Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 12:06 p.m. by Chairperson Severson,

at which time a quorum was established.

Chairperson Severson proceeded with roll call. All Board members were

present.

Minutes of the July 27, 2021
Board Meeting:

Chairperson Severson asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

Mr. Murata requested for a correction on page 2, fourth paragraph:

"[Mr.] Ms. Hall nominated Ms. Amanda Severson as Chairperson."

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Murata, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Williams, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the July 27, 2021 meeting as circulated with the aforementioned amendment (with new material underscored and repealed material bracketed and stricken through).

Licensing:

Chairperson Severson asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

A. Ratification of Issued Licenses

It was moved by Ms. Hall, seconded by Mr. Murata, and unanimously carried to ratify the list of issued licenses attached (<u>see</u>, attached list).

B. <u>Status on the Proposed Administration Bill</u>

Executive Officer Yam reported that the proposed administration bill is currently being reviewed by DCCA Director's Office. She will report back to the Board when there is any update, and a copy of the proposed administration bill will also be disseminated to the major schools and beauty/barber shops for review.

C. October 2-4, 2021 Annual NIC Conference at Louisville, Kentucky

> Executive Officer Yam indicated that DCCA is not approving outof-State travel for business purposes right now, but members may still attend on their own accord. She was informed by NIC that a portion of the conference will be recorded and posted on their website.

> A tentative agenda was provided to Board members. The various topics will be discussed at the October 2-4, 2021 Annual NIC Conference, such as:

- National Credential and Database Demonstration
- Regulation & Legislative Issues
- CDC Recommendations on Cleaning and Disinfection
- American Industrial Hygiene Association

Complaints Office ("RICO"): Advisory

Regulated Industries Chairperson Severson asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

Committee Members: The Board reviewed the RICO Barbering and Cosmetology Advisory Committee List effective January 1, 2022. After due consideration of this information, it was moved by Chairperson Severson, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Williams, and unanimously carried to accept the RICO Barbering and Cosmetology Advisory Committee list with any additional interim appointees that RICO deems necessary to aid in its investigations.

Rules ("HAR") Chapters 73 and 78 - HAR Provisions Regarding Medical Clearance:

Hawaii Administrative Executive Officer Yam asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

> Executive Officer Yam explained that this matter was discussed at the July 27, 2021 meeting; however, the Board did not vote on this matter. After discussion, it was moved by Vice-Chairperson Williams, seconded by Mr. Murata, and unanimously carried to clarify that the HAR §§16-75-56 and 16-78-78 are considered "null, void, or unnecessary" in accordance with HRS §91-3(g) and to further state that the Department of Health, County offices, the Office of the Governor, and federal government agencies such as the CDC would be more appropriate agencies to determine whether a medical clearance certificate should be required to protect the public health.

COVID-19 Guidelines for Barbering and Cosmetology:

Executive Officer Yam asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

Executive Officer Yam reported that the Twenty-First Proclamation Related to the COVID-19 Emergency expired on August 6, 2021. The newest Emergency Proclamation Related to the COVID-19 Response no longer includes any provisions regarding the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology, which included the removal of the Exhibit F "Rules Relating

to Safety Guidelines for Barber and Beauty Operators" document that was included in the previous Twenty-First Proclamation Related to the COVID-19 Emergency.

Executive Officer Yam drafted a guidance FAQ document and disseminated to the Board for review and discussion. The FAQ draft included general information for the industry on where to find the latest Emergency Proclamations, contact information for county offices, and CDC reference guidance information. She stated that as industry members and licensees of the Board, one would still need to abide by any State or county orders and the current statutes and rules.

Ms. Hall recommended for the guidance FAQ document to include the COVID-19 hotline for further assistance.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Hall, seconded by Mr. Murata, and unanimously carried to approve the guidance FAQ document and instruct Executive Officer Yam to make the document available for the public and industry on the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology's website.
