At the Board's October 6, 2017 meeting, members discussed compiling general information regarding examination results. Executive Officer Ferrer stated that she is still accumulating the information.

The Chair noted that the Board has become concerned about the failure rate of the EPPP and wishes to examine factors that may be contributing to the failure rate, including:

- 1. Preparation for the examination—What are institutions doing to prepare students to take the EPPP?
- 2. Keeping knowledge current—How do institutions ensure that the curriculum and program of study are current and up to date?
