Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Arita called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. O'Donnell, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of October 31, 2022, and the Board Meeting Minutes of October 21, 2022, as circulated.

Amendment to Agenda:

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to approve the following amendment to the agenda:

Addition to Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters: 1. Settlement Agreements:

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of H.K. Construction Corp. and Angie C. Kim; CLB 2020-213-L

Committee Reports:

1. Scope of Activity Committee:

Paul Alejado and John Polischeck, Co-Chairpersons

- a. City and County of Honolulu, Department of Planning and Permitting

Requests a determination on whether any employee of the licensed "A" General engineering contractor (which could include a minimum wage entry level laborer) is allowed to perform the C-37a (Sewer drain line) or C-43 (Sewer, sewage disposal, drain, and pipe laying) pipe installations without supervision as long as it is beyond five feet of the building line.

The Board reviewed the City and County of Honolulu, Department of Planning and Permitting emails and inquiry, and the testimony submitted by the Hawaii Laborers-Employers Cooperation and Education Trust, Laborers' International Union of North America Local 368 ("Hawaii Laborer's Union"), General Contractors Association of Hawaii, Hawaii Operating Engineers Industry Stabilization Fund, and Mr. Leonard Leong.

Mr. Ryan Kobayashi, Hawaii Laborer's Union, stated that the "A" General engineering license is allowed to do this type of work and traditionally has performed this work. The contractor statutes are silent on the type of employee and the supervision required over the employee. Thus, the Hawaii Laborer's Union believes that the "A" General engineering contractor has the discretion to select and supervise their employee that performs the work. In addition, the definition of plumbing work in the Board of Electricians and Plumbers' Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") section 16-80-3 states that other properly licensed contractors are not prohibited from performing any exterior piping work five feet or more outside the building line without licensed plumbers.

Mr. Kobayashi also presented his testimony on item 1b, the inquiry from the Hawaii Department of Education, Office of Facilities and Operations - Kailua High School Replace Underground Sewer Line Project, Work Order # 2181052. Similar to this inquiry, the Hawaii Laborers Union believes that the "A" General engineering contractor

should be allowed to perform the Kailua High School Replace Underground Sewer Line Project.

Executive Session:

At 9:08 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4) to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.

At 9:23 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, it is not within the Board's jurisdiction to make a determination on this inquiry.

- b. Hawaii Department of Education, Office of Facilities and Operations - Kailua High School Replace Underground Sewer Line Project, Work Order # 2181052

Requests a determination on whether the C-37 Plumbing or C-37a Sewer and drain line contractor is required to perform the Kailua High School Replace Underground Sewer Line project; and if this project requires a C-37 Plumbing contractor, in what situations would a C-37a Sewer and drain line contractor be required.

The Board reviewed the information provided by the Hawaii Department of Education, Office of Facilities and Operations ("DOE").

Mr. Ryan Ichimura, DOE, stated that the project is to replace the entire sewer line running from the restrooms in the cafeteria, under the concrete slab, to the cleanout outside of the building. He is asking for a clarification on whether a C-37 Plumbing or a C-37a Sewer and drain line contractor is required to perform this work.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, the C-37 Plumbing contractor's license is required to perform the Kailua High School Replace Underground Sewer Line project. With regard to the inquiry of what situations a C-37a Sewer and drain line contractor would be required, the Board is unable to provide a determination because the Board responds to scope inquiries on a case-by-case basis by reviewing a project's plans and specifications. This is a hypothetical inquiry that does not pertain to a specific project.

- c. Jim Markiewicz - Fleetwood Aluminum Sliding Glass Doors and Aluminum Framed Glass Windows

Requests a determination on the contractor license classification required to install the Fleetwood Aluminum Sliding Door Series 3050, 3070, and 3200-T; and Fleetwood Aluminum Framed Glass Window Series 2050-T.

The Board reviewed the information submitted by Mr. Markiewicz and the testimony submitted by the Hawaii Glaziers, Architectural Metal Glassworkers Local Union 1889 AFL-CIO Stabilization Trust Fund ("Glaziers Stabilization Trust Fund").

Chairperson Arita informed Mr. Markiewicz that the Board is aware of his complaint with the Regulated Industries Complaints Office and that the Board will not discuss that complaint.

Mr. Markiewicz stated that he is a retired professional engineer who practiced for 36 years and is registered in 5 states. Before that he was a Chicago Local 399 operating engineer.

Mr. Markiewicz stated that he has 2 questions for the Board:

- What license is required to field assemble and install Fleetwood large Aluminum Sliding Doors, block framed, double pane glass in new construction? For instance, the series 3050 doors are 10' tall, 6'9" wide with a 34 foot track. They are very large doors and are field assembled. He stated that he submitted documents that show that the series 3050 and 3070 Fleetwood doors are block framed and field assembled and that the series 3200-T doors are block framed. He also submitted installation procedures and instructions for the series 3050, 3070 and 3200-T doors; and
- What license is required to field assemble and install Fleetwood Large Aluminum Framed Glass Windows, block framed, double pane glass in new construction? There are 7 panes of glass that are 8'7" x 7'6" in dimension; 2 panes that are 13' long and 5' high (big triangles); and 2 panes that are 11' long x 4'2" wide. These are custom windows. The series 250-T is block framed and the shipping instructions say that the glass is to be wood crated and requires field glazing as noted.

Mr. Markiewicz clarified that this was a new project, new construction, not a remodel or repair work. In the contract, the general contractor ("GC") specified glazing by a C-22 license. Executive Officer Ito reminded Mr. Markiewicz that the Board will not be discussing his RICO complaint and asked that he limit his testimony to the installation of the windows and doors. She stated that the Board needs information on the product and how it is installed to determine which contractor's license is required.

Chairperson Arita asked if the installation required a certification from the factory. Mr. Markiewicz stated that he does not know.

Dwayne Arelliano, Glaziers Union DC 50 stated that he has been in the trade for 41 years and worked for AA Aluminum for 17 years as a lead foreman. AA Aluminum specialized in Fleetwood windows. He went on to say that the work is under the scope of the C-22 Glazing and tinting license and that it poses a danger to the public if it is not installed properly. It's predominately the glaziers that put together the

loose glass into assembled frames and they are also responsible for any kind of leakage problems and issues that may occur due to improper installation. Their union trains their apprentices for 10,000 hours before they become a journeyman and are able to properly install these windows and doors.

Jeff Masatsugu, Glaziers Stabilization Trust Fund, summarized his written testimony. He stated that this is highly specialized work which requires far more skill than simply nailing a framed window system in place; therefore, the C-22 Glazing and tinting license should be required. He emphasized that according to Mr. Markiewicz's testimony, this is new construction, not repair or renovation and that means it would be inappropriate to allow this work to be done as incidental and supplemental work under the C-5 Cabinet, millwork and carpentry remodeling and repairs classification.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, the C-22 Glazing and tinting contractor's license is required to install the Fleetwood Aluminum Sliding Door Series 3050, 3070, and 3200-T; and Fleetwood Aluminum Framed Glass Window Series 2050-T.

- d. Hawaii Department of Transportation, Airports Division – T-Hangar, Roll-Up, & Overhead Door Maintenance, State Project No. BS1322-43, 2022

Requests a determination on whether a C-25 Institutional and commercial equipment contractor may perform repair and maintenance services on aircraft hangar doors and roll up doors that have motors that raise and lower them.

The Board reviewed the information submitted by the Hawaii Department of Transportation, Airports Division.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, the C-48 Structural steel or C-48a Steel door contractor's license is required to perform repair and maintenance services on aircraft hangar doors and roll up doors that have motors that raise and lower them.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischek and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendations.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Chairperson Arita called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:43 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

- a. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Lankford Construction Company; Bruce Vernooy; CLB 2021-198-L

RICO alleges that Lankford Construction Company and Bruce Vernooy ("Respondents") contracted with an unlicensed contractor to performing flooring work and renovation of the Target store located at 4380 Lawehana Street, Honolulu, Hawaii in 2021 (the "Project") and that Respondent Vernooy was not in Hawaii during the work on the Project.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute a violation of the following statute and rules: Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 444-17(17) (entering into a contract with an unlicensed contractor for work requiring a license) and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") sections 16-77-71(a)(4) (RME shall be in residence in the State of Hawaii during the period a project is under construction) and 16-77-71(a)(5) (RME responsible for violations of HRS chapter 444 and HAR Title 16 Chapter 77).

Respondents agreed to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$100,000.00.

A typographical error was noted in paragraphs A.1. and A.2.: "The license will expire or forfeit on or about September **30**, 2024."

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to approve the above Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action.

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of H.K. Construction Corp. and Angie C. Kim; CLB 2020-213-L

In or about October 2017, H.K. Construction Corp. and Angie C. Kim ("Respondents") entered into a written contract to demolish an existing structure and construct a new single-family dwelling at a homeowner's property in Honolulu.

Although that contract included written disclosures regarding the lien rights of the parties performing under the contract, the homeowners' option to demand bonding on the project, and Respondent's right(s) as contractors to resolve any alleged construction defects in accordance with HRS section 672E-11, it did not, however, include the names and license numbers of two sub-contractors that were to provide and did not provide work on the underlying project.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: Hawaii

Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 444-17(12) (failing to any material respect to comply with this chapter [HRS Chapter 444] or the rules adopted pursuant thereto); and Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”) section 16-77-80(a)(5) (providing that written contracts with homeowners shall include the approximate percentage of work to be subcontracted and the names and license numbers of all subcontractors, if any).

Respondents have fully cooperated in RICO’s investigation of this matter.

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to approve the above Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action.

Following the Board’s review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Arita announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:46 a.m.

At 12:15 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board’s regular order of business.
