Call to Order: Chairperson De Luz called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. at which time quorum was established.

Approval of Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Hansen, seconded by Mr. Wong, and unanimously
August 1, 2017 carried to approve the minutes of the August 1, 2017 Board meeting, with
Meeting: the following changes, as requested by Mr. Wong:

Page 1-2, Election of Officers, first paragraph:

In compliance with HRS Chapter 436B, the Board shall annually elect one member as chair and one member as vice-chair; the Executive Officer opened the floor for nominations. Mr. Chow nominated Mr. De Luz for the Chairperson and Mr. Wong for the Vice-Chairperson. Mr. Johnsen seconded the motion. Mr. Wong commented that there should be a balance of an Industry member and a public member for [in] the Chairperson [position be an

~~Industry member~~] and [the] Vice-Chairperson positions [~~be a public member~~]; thus, nominated Mr. Chow for the Vice-Chairperson position. Mr. Chow retracted his nomination of Mr. Wong for the Vice-Chairperson.

Executive Officer's Report:

Executive Officer Kleinhans provided an update of the Board's request instructing Executive Officer Rutkowski to send a notice to the Governor's office, on behalf of the Board, to stress the urgency of filling Board member vacancies. Mr. Kleinhans stated that Ms. Rutkowski informed Celia Suzuki, the Licensing Administrator of the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division, of the Board's request and Ms. Suzuki submitted a notice to the Governor's office.

Mr. Rolf commented that he had informed two (2) interested persons as to how to apply via the Boards and Commissions website.

Ms. Soderholm commented that a second stage manufacturer should fill one of the vacant positions, to broaden the perspective of the Board.

Chairperson De Luz stated that Board member appointments are controlled by the Executive Branch, the Governor's Office - Boards and Commissions, and that he encourages anyone to apply to get a different variety of people/backgrounds on the Board composition.

Chairperson De Luz announced the Board will recess its meeting to go into adjudicatory matter and subsequently go into Executive Session; the meeting recessed at 9:12 a.m.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Wong, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Chow, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement for the Motor Vehicle Dealer License of Ausagetaliitama P. Taulau doing business as Cure Autoplex LLC; MVI 2011-51-L.

Mr. Wong requested for Executive Officer Kleinhans to check on the status of Mr. Taulau's motor vehicle dealer's license and report his findings at the next scheduled meeting.

b. In the Matter of the Motor Vehicle Dealer's License of Sandra G. Siracusa, dba Metro Motors, In the Matter of the Motor Vehicle Salesperson's License of John A. Siracusa; MVI 2014-3-L

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Hansen, seconded by Mr. Wong, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement for the Motor Vehicle Dealer's License of Sandra G. Siracusa, dba Metro Motors, and for the Motor Vehicle Salesperson's license of John A. Siracusa; MVI 2014-3-L.

A suggestion to transmit a comment to the Regulated Industries Complaints Office ("RICO") was discussed. The Board commented that the terms of this settlement was "not tough" and that for future similar Settlement Agreements, the Board would like to see stricter terms of settlement.

The Board reconvened its meeting at 9:27 a.m., and immediately entered into Executive Session.

Executive Session: At 9:27 a.m., it was moved by Vice-Chairperson Chow, seconded by Mr. Hansen, and unanimously carried to enter into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to the individual applying for licensure in accordance with HRS §92-5(a) (1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS §92-5(a) (4).

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 9:54 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Wong, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Chow, and unanimously carried to return to the Board's regular order of business.

Licensing:

a. Ratifications

Upon a motion by Mr. Wong, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Chow, it was unanimously carried to ratify the above lists for the licenses sought (as attached).

b. Applications

- (i) Lotus Cars USA, Inc.
Motor Vehicle Distributor (LICF)

It was moved by Mr. Hansen, seconded by Mr. Wong, and unanimously carried to approve the motor vehicle distributor application for Lotus Cars USA, Inc.

- (ii) Jennifer Lynn Hill
Motor Vehicle Salesperson

It was moved by Vice-Chairperson Chow, seconded by Mr. Hansen, and carried by majority vote (Mr. Wong recused himself from decision making) to approve the motor vehicle salesperson application for Jennifer Lynn Hill.

- (iii) Ryan Shinjo
Motor Vehicle Salesperson

It was moved by Mr. Wong, seconded by Mr. Hansen, and unanimously carried to approve a conditional motor vehicle salesperson license to Ryan Shinjo.

New Business:

- a. 2018 RICO Motor Vehicle Industry Advisory Committee and Addendum Language

After discussion, it was moved by Vice-Chairperson Chow, seconded by Mr. Wong, and unanimously carried to approve the list of members of the RICO Motor Vehicle Industry Advisory Committee and addendum, which includes any additional interim appointees that RICO deems necessary to aid in its investigations.

Old Business:

- a. First Hawaiian Bank International Auto Show

Mr. Rolf stated that the First Hawaiian Bank International Auto Show ("Auto Show") was created by Walter Dods (in 1978) as a dealer show. Mr. Rolf stated that he got involved with the Auto Show from year 2000 where now it is a manufacturer's show; manufacturer's pay for ~ 70% of the cost to run the show, no display/endorsement by dealer at the Auto Show.

Discussion ensued on off-premise display approvals for motor vehicle dealers. Mr. Rolf pointed out that the April 2016 meeting minutes reflected/confirmed that the auto show is a manufacturer's show and not a dealer's show. Chairperson De Luz reiterated that the issue of an off-premise display is covered under HRS 437-4(d) for a motor vehicle dealer.

Discussion ensued on *First Hawaiian Bank Auto Show Timeline* ("Timeline") handout by Executive Officer Kleinhans. Mr. Wong commented that the copy of the Board's letter, dated March 11, 2016, clearly states that the Auto Show is a manufacturer's show.

He pointed out that there appears to be a discrepancy with the April 26, 2016 meeting minutes as it was reflected that Mr. Rolf reported that the 2016 First Hawaiian International Auto Show was not a manufacturer's show.

Mr. Rolf stated that he did not notice the incorrect information had been memorialized in the meeting minutes of April 26, 2016. He stated that the following paragraph on Page 6 should be deleted:

"The Executive Officer stated that Mr. Rolf reported that the 2016 First Hawaiian International Auto Show held from March 18 – 20 did not have ride and drives and was not a Manufacturer's Show."

It was moved by Mr. Wong, seconded by Mr. Johnsen, and unanimously carried to state that the April 26, 2016 meeting minutes was incorrectly recorded (as noted above), the Timeline should also be corrected to strike out "4/26/2016 – Board apprised of letter sent, Mr. Rolf reported that the Auto Show did not have "drive and rides" and was not a Manufacturer's show", and that the Board stands affirmatively with its letter dated March 11, 2016 that stated:

"Based solely on your representations that the Show is distinctively a Manufacturers' Show, the Board determined that the requirements of Hawaii Revised Statutes section 437-4(d) (display of motor vehicle at unlicensed premises) do not apply to Manufacturers."

Chairperson De Luz commented that this topic of discussion should be removed from future meeting agendas.

b. Hawaii Automobile Dealers Association – Definition of Final Stage Manufacturer

Mr. Rolf requested to defer discussion on the definition of final stage manufacturer.

Ms. Soderholm commented that while the Board had requested HADA and interested parties to work together to draft a definition of final stage manufacturer; that has not happened, and it is now "HADA's decision". Mr. Soderholm added that while he is a member of HADA, he is not invited to attend their meetings.

Chairperson De Luz stated that there is no consensus on this issue and encourages open discussion by HADA.

Ms. Soderholm stated her recollection was that this topic of discussion was to be taken off the meeting agendas.

It was moved by Mr. Wong, seconded by Mr. Hansen, and unanimously carried to remove agenda topic "Hawaii Automobile Dealers Association – Definition of Final Stage Manufacturer" from future meeting agendas until further notice.

Mr. Soderholm commented that when there is a broad consensus, the Board should request the opinions of the industry.

Correspondence:

- a. Request for clarification from John John Genovese: Is an auctioneer that offers marketing services, website services, and auction services to a motor vehicle dealer, required to obtain a motor vehicle auction license?

Discussion ensued on the license difference of a motor vehicle dealer versus a motor vehicle auction. It was commented that a motor vehicle dealer and a motor vehicle auction may be "kind of mirrored"; the difference is that a motor vehicle auction does not have inventory. Vice-Chairperson Chow commented that accountability is enhanced with a license, whether the car is here or there, better safe than sorry.

Mr. Wong commented that the inquirer should obtain a motor vehicle auction license.

It was moved by Vice-Chairperson Chow, seconded by Mr. Hansen, and unanimously carried that based on the situation described by Mr. Genovese, a motor vehicle auction license is required.

Public Comment:

Mr. Rolf provided a handout titled *HADA-initiated Bill(s) for 2018*. He summarized the objectives as it may be one bill to include the following:

- 1) *Common Ownership Bill* – Seamless transfer of salespersons between dealerships with a common owner;
- 2) To require manufacturers to pay dealers 1.75% per month for value of used vehicle grounded for lack of a repair part (Mr. Rolf commented: this was initiated due to the air bag issue, and also that this bill is tabled, awaiting information from Hawaii Ford dealers);
- 3) To require a 7-10 year period after a manufacturer-required facility upgrade before another upgrade can be required of a dealer;
- 4) *Sales Performance Criteria Bill* – To stipulate that the manufacturer be required to take into account unique circumstances within a dealer's market (Mr. Rolf commented: unique in that Hawaii is an isolated state);
- 5) *Vendor Choice Bill* – To allow a dealer to use a vendor with like quality materials for manufacturer-ordered facility up-grade; and
- 6) *Dealership Data Agreement Bill* – Establishing the dealership's data is its property and may not be accessed by the manufacturer or a manufacture vendor without the dealer's permission.

DAG Moriarty inquired if there is a federal regulation on the Dealership Data Agreement Bill.

Mr. Hansen left the meeting at 11:10 a.m.

Vice-Chairperson Chow inquired as to the type of data collected: what, when, financial data. Mr. Wong commented that these data may be used for recall information.
