Relating to its
Implementation:

a. Private Detective and Guard Positions Included in DCCA's Budget

The EO reported that the Vice Chair we leave this agenda item on from the last meeting to give an updated report. The EO stated that the Division was able to hire a new employee and that to date any clean applications have been processed.

b. June 30, 2018 Private Detective and Guard Renewal Statistics

The EO reported on the June 30, 2018 Renewal statistics for the following licenses types:

- Guard Agencies (GDA)- Of the 80 Agency licenses eligible to renew, 63 licensees renewed.
- Guard (GD) - Of the 102 Security Guard licenses eligible to renew, 83 renewed.
- Private Detective Agencies (PDA) - Of the 38 Agency licenses able to renew, 34 licensees renewed.
- Private Detective (PD)- Of the 112 Private Detective licenses able to renew, 96 renewed.
- Guard Employee (GDE)- Of the 14, 321 GDE licenses eligible for renewal, 9,004 licensees renewed.

Scope:

a. Email Inquiry- If the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Academy is acceptable to satisfy the high school educational requirement

After review of the email inquiry dated August 18, 2018, the Board reaffirmed its previous determination that the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge is acceptable to satisfy the high school educational requirement needed for HRS 463-10.5.

Upon a motion by Mr. Inouye, seconded by the Vice Chair, and unanimously carry to uphold the Board's previous determination regarding the above inquiry.

New Business:

a. New Fingerprint code required for Fieldprint in lieu of Drop-Down Option

The EO reported that in order to comply with FBI requirements and to ensure fingerprints are given to the correct reviewing agency, Fieldprint is requiring a code, instead of using the drop down option. The EO reported that effective September 1, 2018, applicants completing their fingerprints will need to enter a code when making their appointment. The code is HI-DCCA-PDSG. She noted that the code is not case sensitive, however, the hyphens are necessary. The EO also stated that this information will be posted on the Board website along with being an attachment on the physical application.

- b. "Young vs. State of Hawaii"
- c. 9th Circuit Court Decision Regarding Handguns

The EO stated that after review of both agenda item "b" and "c" under "New Business" the topic was regarding the same issue. She asked the DAG to go over the matter more.

At 1:18 p.m., it was moved by the Vice Chair, seconded by Mr. Inouye, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

The DAG reported on an article distributed to the Board regarding "Young vs. State of Hawaii." After a brief discussion, the DAG reported that as far as the Board itself is concerned, the Board has HRS 16-89-17 which prohibits private detective and guards from carrying firearms unless authorized by the appropriate state agency or chief of police. The DAG clarified that HRS 16-89-17 will remain unchanged despite the 9th Circuit Court decision.

- d. Registration with U.S. Selective Service

The Chair asked if there is any part of the application process that asks if an applicant is registered with the U.S. Selective Service and if not, should the Board consider that a requirement to place as a question on the application.

The EO reported that the law is a federal law.

The DAG reported that as the PVL Boards are concerned, no Board has that question as part of their application. Regarding the second question, the DAG stated that one of the main functions of PVL is to protect the health and safety of consumers and make sure the licensed professionals are acting appropriately. Therefore, the adding of the question would be a policy component that individual Boards would need to consider.

The Chair asked if there were further questions. There were none.
