Mr. Turner requested that the next meeting include discussion on changing the Board's statutes to include dry needling and adding a continuing competence requirement for physical therapist assistants.

Ms. Kubota noted that changing the inquired about the timeframe for proposed legislation.

EO Taniguchi noted that the deadline for bills to be submitted as part of the Administration's package for the 2018 legislative session has passed so the earliest a bill could be submitted is the 2019 legislative session.

Ms. Wakabayashi requested that the Board discuss possible participation in the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") licensure compact.

Vice Chair lopa asked how many states currently participate in the FSBPT's licensure compact.

Ms. Wakabayashi said currently there are 14 states who participate in the compact. The number will possibly increase to 16 or 18 by April.

Chair Shimabukuro asked that the FSBPT 2017 Annual Meeting be placed on the next meeting's agenda also so the Board could discuss information presented at the FSBPT meeting on topics such as telehealth.

Mr. Yee stated that HAPTA would like the Board to change their rules to allow telehealth.

DAG Wong stated that she does not think that change can be accomplished by changing the rules.

Mr. Turner noted that in order for the issue to be addressed in the rules, it must be in the Board's statutes first.
