Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as

required by HRS section 92-7(b).

A short video was played to explain procedures for this virtual meeting and how

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members of the public can participate and interact with the Board during the meeting.

Chairperson Leong proceeded with roll call. All Board members were present.

Call to Order:

There being a quorum present, Chairperson Leong called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m.

Amendments to the Agenda:

It was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the following amendment to the agenda:

Move to Kaeo'okalani C. Jones (Individual) from deferred to <u>Conditional License</u> Report.

Minutes:

It was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of April 5, 2021 and the Board Meeting and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of March 19, 2021, as circulated.

Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

Chairperson Leong called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:10 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

- 1. Settlement Agreements
- a. <u>In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Ryan A. Thompson formerly doing business as Pro Solar Hawaii; CLB 2015-231-L</u>

RICO received a complaint alleging that, in 2014, Ryan A. Thompson formerly doing business as Pro Solar Hawaii ("Respondent") exhibited poor workmanship in the installation of a residential photovoltaic system (the "Project").

RICO alleges that Respondent failed to include required information and disclosures in the contract for the Project.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rules: HRS section 444-25.5 (required disclosures in homeowner contracts) and HAR section 16-77-80 (required information and disclosures in homeowner contracts) and 16-77-97 (poor workmanship).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Teves, seconded by Mr. Arita (with Mr. Isemoto recusing himself), and carried by the majority, to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

b. <u>In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Holika Manupele doing business as DSK Contractor; CLB 2020-3151-L</u>

On or about February 20, 2020, Holika Manupele doing business as DSK Contractor ("Respondent") entered a written contract to construct a wall at a home in Koloa, Hawaii, but did not provide the homeowner with verbal or written disclosures regarding lien or bonding rights.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444-25.5(a) and (b) (requiring verbal and written disclosure of lien and bonding rights) and/or HAR section 16-77-80 (requiring disclosures in written contracts with homeowners).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$500.00.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Teves, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried, to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

c. <u>In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of All In One Construction Inc.</u> and Philip E. Blake; CLB 2019-255-L

In August of 2016, All In One Construction Inc. and Philip E. Blake ("Respondents AIO and Blake") entered into a written contract with a homeowner. The contract called for Respondents to build out a commercial unit in Lahaina in exchange for \$109,270.00.

RICO alleges that Respondent AIO failed to make and keep records showing all contracts, documents, records, receipts, and disbursements by a licensee for a period of three years after completion, in violation of HRS section 444-17(7) (failure to keep and maintain records of transactions for three years).

RICO further alleges that Respondent Blake failed to have direct management of Respondent AIO and the contracts entered into by Respondent AIO and Richard Januzzi in violation of HAR section 16-77-70(b) (the contracting business shall be under the direct management of the principal RME).

RICO alleges that Respondent Blake, as the RME for Respondent AIO, was not familiar with the contracts entered into by Respondent AIO in violation of HAR section 16-77-71(a)(2).

RICO alleges that Respondent Blake has failed to see that records were kept for the contract with Complainant in violation of HAR section 16-77-71(a)(3).

RICO alleges that Respondent Blake was not present in Hawaii during the time the project was under construction in violation of HAR section 16-77-71 (a)(4).

Respondents AIO and Blake agree to the voluntary surrender of their respective licenses. The surrender shall become effective March 1, 2021. Respondents shall turn in all indicia of the licenses to the Executive Officer of the Board within ten (10) days after receipt of notice that this Settlement Agreement has been approved.

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After discussion it was moved by Mr. Teves, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried, to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Leong announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:24 a.m.

Executive Session:

At 9:29 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(1) to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS section 26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

DAG Leong left the meeting at 12:54 p.m.

At 1:58 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Isemoto, and unanimously carried, to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

5. <u>Legislative Committee</u>:

Neal Arita, Chairperson

Executive Officer Ito presented the Legislative Committee Report:

Relating to the Contractors Recovery Fund

a. Senate Bill No. 1104, H.D. 1

This bill increases the maximum amount of recovery to \$25,000.00 per contract and maximum payout per licensed contractor to \$75,000.00.

On March 31, 2021, FIN held a hearing on S.B.1104, H.D.1 and passed this measure unamended.

Senate and House Conferees were appointed. On April 17, 2021 the Department sent a letter to the conferees in support of the Senate version of S.B. 1104 as this version is effective upon approval. On April 21, 2021, the Conference Committee deferred this bill indefinitely due to underlying concerns.

Relating to Roofing Contractors

b. Senate Bill No. 601, H.D. 1

This bill prohibits roofing contractors from offering to pay, in any monetary form, an insured's insurance deductible as an incentive to encourage the insured to hire the contractor. Allows insureds to rescind contracts with roofing contractors within five business days of receiving notification from an insurer that all or any part of a claim or contract is not a covered loss under the insured's insurance policy.

S.B. 601, S.D.1, H.D.1 was referred to FIN and a hearing was not scheduled.

c. Senate Bill No. 1327, S.D. 1

This bill amends or repeals various provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) or the Session Laws of Hawaii for the purposes of correcting errors and references, clarifying language, or deleting obsolete or unnecessary provisions.

This is an omnibus bill which amends various statutes. With regard to chapter 444, an earlier version this bill moved the definition of "person injured" or "injured person" from section 444-26(b) to section 444-1. Subsequently, JDC restored the definition of "person injured" or "injured person" back to section 444-26(b). The Board is tracking this measure.

On April 14, 2021, S.B. No. 1327 S.D.1 was enrolled to the Governor.

Relating to Boards and Commissions

d. Senate Bill No. 610, S.D. 1, H.D. 1

This bill (1) prohibits a public member of any board or commission under the Department's purview from being engaged in the occupation that the board or commission regulates or having other direct legal or financial interests in the regulated occupation; and (2) specify that public members represent the public interest.

S.B. No. 610 S.D.1, H.D.1 was referred to CPC and a hearing was not scheduled.

e. House Concurrent Resolution No. 141, H.D. 1/House Resolution No. 120

Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 194/Senate Resolution No. 159

Requesting the Legislative Reference Bureau to conduct a study of best practices regarding the performance of "incidental and supplemental" contracting work.

On March 30, 2021, FIN held a hearing on H.C.R. No. 141, H.D.1 and H.R. No. 120, H.D.1 and passed these measures unamended.

H.C.R. No. 141, H.D.1 was referred to CPN and WAM. Neither committee scheduled a hearing.

The House adopted H.R. No. 120, H.D.1 in final form. S.C.R. No. 194/S.R. No. 159: On March 25, 2021, CPN held a hearing on these resolutions and deferred these measures.

It was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to approve the above positions on the bills as stated above.
