Call to Order: The agenda for this meeting was filed with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, as required by section 92-7(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS").

The Chair took roll call to establish quorum. All members being present, the Chair called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

All votes were conducted by roll call.

Executive Session: At 9:06 a.m., upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Keefe, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move into Executive Session in accordance with HRS, 92-5(a) (1) and (4), "To consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for pharmacy licensure," and, "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities".

At 10:02 a.m., upon a motion by Ms. Cross, seconded by Mr. Adams, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Ms. Takahashi asked if Mr. Wheatland was in attendance to please raise his hand.

Ms. Takahashi reported that none of the attendees raised their hand in response to her request. It did not appear that Mr. Wheatland was in attendance.

Chapter 91, HRS – Adjudicatory Matters:

At 10:17 a.m., the Chair called for a recess of the meeting to discuss and deliberate on adjudicatory matters.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decision, in these matters, pursuant to Chapter 91, HRS, the Chair announced that the Board was reconvening its scheduled meeting at 10:25 a.m.

New Business: **Correspondence**

At 10:25 a.m., the Chair asked staff if Mr. Wheatland was listed as an attendee.

Ms. Takahashi asked if Mr. Wheatland was in attendance to please raise his hand.

Ms Takahashi reported that none of the attendees raised their hand in response to her request. It did not appear that Mr. Wheatland was in attendance.

The Chair stated that she would give him some extra time and would take up the second correspondence agenda item.

Pharmacists Administering COVID-19 Test - HHS Guidance and Advisory Opinion

The Chair reported that on April 8, 2020, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS") issued a Guidance for Licensed Pharmacists, COVID-19 Testing, and Immunity under the PREP Act and on May 19, 2020, issued an Advisory Opinion 20-02 On the Public Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act and the Secretary's Delegation Under the Act.

The Guidance and Advisory Opinion preempts state licensing laws that restrict the ability of pharmacists to order and administer COVID-19 diagnostic tests.

The Guidance and Advisory Opinion expressly authorizes pharmacists, under the PREP Act, to order and administer those tests.

Mr. Adams stated that a CLIA waiver is also required.

Mr. VandenBussche stated that appropriate training should also be required.

The DAG cautioned the Board on mandating further requirements.

Ms. Tokumaru asked if pharmacy students would also be able to administer the COVID-19 tests under this Guidance and Advisory Opinion.

The EO stated that the Guidance and Advisory Opinion specifically refers to “pharmacists” and not pharmacy students, pharmacy interns or other pharmacy personnel.

The Chair stated that, pursuant to HRS Section 461-9, a pharmacy intern may perform the activities defined in the “Practice of pharmacy” in HRS 461-1, provided the intern is under the immediate supervision of a pharmacist and is administering the test pursuant to a health care professional authorized to order such tests.

There being no further discussion, it was the consensus of the Board that the HHS Guidance and Advisory Opinion preempts state laws restricting pharmacists from ordering and administering Covid tests, that the current pharmacy practice act does not prohibit pharmacists from administering the COVID-19 tests, and that pharmacy interns, under the immediate supervision of a pharmacist, may also administer the COVID-19 test.

At 10:39 a.m., the Chair asked if Mr. Wheatland was listed as an attendee.

Ms. Takahashi asked if Mr. Wheatland was in attendance to please raise his hand.

None of the attendees raised their hand in response to her request. Ms Takahashi reported that it did not appear that Mr. Wheatland was in attendance.

Prescription for OTC Product – Rand Wheatland

The Chair stated that upon review of Mr. Wheatland’s emails and his August 13, 2020 submission, it appears that in this case the pharmacy refused to sell an OTC product based on the pharmacist’s professional judgement with knowledge of the FDA issuance of a Drug Safety Communication that expressed safety concerns and added warnings about serious heart problems to the Drug Facts label of OTC loperamide products.

Mr. VandenBussche stated that the pharmacist is responsible for the safety of the patient and that it looks like the pharmacist did the right thing.

Ms. Cross stated that a pharmacy cannot mandate or require a prescription for an OTC product, however, the pharmacy practice act, as previously stated, includes that the pharmacist look out for patient safety and that the pharmacist has a professional responsibility to consider the FDA issuance of the Drug Safety Communication.

Mr. Adams stated that the pharmacy has the right to advise of the side effects/potential problems but it is beyond the pharmacist’s responsibility to “require” a prescription. He also reiterated that the company/pharmacy may determine “guidelines” and that the pharmacist may be prudent with customers but not deny the customer’s needs.

Ms. Tokumaru stated that a pharmacist can use their professional judgment to consider the safety of the patient especially if a patient is requesting a quantity of meds that may do harm to the patient.

Ms. Keefe referred to HRS §461-1, definition of "Practice of pharmacy" that states:

"Practice of pharmacy" means:

- (1) The interpretation and evaluation of prescription orders; the compounding, dispensing, and labeling of drugs and devices (except labeling by a manufacturer, packer, or distributor of nonprescription drugs and commercially legend drugs and devices); the participation in drug selection and drug utilization reviews; the proper and safe storage of drugs and devices and the maintenance of proper records therefor; the responsibility for advising when necessary or where regulated, of therapeutic values, content, hazards, and use of drugs and devices; and the interpretation and evaluation of prescription orders to adjust the supply dispensed for purposes of medication synchronization pursuant to section 431:10A-606, 432:1-621, or 432D-30;

Emphasis added. Ms. Keefe also stated that in response to Mr. Wheatland's question, a prescription is NOT required for an OTC product.

The Vice Chair agreed that, as a public member, she would like to emphasize and appreciate the pharmacist looking out for the safety of the consumer.

At 10:47 a.m., the Chair asked if Mr. Wheatland was listed as an attendee.

Ms. Takahashi asked if Mr. Wheatland was in attendance to please raise his hand.

None of the attendees raised their hand in response to her request. Ms. Takahashi reported that it did not appear that Mr. Wheatland was in attendance.

The Chair summarized the Board's response to Mr. Wheatland's submission and reiterated that:

- A prescription is not required for an OTC product; and
- The pharmacist acted appropriately, using their professional judgement as stated in the definition of "Practice of pharmacy" by not selling the OTC product as requested based on the FDA Drug Safety Communication in the interest of patient safety; and
- The Board has no jurisdiction over private companies' policies/directives, unless they conflict with the pharmacy practice act's laws/rules.

There being no further discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to respond to Mr. Wheatland as stated above.
