Virtual Meeting Instructions: A short video regarding virtual meetings was played for attendees.

Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

Call to Order: The Chair took roll call of the Board members.

In accordance with Act 220, SLH 2021, all Board members attending virtually confirmed that they were alone in their nonpublic location. After taking roll, quorum was established, and the Chair called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

Chair's Report:

**Announcements**

The Chair had no announcements.

**Approval of the Minutes of the March 16, 2022, Meeting**

The Chair asked if any members of the public would like to provide testimony on this agenda item. There was none.

The Chair asked if there was any discussion on the minutes. Being none, upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Mr. Arakaki, it was voted on with the Chair, Vice Chair and Mr. Arakaki voting yes and Ms. Frankel abstaining to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2022, meeting as circulated. The motion carried.

Executive Officer's Report:

**Rule Revisions – Title 16, Chapter 84, Hawaii Administrative Rules**

The EO stated that she had reviewed the latest draft of the amendments and made the following changes for clarification:

On page 84-4, added the definition for continuing education, "Continuing education" means a course or courses that expand knowledge and education in the practice of massage therapy."

On page 84-5, the title of §16-84-3, "Renewal of massage therapist license;" was amended to read, "Renewal, restoration, reactivation of massage therapist license; continuing education; audit."

She stated that the title now clearly clarifies what is included in this section.

The Vice Chair asked how many CEs are required for licensees who will be renewing their license on inactive status.

The EO responded that a licensee who renews their license on inactive status will not have to complete the CE requirement. However, when reactivating the license, the licensee will need to submit proof that they have completed the CE requirement for the most recent biennium.

The Board recommended that this be clarified in the rules.

Ms. Frankel asked if there will be exceptions or waivers for CEs if another pandemic occurs.

The EO stated that the CE courses are not required to be in person and the statute did not authorize the Board to establish exceptions to the CE requirement.

The Vice Chair stated there are only 12 hours of required CE for a two-year renewal and therefore doesn't see a need to have exceptions or waivers at this time.

The EO stated that she also included that when the licensee renews his/her massage therapist license, he/she will "attest" that they completed the CE requirement prior to renewing their license. She stated that this is similar to other professions that require CE.

Also, on page 84-14, §16-84-19 was amended to add the following language to enforce the filing of a false attestation:

"Submitting to or filing with the board any notice, statement, or other document required under this chapter, which is false or untrue or contains any material misstatement of fact, including a false attestation of compliance with the continuing education requirement."

*At 9:43 a.m. Ms. Frankel lost internet connection. However, the Board still had quorum and continued their discussion.*

The EO referred to page 84-12, Subchapter 4.1, Sanitation, §16-84-16 Sanitary practices. The EO addressed that this section referred to "guidelines" for a massage establishment, stating that "guidelines" are suggestions, not rules, therefore can be difficult to "enforce". The EO asked the Board whether they would consider changing the terminology from "guideline" to "requirement".

The Board confirmed that these are "requirements" and not guidelines.

Next, the EO addressed Subchapter 13, Continuing education, on page 84-23 and continuing to the top of page 84-25. She stated the title to §16-84-51 Continuing education was amended for clarification to read, "Continuing education courses; providers."

The EO asked Board members for clarification on the CE learning categories as currently listed in this section as follows:

“All eligible continuing education (“CE”) categories shall be learning experiences that enhance and expand the skills, knowledge, and attitudes of massage therapists that enable them to render competent professional service to clients, the profession, and the public.”

The Board discussed and agreed to remove “attitudes” and replace it with “professionalism or ethics”.

In the next section pertaining to CE providers, the Board agreed to recognize state board-approved or accredited massage schools as providers of CE and ensure that Hawaii massage schools are also included.

On page 84-25, the EO recommended the title for §16-84-52, “Certification of attendance” be amended to read “Completion certificate” to clarify that the licensee must “complete” the CE course rather than just attend.

The Chair asked if there was anyone attending who wishes to address the Board on the proposed amendments to the administrative rules.

Staff reported that no one raised their hand.

Applications:

The Chair asked if any members of the public would like to provide testimony on this agenda item.

Staff reported that no one raised their hand.

Upon a motion by the Chair, seconded by the Vice Chair, it was voted on with the Chair, Vice Chair and Mr. Arakaki voting yes to approve the attached ratification list.

The Chair stated that she will be recusing herself from discussion and decision on the applicant and deferred to the Vice Chair.

Executive Session:

At 9:55 a.m., upon a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by Ms. Frankel, it was voted on with the Vice Chair, Ms. Frankel and Mr. Arakaki voting yes move into executive session in accordance with HRS, § 92-5(a)(1) and (4), “To consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or

vocational licenses cited in section 26-9 or both;” and “To consult with the board’s attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board’s powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.”

The motion carried.

The Board resumed the meeting at 10:02 a.m. after coming out of executive session.
