1. Call to Order: There being a guorum present, Chair Nagashima called the meeting to

order at 9:38 a.m.

Chair Nagashima noted a typo on the agenda and that the minutes being

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to

provide oral testimony on this agenda item.

Meeting: Chair Nagashima requested the following correction to the

Upon a motion by Ms. Bath, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the June 24, 2021 meeting as amended.

Chair Nagashima asked if there were any comments or concerns regarding the Executive Session minutes of the June 24, 2021 meeting. There were none.

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the Executive Session minutes of the June 24, 2021 meeting as circulated.

3. Applications:

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

a. Ratifications (see attached Addendum)

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the attached ratification list.

b. Applications

Executive Session:

At 9:43 a.m., it was moved by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Bath, and unanimously carried to move into Executive Session in accordance with HRS, § 92-5(a)(1) and (4), "To consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in section 26-9 or both;" and "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities."

At 10:31 a.m., it was moved by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, and unanimously carried to move out of Executive Session.

1) RCM Mobile Massage and Spa LLC

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve RCM Mobile Massage and Spa LLC's application.

2) Hawaii Healing Arts College

Upon a motion by Ms. Okura, seconded by Ms. Bath, it was voted on and unanimously carried that based on the review of Hawaii

Healing Arts College's application and supporting documents, the school's curriculum meets the Board's minimum education and training hours required for an applicant to obtain a license in massage therapy. The Board directed the EO to issue an approval letter valid through the DOE licensure period from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2023.

3) Maui School of Therapeutic Massage

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Bath, it was voted on and unanimously carried that based on the review of Maui School of Therapeutic Massage's application and supporting documents, the school's curriculum meets the Board's minimum education and training hours required for an applicant to obtain a license in massage therapy. The Board directed the EO to issue an approval letter valid through the DOE licensure period from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2023.

4) Heaven on Earth Wellness Academy

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried that based on the review of Heaven on Earth Wellness Academy's application and supporting documents, the school's curriculum does not meet the Board's minimum education and training hours required for an applicant to obtain a license in massage therapy. The Board directed the EO to issue a deferral letter requesting additional documentation.

5) Corey Thompson

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to defer Mr. Thompson application requesting additional documentation.

6) Sora Kiyose

Upon a motion by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve Ms. Kiyose to sit for the Hawaii Massage Therapy examination.

4. Executive Officer's Report:

a. Looking for two (2) public members to serve on the Board

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

EO Doi stated the Governor recently appointed a public member. There is

currently one more public member position open with the Board of Massage Therapy.

Executive Session:

At 10:41 a.m., it was moved by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Bath, and unanimously carried to move into Executive Session in accordance with HRS, § 92-5(a)(1) and (4), "To consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in section 26-9 or both;" and "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities."

At 10:44 a.m., it was moved by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Okura, and unanimously carried to move out of Executive Session.

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

5. <u>New</u> <u>Business</u>:

a. <u>Regulated Industries Complaint Office ("RICO") Massage</u>
<u>Therapy Advisory Committee</u>

It was moved by Chair Nagashima, seconded by Ms. Bath, and unanimously carried to approve the RICO Massage Therapy Advisory Committee listing.

b. Review draft of continuing education ("CE") rulemaking

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

EO Doi shared a recent draft of CE rule revisions based on the suggestions that were discussed at the June 24, 2021 meeting. The draft included new sections to address the renewal of a massage therapist license, restoration of a forfeited massage license, and CE requirements.

The Board discussed the parameters for fulfilling CE requirements.

The Board recommended that the following amendments be made relating to renewal of a massage therapist license (bracketed material to be deleted, underlined material to be added):

Each licensee shall be responsible for the timely renewing of the licensee's license, completing the continuing education ("CE") requirement, and satisfying the renewal requirements provided by law. Licensees who wish to renew their license as inactive status shall be required to submit [proof]evidence of completion of [CE] twelve hours for each renewal period with the minimum twelve hours required in the preceding biennium upon reactivation for the period that the license was

inactive.

The Board recommended that the following amendments be made relating to the restoration of a massage therapist license (bracketed material to be deleted, underlined material to be added):

- (a) A license which has been forfeited may be restored within one year after the date of expiration upon compliance with the licensing renewal requirements provided by law and upon written application and payment of all applicable renewal fees, penalty fees, and compliance resolution fund fees.
- (b) A forfeited license may be restored after one year from the date of expiration upon:
 - (1) Written application and payment of all applicable fees;
 - (2) <u>Submitting evidence of completion of CE requirements of a minimum of twelve hours for each renewal period with the minimum twelve hours required in the preceding biennium; and</u>
 - (3) If the person is unable to meet the above requirements, the person shall be required to reapply as a new applicant and the board may require the person to take and pass the licensure examination and satisfy all requirements for the examination, including training, if the board is not satisfied that the person possesses current knowledge and skills for the practice of massage therapy.
- c. <u>Discussion of residential massage therapy establishments and</u> sanitation requirements

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

Ms. Bath informed the Board of a discussion she had with Nicole Byrd regarding the topic of human trafficking and how it may affect massage therapists. Ms. Bath wanted to make the Board aware of appropriate terminology for those who are victims of human trafficking. Ms. Bath clarified she spoke with Ms. Byrd as an individual and not as a Board member.

6. <u>Unfinished</u> a. <u>Rule Revisions – Title 16, Chapter 84, Hawaii Administrative</u>
<u>Business:</u> <u>Rules</u>

Chair Nagashima asked if any members of the public would like to provide oral testimony on this agenda item. There were none.

Ms. Bath shared the revised rule revisions where the definition of "Principal Massage Therapist" was removed.

Chair Nagashima advised that the "sponsoring massage therapist" shall be in charge of making sure the massage apprentice is wearing a name tag which states their title as an apprentice.

The Board concluded the statutes must be revised before the rules may be amended.
