of at least five (5) years after the effective date of the revocation. Respondent understand that if

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> Respondent desires to become licensed again, Respondent must apply to the Board for a new license pursuant to and subject to HRS §§92-17, 436B-21, and all other applicable laws and rules in effect at the time.

#### Licensing: Ratifications

The Board members reviewed the ratification lists for motor vehicle repair dealer and motor vehicle mechanic licenses. Upon a motion by Mr. Sasuga, seconded by Ms. Berkey, it was unanimously carried to ratify the lists (attached).

At 1:50 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Tetsutani, seconded by Ms. Weite, and unanimously carried to enter into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to the individual applying for licensure in accordance with Chapter 92-5(a) (1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with Chapter 92-5(a) (4), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

#### New Business: 2014 Legislative Session

The Executive Officer reported that the administration bill, H.B. 2273, regarding the motor vehicle mechanic certification program was heard by the House committees on Transportation and Consumer Protection and Commerce, crossed over to Senate and was also heard by the Senate committees on Higher Education and Commerce and Consumer Protection where technical and non-substantive amendments were made (S.B. 2273, S.D. 1). It will then be heard by the Senate Ways and Means Committee.

The Executive Officer further reported that Mr. Nakamura's name had been submitted for reappointment to the Board and is awaiting Senate confirmation.
