Call to Order:	There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 8:35 a.m. by Vice-Chairperson Komo.		
	Vice-Chairperson Komo proceeded with roll call. All Board members were present.		
Election of Officers:	Vice-Chairperson Komo requested that Board members could either indicate their interest in or nominate member(s) for the position of Board Chairperson. Mr. Roberts nominated Vice-Chairperson Komo for the position of Board Chairperson. Vice-Chairperson Komo expressed his interest in the position. No further members expressed an interest and no further nominations were made for the position of Board Chairperson. Mr. Aratani seconded the motion, and it was unanimously carried to elect Vice-Chairperson Komo as Board Chairperson.

<u>New Business</u> :	A.	Delegation and clarification of responsibilities to the Executive Officer and general processes in response COVID-19 pandemic
		Discussion ensued regarding the Board to adopt a policy to allow applicants to partake in the continuous testing scheme while amendments to the administrative rules are pending.
		Chairperson Komo cited current Hawaii Administrative Rules section16-71-19(i)(2):
		"An applicant shall not retake a failed section in the same examination window."
		After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Punua, and unanimously carried that the Board's policy will be to not enforce the existing administrative rules that limits applicants to retake a test within the same examination window in light of the continuous testing scheme and pending changes to the Board's administrative rules.
		Discussion ensued regarding the extension of CPA expiring credits due to COVID-19 limitations in taking examination.

Mr. Punua cited Hawaii Administrative Rules Section 16-71-19(k):

"Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, conditional credits that have expired may be extended only for good and valid reasons determined by the board."

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Punua, and unanimously carried that the Board extend expiring CPA credits to December 31, 2020 due to COVID-19 limitations in being able to take the examination.

Discussion ensued regarding an extension of the NTS (Notice to Schedule) for candidates due to COVID-19 limitations in being able to take the examination.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Miyashiro, and unanimously carried that the Board have a blanket extension of the NTS (Notice to Schedule) to December 31, 2020 due to COVID-19 limitations.

Discussion ensued regarding an extension of CPE requirements for the upcoming biennial renewal (December 31, 2021) due to COVID-19 limitations.

Executive Officer Araceley cited Hawaii Administrative Rules section 16-71-46(3):

"<u>Exceptions.</u> The board may issue a permit to practice to any applicant who has not fully complied with the continuing professional education requirement in cases where failure by the applicant to fulfill the requirement has been caused by reason of: (3) Other good and valid causes, as determined and approved by the board."

Mr. Williams and Chairperson Komo commented that the Board's pending changes to the administrative rules will have a minimum CPE requirement per year. Since the new administrative rules have not been

	adopted yet, the Board will take this into consideration and discuss in a future meeting. Discussion ensued regarding delegating the approval of applicants to the Executive Officer to be ratified by the Board at the next meeting. At this time, the Board agreed to keep the current process as is of Chairperson Komo providing an initial review of applicants and an applicant summary provided to board members to review and approve at the meeting. Chairperson Komo stated the Board can meet to accelerate the process or delegate Executive Officer Araceley to approve applicants should any issue arise.
