Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 8:39 a.m. at which time quorum was established.

Chair's Report: **Announcements/Introductions**

The Chair excused Ms. Stone Murai and asked the audience to introduce themselves.

Approval of the Previous Minutes –August 1, 2019

The Chair called for a motion in regard to the minutes of the August 1, 2019 meeting.

Upon a motion by Ms. Daub, seconded by Dr. Napoleon, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the August 1, 2019 meeting as circulated.

Proposed Position Statement – “Administration and Management of Intravenous (IV) Moderate Sedation”

The Chair prepared a position statement on the “Administration and Management of Intravenous (IV) Moderate Sedation” that he wanted the Board to consider adopting.

The position statement distinguishes between minimal sedation, moderate sedation, deep sedation and general anesthesia and includes whether an RN can administer or manage any of these analgesia.

The Chair stated that he found this on the Mississippi Board of Nursing web page and had received their Chair’s approval to copy their position statement.

After some discussion, upon a motion by Ms. Boyer, seconded by Ms. Oliveira, it was voted on and unanimously carried to adopt the position statement and to direct the EO to post the position statement on the Board’s web page.

Executive Officer’s Report:

Conferences/Seminars/Meetings

2019 NCSBN Annual Meeting

August 21-23, 2019, Chicago, Illinois – The Vice Chair and Mr. Duldulao Attending

The Vice Chair and Mr. Duldulao gave a brief summary as well as submitted a written report on their attendance at the NCSBN Annual Meeting.

The Vice Chair was asked when she attend the NLC meeting, if she was able to discuss some of the Board’s concerns with the NLC with some of the other states that had not yet joined.

The Vice Chair reported that she spoke with Phyllis Mitchell of the Vermont BON who stated they anticipate a \$1 million-dollar loss of revenue by joining the NLC. However, she stated that NCSBN does have a grant to help with initiating the process, which any jurisdiction may apply for. The Vice Chair stated that there is a \$6,000 annual fee that the individual Board is responsible for paying while in the compact. The Vice Chair stated that Ms. Mitchell mentioned hiring a lobbyist to help with the legislative process if the Board was interested in joining the compact, which she believes NCSBN may also help in funding.

The Vice Chair stated that she and Mr. Duldulao had the opportunity to speak with a representative from the Washington Board of Nursing regarding their opposition to join the NLC. She stated that the Washington Board had questions that were raised by unions within Washington. As a result, Washington will be conducting a survey to see how many nurses would be interested in participating in the compact. The Vice Chair stated that she did inquire with the NLC panel if there was a nurse that violated the law and fled to another state to practice, who would be responsible for the investigation process. The Vice Chair stated that she was told it would be the responsibility of the State Board in which the violation occurred. She stated that NLC does stress to each nurse the importance of learning and understanding individual state laws and requirements. Lastly, the Vice Chair stated that she was able to speak with a Guam representative which shared they have similar concerns as the Washington Board of Nursing.

2019 NCLEX Conference

The EO apologized to Ms. Boyer that she thought she registered her for the NCLEX Conference but it was another conference for someone else, thus, Ms. Boyer will not be attending the NCLEX Conference this year.

2019 NCSBN Leadership & Public Policy Conference

The Chair will be attending this conference, October 2-4, 2019, in Atlanta, Georgia.

Boards and Commissions Member Orientation

Ms. Oliveira and Ms. Kodama will be attending this orientation October 11, 2019, 8:30 – 12:00, State Capitol Auditorium

Information/Resource - “Adverse Event Decision Pathway”

The EO reported that a memo with the decision pathway was posted on the Board’s web page per the Board’s previous directive.

2019 Renewal – Status Report

Continuing Competency

The EO reported that she received the list of nurses that were randomly selected to submit proof of completion of a learning activity option for continuing competency, there were 1,170 total nurses selected. Of the nurses selected, 71 were APRNs with prescriptive authority, 115 were LPNs and 1,524 were RNs. She stated that the audit letters should be mailed by the end of September but asked if letters should go out all at the same time or divided up into groups?

It was the consensus of the Board to send out the letters at the same time.

The EO stated that she will also check if the list can be posted on the Board’s web page.

Criminal History Background Check

The EO stated that she is still waiting for the number of nurses that actually went to get fingerprinted for the 2019 renewal. She reminded the Board that over 8,000 nurses were required to be fingerprinted as part of the renewal requirement for 2019 and that Licensing Branch staff has been checking the list but she has not gotten a report on how many nurses were actually fingerprinted.

State Health Care Scorecard Finds Deaths from Suicide, Alcohol, Drugs are a Regional Epidemic; Impact Varies Widely Across States

The EO reported that administration has been working on the process and are taking steps to report notices by licensees and other jurisdictions more timely.

The EO also announced that Dean Boland of the UH School of Nursing and Dental Hygiene will be retiring next summer.

In addition, she reported that DCCA issued a press release on “Phone Scam Calls Targeting Licensed Professional Reported.”

Legislative Updates

The Board noted the following bills introduced or new laws enacted in other states:

- 8/9/2019

ENACTED

AK S 93 SUMMARY:

Establishes the workforce enhancement program intended to increase the availability of health care services throughout the state, especially to underserved individuals or in health care professional shortage or rural areas.

DE H 58 SUMMARY:

Increases the Numbers of Delaware nursing students eligible for the nursing incentive program by allowing Delawareans pursuing nursing careers at non-profit hospitals.

DE S 83 SUMMARY:

Adopts the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact.

Scope of Practice

APRN-Rx – Exclusionary Formulary

The Chair led the discussion on the following email inquiry:

“I am a new APRN with prescriptive authority and I am e-mailing for clarification of the "Exclusionary Formulary for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses Granted Prescriptive Authority".

In the exclusionary formulary, it states that an APRN with prescriptive authority shall NOT prescribe "human growth hormones, anabolic steroids, or hormones for performance enhancement or decreasing the impact of aging;".

However, in my current practice, which specializes in rheumatology involves a variety of bones and joints disorders including aging-associated diseases (i.e. osteoporosis, arthritis). Treatment for some of these aging-associated diseases include hormones (i.e. teriparatide (Forteo) for Osteoporosis). I was wondering if there were specifics or examples you could provide to that rule stated in the exclusionary formulary. Would the example given (i.e. Forteo for Osteoporosis) be considered acceptable as it is use in my current specialty and practice or does that fall into the category that APRN-Rxs are not being able to prescribe? I am more interested in the last clause of that rule since as mentioned in my practice of rheumatology we have many patients who have aging-related disease and may require hormone therapies. Any guidance would be greatly appreciated as this is in the best interest of my patients and in terms of following my scope of practice and prescribing guidelines.”

Ms. Boyer stated that osteoporosis is a well-established medical condition that may be “treated” as opposed to “decreasing the impact of aging” as stated in the Exclusionary Formulary.

After further discussion, it was the consensus of the Board that that osteoporosis is a well-established medical condition that may be “treated” as opposed to “prevention” by “decreasing the impact of aging” as stated in the Exclusionary Formulary and therefore an APRN with prescriptive authority who had received the appropriate education and training and practicing within his/her practice specialty, may prescribe/administer drugs to “treat” these aging-associated diseases.

The EO recommended that the Board re-review the Exclusionary Formulary to see if any clarification or updates are warranted.

APRN Treatment with Silver Nitrate Stick

The Chair led the discussion on the following email inquiry:

“My name is Hanna Krieger. I am a nurse practitioner at Hawaii State Hospital and need to clarify whether treatment with silver nitrate stick in a patient with a stage 4 pressure ulcer falls within the scope of nursing practice in Hawaii.”

The Chair referred to various stages of pressure ulcers and that research appears to indicate that treatment with silver nitrate stick is not appropriate to treat a stage IV pressure ulcer. He stated that a stage IV pressure ulcer is exposed bone, tendon or muscle and that silver nitrate stick, a topical medication, is not indicated for stage II, III, or IV pressure ulcers.

After further discussion, it was the consensus of the Board that based on the information provided, the use of silver nitrate stick to treat a stage IV pressure ulcer does NOT fall within an APRN's or nurse's scope of practice.

In accordance with HAR § 16-201-90, the above interpretation is for informational and explanatory purposes only and based solely on the information provided. It is not an official opinion or decision and therefore not binding on the Board.

Can an APRN Administer “Stem Cell Therapy” – Additional Information

The EO stated that the inquirer asked that this matter be deferred to the October meeting as he was still gathering additional information.

Email from Richard A. “Red” Lawhern, PhD- Prescribing Opioids

The Vice Chair read an email the Board received from Dr. Lawhern regarding his opinion that doctors “over prescribing” opioids did not cause the nation's drug crisis.

Hawaii State Center for Nursing:

Mrs. Hussey reported on the following:

The Center released their annual Education Compacity Report. She did want to note that the infographics does not include clinical placements as one of the top three concerns. She stated that although it remains a challenge it primarily affects Oahu schools and not a problem statewide.

In addition, the data from the Workforce supply survey is in and the Center is working on getting out the report. However, Mrs. Hussey did state that their first infographic targeting Lifelong Learning was released.

Mrs. Hussey shared that the HAH Demand Data report was released which stated that the top three vacancies were nurse related. There is a shortage in Specialty RNS, LPNS, and CNAs.

Lastly, Mrs. Hussey reminded everyone that their Leadership in Action Conference is coming up.
