 - Update from Phil Meyer, President and Colin Rorrie, Interim CEO;

EO Matsushima circulated the newsletter for perusal. Mr. Rorrie is serving as the interim CEO. CLARB is searching for a full-time CEO. Mr. Kurokawa also shared that CLARB has been holding a series of webinars on Foresight. This was a series of four webinars, anticipating what may arise in the future as well as what the board has been doing. There is a new alliance for EALSA-accountancy boards to combat threats to licensure. CLARB is also working on strategies to educate the public in all jurisdictions. More details were provided in the newsletter.

Correspondence:

Questions from the Contractors License Board in reference to an inquiry from the Department of Fire and Public Safety, County of Maui,

regarding Mechanical Engineer's Supervision of C-37 Plumbing Contractor Installing Fire Protection Sprinkler Systems;

EO Matsushima shared the inquiry letter with the board. A discussion ensued. What does supervise mean? Should a licensed mechanical engineer (ME) be the one to supervise? Plumbers can install sprinkler systems under the supervision of a ME. Mr. Katayama (Board's ME) provided his input and mentioned that supervision is defined in the rules. There was question as to whether or not supervision must be directly onsite or if it could be via video or facetime.

Following the discussion, EO Matsushima's draft response letter was read to the board. The following is an excerpt from that letter.

"The EASLA Board met on July 18, 2019 and concurred that a licensed mechanical engineer shall supervise a C-37 Plumbing Contractor. The supervision may be through physical presence and/or through the use of communication devices (i.e., phone, telecommunication, webinar, etc.). After installation, a licensed mechanical engineer or a qualified inspector, not an unlicensed individual, could conduct the inspection."

Following the reading of EO Matsushima's draft response letter, Mr. Katayama moved, Mr. Kurokawa seconded and it was unanimously carried to approve the Board's letter to the Contractors License Board.

There was a discussion as to how Board members who are reviewing applications credit the applicants for experience while they are studying for

their Bachelor's and/or Master's degrees and whether or not part-time or full credit should be credited during the school year. There is inconsistency among the reviewers who allow for experience credit. The discussion is should the reviewers allow an applicant to earn lawful experience credit during the school year while attending / studying for their Bachelors or Masters in engineering?

NCEES model law does not allow for experience while in school. Mr. Yumol asked if the Board adopts NCEES model law, would the board be restricted? Dep AG Leong said it would depend on how it's written.

The Board will defer further discussion until next month when Mr. Suzuki (Civil Engineer) and Mr. Iwamoto (Structural Engineer) are present. Dep AG Leong will also research on restrictions when adopting model laws.
