b. Email Correspondence- Frank Commendador (Jan-Guard Hawaii Inc)

Frank Commendador Principal Guard and Danielle Vierra General Manager of Hawaii of Jan Guard came in wanting to discuss their concern with the amount of time it takes to process Guard card applications. Mr. Commendador mentioned that there is an excess amount of over-time because the demand for guards is extremely high. Therefore, they want to be able to employ more people, more quickly. He suggested if there was a way to pay for an employee to process all the applications.

The EO stated that unfortunately because of the Ethics issue he is unable to pay for a state position. It is not even a thought we can entertain because it is the law. We are a State agency, therefore we cannot receive payment from an outside source for work.

Although the lead time is 4-5 days, when there are deficiencies it can delay the process. This is the only Board with that type of processing time.

Chief Perry recognized the struggle of finding employees, however, recommended Mr. Commendador look for alternatives to keep employees invested in their company to minimize the turn-over rate.

Mr. Chang also commented that many times employees do not disclose that they have criminal histories or psychological disorders. Sometimes, employees can't remember their last conviction so they are surprised when their report comes up with a match. These all add to the length of the processing time.

The Board thanked Mr. Commendador and Ms. Vierra for coming down and sharing their passion for the industry and making it more efficient.

b. Changes in Procedures and the Implementation of Military Action

The Chair reported that a few days ago there was a mass shooting that occurred in Texas at a Church by a Veteran of the United States Airforce. The Chair explained that the anecdote seems to indicate that the premise of our application process screens candidates to deem them okay. However, we now know, as it relates to the Department of Defense for the last 20 years

there has been 3 inspector general reports and a law from Congress mandating DOD report actions. However, DOD has not been reporting these actions.

The Board can start the conversation with Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center staff and locally with the Local Commander Admiral Harris and ask the questions on the status of the reporting.

The Chair suggested we should raise the issue because it reasonable to theorize that maybe if the Chief of Police know that an individual had prior issues, then he would have not be able to obtain firearms and subsequently the shooting would not have occurred.

The EO reminded the Board that when reviewing applicants all we have to rely is the Criminal history report. The military branches are supposed to report, however we are finding that they do not always reporting. The FBI report is only as accurate as what the state, counties and militaries do report. The EO explained that by starting the conversation, we can bring awareness on the importance of everyone doing their job at reporting in order to gain a better picture of the applicant. They can begin the conversation with the Criminal Justice Data Center and Ray will provide contacts for military personal.

a. Board Approved 8-hour Curriculum
