b. Examination Review (Private Detective and Guard)

The Chair reported that on behalf of the Strategic Review Committee, he reviewed each of the exam study materials and compared it to the test bank for both the Private Detective and Guard Examinations. After extensive review, he suggested that Study Material be separated by Exam to reflect the following:

a. **Mandatory Training: HRS §463-10.5 and HAR §16-97-7 (b)(7)**

- (i) Does HRS §463-10.5 supersede HAR §16-97-7(b)(7)?

The Vice Chair stated that he compared HRS §463-10.5 to HAR §16-97-7(b)(7) and wanted clarification if one superseded the other. He noted that in HAR §16-97-7(b)(7) minimum durations were not specified whereas in HRS §463-10.5 they are.

The EO stated that it has always been that the statute would prevail over the rule. She stated that section seven of the rules was created prior to Act 208 therefore specific information was not included.

Rule Revision: a. HAR §16-97-7(b)

The EO stated that with the induction of Act 208, the Rules Committee will be working on amending the current rules to create an entire subsection that will include all the necessary requirements of Act 208 and separate out the items that apply to guard agencies for consistency and clarity purposes.

Executive Officer's Report:

a. Outreach to Hotels, Retail, In-House Security regarding Guard Registration Requirements

The EO reported that she will be working with the Vice Chair to send out an outreach memo to all hotels, retail, and in-house security to remind these areas that individuals acting in a guard capacity as defined in Act 208 must be registered as a guard employee.
