Mr. Lance Lam addressed the board. He claimed to have turned in his application way ahead of the July deadline and is concerned that only today his application was being reviewed. EO Matsushima will contact him after the meeting to discuss the status of his application. (After the meeting, EO Matsushima consulted with the licensing clerk and Mr. Lam will be allowed to register for the October exam.)

New Business: None.

Permitted Interaction Group ("P.I.G.") pursuant to Old Business:

§92-2.5(b)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to investigate and provide recommendations regarding the potential acceptance of electronic digital signatures on plans, specifications, maps, reports, surveys, descriptions and design drawings prepared by or under the supervision of a licensed professional engineer, architect, land surveyor, or landscape architect that are to be filed with public officials.

The PIG deferred to EO Matsushima and DAG Leong to propose language. EO Matsushima sent draft language in regards to digital signatures to the board. The language referenced was taken from the NV board, who took the definition of digital signatures from the Oxford dictionary and amended their laws. EO Matsushima presented draft language which proposes to add a definition of "digital signature" and amend subsection (e) to allow for digital signatures.

§16-115-2 Definitions

"Digital signature" means a digital code, generated and authenticated by public key encryption, which is attached to an electronically transmitted document to verify its contents and the sender's identity.

A digital signature contains encryption protections using a set of algorithms to determine authenticity of a document.

§16-115-9 <u>Authentication: preparation or supervision of design</u> and observation of construction.

(e) All signatures required under this section shall be original[-], provided that a digital signature is acceptable. The use of rubber signature stamps[, or computer-generated] or other facsimile signatures is prohibited.

The PIG will review the draft language and provide comments at the next Board meeting.

Executive Officer's Report

NCEES Resolution of Cooperation to Facilitate Interstate Licensure Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors;

This was mainly intended for the engineers and land surveyors. Other

state MBEs took the matter before their boards. Previously, EO Matsushima ran this past the engineers and surveyors, and they had no comments. However, in these past months, many of the other boards have responded to the NCEES. These states appear evenly split amongst the yes, no, or no action taken votes. EO Matsushima spoke with DAG Leong and he advised that it wouldn't impact this board whether or not they sign it. She requested the Board to review and comment so she could notify the NCEES on their position.

The following states agreed with the resolution: TX, MO, NV, DE, VA, NB, WY, AR, OH

The following states either voted no or no action was taken: ND, FL, AL, IL, WA, CA, MD, IN, KY.

The states with no position are ME, NM, KS, OR and WV. Not all of the member states have responded.

Mr. Lau doesn't agree with the resolution, so his vote would be no. It was moved by Mr. Lau and seconded by Mr. Hirota to not sign off on the resolution. A roll call vote was taken and it was unanimously carried not to sign the resolution.

EO Matsushima will notify the NCEES of the Board's "no" position.

Comments to the Resolution of Cooperation from the California Board of Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists;

In relation to the NCEES Resolution, written comments were made by the California Board stating their opposition to the resolution and the reasons why they were opposing the resolution. This document was provided to the board members in their packets and EO Matsushima briefly discussed this matter with the board.
