1. <u>SB 3084/HB 2116 Relating to the Elevator Mechanics Licensing</u>
<u>Board Composition</u>

Report Title: Elevator; Elevator Mechanic; Board; License;

Chapter 448H

**Description:** Amends the composition of the Elevator Mechanics Licensing Board to replace the ex-officio Department of Labor and Industrial Relations member with a licensed elevator mechanic member.

EO Skizewski stated that HB 2116 has gone through the process and that he is working with the administration to see when the Board can start having another licensed elevator mechanic as a member. Once the applications come in, the process should go rather quickly so the new member will be temporarily appointed until they get reconfirmed at the next legislative session.
