**Agenda:** The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7(b).

**Call to Order:** There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. by Chairperson McKay.

**Minutes of the November 19, 2018 Board Meeting:** Executive Officer Kleinhans stated the minutes of the November 19, 2018 meeting were not finalized. It was noted that the minutes will be available within thirty days after the November 19, 2018 meeting date, as required pursuant to HRS section 92-9, and will be on the January 28, 2019 meeting agenda for the Board's review and approval.

**Executive Officer's Report:** A. Licensing Examination of the National-Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology ("NIC")

Executive Officer Kleinhans stated he has no new updates on the Board's expressed interest in the administration of the NIC exam, as no response has yet been received from NIC concerning testing vendors.

B. 2019 Board Meeting Schedule

Board members were provided with a copy of the 2019 Board meeting schedule.

At 12:02 p.m., the Board recessed the meeting to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

Matters:

A. In the Matter of the Beauty Operator's License of LILY K. PHAM; BAR 2018-84-L

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Williams, seconded by Mr. Nelson, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement relating to the Matter of the Beauty Operator's License of LILY K. PHAM; BAR 2018-84-L.

At 12:05 p.m., the Board reconvened its scheduled meeting and immediately entered Executive Session.

At 12:05 p.m., it was moved by Ms. Williams, seconded by Ms. Severson, and unanimously carried for the Board to enter into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 12:20 p.m., it was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Mr. Nelson, and unanimously carried for the Board to move out of Executive Session.

A. Ratification of Issued Licenses

It was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Ms. Severson, and unanimously carried to ratify the list of issued licenses attached (see, attached list).

B. Application for Registration – Barber Apprentice

(1) VAA, Hunnie N.

Ms. Williams disclosed she knows the applicant but is able to vote fairly and objectively on her barber apprentice application for registration.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Williams, seconded by Ms. Severson, and unanimously carried to approve the barber apprentice application for registration of Hunnie N. Vaa.

C. Application for New Beauty Shop

(1) DIVA SALON LLC

After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Ms. Williams, and unanimously carried to approve the beauty shop application of Diva Salon LLC.

Mr. Nakama inquired if a shop license is required for booth renters/sublessees. The Board reaffirmed its previous determination that booth renters/sublessees of an existing shop need to hold their own shop license.

It was noted that, in accordance with HAR section 16-201-90, the above interpretation is for informational and explanatory purposes only. It is not an official opinion or decision, and therefore is not to be viewed as binding on the Board or the DCCA.

D. Request to Remove Conditions: CANIO, Stanley C., III  
( BAR 2758 )

Mr. Canio's barber license had been restored with conditions by the Board at its May 2017 meeting. He is requesting that the Board remove those conditions, as follows:

- Licensee must secure employment in a licensed shop with his restored conditional barber's license;
- Licensee must disclose to any and all employers his history of criminal convictions;

- Licensee must notify the Board in writing within thirty (30) days of securing that employment; and
- This written notification to the Board must include his signature and the signature of his employer reflecting the employer's acknowledgment of receiving and being aware of Mr. Canio's history of criminal convictions.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Williams, seconded by Ms. Severson, and unanimously carried to remove the aforementioned conditions to Mr. Canio's barber license.

Investigative

Report:

A. Possible Revisions to HAR §§16-73 and 16-78

The Cosmetology Committee reported the following, to suggest for the following amendments to the Curriculum:

- Cosmetician to be renamed to Esthetician;
- Esthetician: manicuring and pedicuring 150 hours  
= 150 hours "facial and makeup"
- Remove all "unassigned" hours (to be recategorized):
  - Manicurist: unassigned 50 hours  
= 50 hours "manicuring and pedicuring"
  - Esthetician: unassigned 75 hours  
= 50 hours "theory"  
= 25 hours "shop management";
  - Hairdresser: unassigned 175 hours  
= 50 hours "haircutting"  
= 50 hours "haircoloring and bleaching"  
= 100 hours "hair straightening"  
= removing 25 hours from "hairstyling and shampooing"
  - Cosmetologist: unassigned 250 hours  
= 50 hours "haircutting"  
= 50 hours "haircoloring and bleaching"  
= 100 hours "hair straightening"  
= 25 hours "facial and makeup"  
= 25 hours "manicuring and pedicuring"

Executive Officer Kleinhans stated that he will provide a proposed curriculum draft at the next meeting.

The Barber Committee reported that a previous draft of HAR chapter 16-73 that included their suggested amendments may have been circulated with the previous Executive Officer.

Executive Officer Kleinhans stated he will follow up on this matter.
