Old Business:

a. Discussion of the draft rules amendment to a proposed Draft 1 of Title 16 Chapter 115, Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR").

The draft is being routed to the Attorney General and the DCCA Director for review.

New Business: a. <u>Professional Engineers Report</u>

EO Matsushima noted a correction that the year of the agenda items under NCEES Zone visit and the NCARB's MBE Workshop are typos and need to be corrected from 2019 to 2020.

- Matters Related to the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying ("NCEES")
 - NCEES Western Zone Mobility Challenge

Brian Robertson, Western Zone Vice President challenged the Western Zone States by introducing a 3-step process towards reducing barriers to mobility. Each state will select a state to review that state's laws. The state will then report back to the leadership on their findings in Spring 2020. The last step will be to propose or implement those changes in helping to reduce barriers to mobility where possible at the Annual Meeting in late Summer 2020. Alaska has selected Hawaii. Hawaii has selected Guam.

The Board's delegates will need to begin reviewing the licensure regulations from Guam in response to the mobility challenge and present a report of its findings at the Zone meeting in March. All state board findings will be compiled and presented in whole at the Annual meeting.

NCEES will fund three board delegates- two engineers and one land surveyor, plus one MBE to attend the Zone meeting. Mr. Katayama, Mr. Pang, and Mr. Hirota plan to be the delegates for the Zone meeting in March. The Board's delegates who plan to attend the Annual meeting in June are Mr. Suzuki, Mr. Iwamoto, and Mr. Hirota. All delegates will conduct their own research, reviews, and comments in the combined Board's report, which will be compiled and presented at the Zone meeting and finalized at the Annual meeting.

NCEES ACCA inquiry regarding Amending the By Laws to Add a Ninth Seat on the Board of Directors

EO Matsushima informed the Board that the ACCA was conducting a poll to see whether the member boards were in favor of adding an MBA, as an official voting member, to the NCEES Board of Directors. Majority of the responses from

other state boards and/or jurisdictions were in favor. After a brief discussion, the Board could not reach a consensus.

NCEES Western Zone Visit to Hawaii – February 20, 2020

EO Matsushima announced that the NCEES Zone Vice President Brian Robertson is planning to visit the Board at its February 20, 2020 meeting.
