## Old Business:

Next

a. Proposed Rule Revisions, HAR Title 16, Chap. 72 Subchapters 1-11

Dr. Tsuchiyama stated that she wanted to tighten the schedule to finalize the rules. The Board began with the third subchapter intending to go back to the definitions in Subchapter 2 as time permits.

Listed below are highlights that were discussed:

- Adding language to further clarify the definition of authorized practice of acupuncture.
- Discussion on embedded needle procedures. Will check if this is based on the integration of biomedical sciences.
- Details on how records are to be kept and stored. Records to be kept on file for at least five years.
- A lengthy discussion on whether to state the minimum formal education and training hours or leave it open to follow Accreditation Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine ("ACAOM") minimum requirements. Need to confirm if ACAOM breaks out herbal medicine credit hours.
- Take out language referencing the use of Ph.D.
- Adding language to note that a request for reissuance of an acupuncture intern permit shall be submitted no less than 45 days prior to its expiration.
- Discussion whether the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine ("NCCAOM") exam should be taken in English only or allow for other languages.
