Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Isemoto called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Leong, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of May 2, 2022, the Board Meeting Minutes of April 22, 2022, the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of March 24, 2022, as circulated, and defer the approval of the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of April 22, 2022.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory

Matters: Chairperson Isemoto called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:09 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

- a. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Kauai Premier Builders LLC and Todd Dorny; CLB 2022-27-L

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to defer the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Torres Roofing, LLC and Frank L. Torres; CLB 2021-105-L

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to defer the Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

- c. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Duarte Lima; CLB 2021-283-L

RICO alleges that on or about October 29, 2018, Duarte N. Lima ("Respondent") registered with the State of Hawaii the tradename Acacia Construction ("Acacia").

RICO alleges that Respondent advertised for contracting services, including but not limited to home construction and remodeling, in Acacia's name and on Acacia's website.

RICO alleges that Respondent used his license number on Acacia's website. Respondent did not state that the license number was Respondent's and not Acacia's.

RICO alleges that Respondent did not register any trade name that he would operate under with the Board.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: Hawaii Revised Statutes section 444-17(12) (failure to adhere to the rules adopted pursuant to Chapter 444), specifically Hawaii Administrative Rules section 16-77-8(a) (failure to register in writing a trade name used by a contracting entity).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to defer the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

- d. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of CDT Island Construction Incorporated and Chad Kwock On Tom; CLB 2020-450-L

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to defer the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above case.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Isemoto announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:25 a.m.

At 11:39 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Nishek, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

It was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried to defer Benjamin K. Steele's application for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of a revised project list (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees constructing a building from the "ground-up" noting the trades performed in-house with his own employees and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. The revised project list must include a detailed description of the projects and the work he supervised within the broad scope of the "B" General building classification. The "Amount of Supervisory Experience" on the revised project list should only include the actual amount of time he spent on-site supervising his employees performing work in the broad scope of the "B" General building classification; do not include the time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling or downtime for rain-outs or waiting for delivery of materials. Mr. Steele may include projects that date back beyond ten years. The Board requested that Mr. Steele provide a copy of his transcripts or diploma for his Bachelor of Science in Construction Management degree.

It was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to approve Mr. Nishikawa's request to withdraw his application in the "A" General engineering and "B" General building classifications; amend his application to apply for the C-31a Cement concrete classification; and defer his application for licensure in the C-31a Cement concrete classification pending the submittal of an Additional Classification application from Haleakala Invest Co. Ltd. for the C-31a classification, and a project list verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the C-31a classification noting the work performed in house and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. The "Amount of Supervisory Experience" on the C-31a project list should only include the actual amount of time he spent on-site supervising his employees performing work in the broad scope of the C-31a Cement concrete classification; do not include the time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling or downtime for rain-outs or waiting for delivery of materials.

7. Legislative Committee: Neal Arita, Chairperson

Relating to Electrical Contractors

Senate Bill No. 2644, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, C.D. 1

Extends until 6/30/2027 Act 65, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, as amended by Act 60, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, which provides a limited exemption to the licensing requirements for certain individuals in situations when an electric utility must retain qualified individuals to work

with high voltage (six hundred volts or higher) who are not licensed in the State but are otherwise deemed qualified by the electric utility, provided that the public utility certifies to the Board of Electricians and Plumbers that, after solicitation of a request for proposal, no electrician responded to the request who was sufficiently qualified and licensed in the State and was available and able to perform or timely complete the high voltage electrical work or task before the public utility recruited outside the State.

The Conference Committee amended this measure by:

- (1) Specifying that, before a duly licensed contractor hired by the public utility may recruit qualified electricians who are not licensed in Hawaii, the public utility shall:
 - (A) Solicit a request for proposals to licensed contractors specifying the high voltage work requested, which shall also be made available through its website in an electronic format to C-62 Pole and line and C-63 High voltage electrical contractors; and
 - (B) Certify to the Board of Electricians and Plumbers that no electricians (including electricians employed by C-62 Pole and line or C-63 High voltage electrical contractors) responded to the request for proposal who were sufficiently qualified and licensed in the State and available and able to perform or timely complete the high voltage electrical work or task;
- (2) Requiring the public utility to submit an annual report to the Board of Electricians and Plumbers covering the preceding calendar year that identifies, at a minimum:
 - (A) The number of qualified contractors the public utility employed to perform high voltage electrical work; and
 - (B) The number of requests for proposals solicited for high voltage work;
- (3) Clarifying the licensure exemption is limited to the use by a public utility for high voltage electrical workers who perform electric transmission and distribution line construction, maintenance, and connection to substation work;
- (4) Deleting language that would have permanently required the Board of the Electricians and Plumbers to submit annual reports to the Legislature containing certain information;
- (5) Extending the repeal date of Act 65, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, as amended by Act 60, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, to 2027 and further amending Act 60 to require the Board of Electricians and Plumbers to submit annual reports to the Legislature prior to the convening of the regular sessions of 2023 through 2027;
- (6) Amending section 1 to reflect its amended purpose;
- (7) Inserting an effective date of July 1, 2022; and

(8) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.
