Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Arita called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 92-7(b).

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Torigoe, and unanimously carried to approve the Application Committee Meeting Minutes of April 3, 2023, and the Board Meeting Minutes of March 24, 2023.

Amendments to Agenda:

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Nishek, and unanimously carried to approve the following amendments to the agenda:

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Chairperson Arita called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:06 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractor Licenses of Custom Contractors, Inc., and Robin Kameda, RME; CLB 2022-299-L

On or about December 15, 2021, Respondents Custom Contractors, Inc. ("Respondent CCI") and Robin Kameda ("Respondent Kameda") entered into a written sales agreement (the "Agreement") with John Victoria for the purchase and installation of one bedroom and two living room windows in exchange for payment of \$12,621.02. The Agreement was signed by Victoria but not by the Respondent CCI.

The Agreement header contained Respondent CCI's trade name "CCI, the Window Company". Respondent CCI has not filed its trade name "CCI, the Window Company" with the Board.

The Agreement did not contain required written disclosures, including lien/bond rights and contractor's right to repair any alleged defects.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations could constitute violations of the following Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") and/or Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR"):

- HRS § 444-25.5(b) (written contract shall contain information such as lien/bond rights and notice of contractor's right to repair and be signed by the contractor and homeowner);
- HAR § 16-77-71(a)(2) (RME primarily responsible for direct management of the business of the contracting entity, including reviewing and signing all contracts); and
- HAR § 16-77-80(a)(9) (written contact shall contain the signatures of the homeowner and contractor).

Respondents shall jointly and severally pay an administrative fine of \$1,000.00.

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of DJ's Construction Inc. and David Crabbe Parker; CLB 2022-187-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that in April of 2021, Gavin and Tina Gushiken ("the Gushikens") entered into a contract with DJ's Construction Inc. and David Crabbe Parker ("Respondents") for a renovation project at their residence in Honolulu, Hawaii. The project included removing and replacing cabinets, doing drywall work, installing tiles, and installing flooring in exchange for \$68,250.83.

The Gushikens paid Respondents \$50,400.00.

Respondents did not provide the Gushikens with any written or verbal bond and lien disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following laws and rules:

- HRS § 444-25.5(b) and HAR § 16-77-80(a) (failure to provide a written contract);
- HRS § 444-25.5(b)(1) and HAR §§ 16-77-80(a)(3), 16-77-80 (a)(7) and 16-77-71 (a)(2) (failure to include required contract disclosures); and
- HRS § 444-9.2(b) as to Respondent DJ's Construction Inc.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following laws and rules:

- HRS § 444-25.5(b) and HAR § 16-77-80(a) (failure to provide a written contract); and
- HRS § 444-25.5(b)(1) and HAR §§ 16-77-80(a)(3), 16-77-80 (a)(7) and 16-77-71 (a)(2) (failure to include required contract disclosures) as to Respondent David Crabbe Parker.

Respondents agree to jointly and severally pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

- a. Emergency Drain Cleaning & Plumbing Svcs LLC, doing business as Emergency Plumbing and Solar, and Calvin R. Gulia, Jr.; CLB 2021-94-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that Emergency Drain Cleaning & Plumbing Svcs LLC, doing business as Emergency Plumbing and Solar and Calvin R. Gulia, Jr. ("Respondents") failed to complete installation of a solar water heater, poor workmanship, that the solar water heater was installed without permits required, and that Respondents had failed to provide the complainant ("Complainant") with a copy of the contract disclosing lien and bond rights.

RICO alleges that in December 2020, Complainant's electric water heater stopped working. Complainant called Respondent Emergency Drain Cleaning & Plumbing Svcs LLC, doing business as Emergency Plumbing and Solar ("Respondent Emergency") and agreed to a proposal from Respondent

Emergency to install a solar water heater for \$15,000.00. On or about December 8, 2020, Respondent Emergency's employee, journey worker plumber Jesse Mitchell ("Mitchell"), arrived at Complainant's house to have Complainant sign the contract for \$15,167.53, with an initial payment of \$7,500.00 (the "Contract"), which Complainant signed on an iPad and remitted the initial payment. The Contract made lien and bond disclosures but was not signed by Calvin R. Gulia, Jr. ("Respondent Gulia") at the time Complainant executed it, and no commencement date and number of days to completion were stated. Mitchell stated that a copy would be provided to Complainant, but no copy was ever provided to Complainant. Approximately two days after Complainant signed the Contract, Mitchell commenced installation of the solar water heater and completed installation the same day. Mitchell connected the power to the solar water heater, but Mitchell was not a licensed electrician.

If proven at an administrative hearing the above allegations could constitute violations of the following statutes and/or rules:

- HRS § 436B-19(16) ("Employing, utilizing, or attempting to employ or utilize at any time any person not licensed under the licensing laws where licensure is required");
- HRS § 436B-19(17) ("Violating this chapter, the applicable licensing laws, or any rule or order of the licensing authority");
- HAR § 16-77-80(a)(3) ("All the contractors shall provide homeowners with a written contract . . . which shall provide . . . the date work is to commence and number of days for completion"); and
- HAR § 16-77-80(a)(9) ("All contractors shall provide homeowners with a written contract which shall provide the signatures of the homeowner and the contractor").

Respondents agree to pay, jointly and severally, an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,500.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to approve the Settle Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order in the above cases.

2. Board's Final Order

In the Matter of the Application for Contractors License of David H. Fujikawa, RME; CLB-LIC-2022-002

At its February 24, 2023 meeting, the Board rejected the Hearings Officer's Recommended Order and deferred action on the Board's Final Order.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to defer action on the Board's Final Order.

3. Petition for Declaratory Relief

In the Matter of the Petition of James S. Markiewicz, Trustee, Joanne C. Markiewicz, Trustee for Declaratory Relief

James S. Markiewicz, Trustee and Joanne C. Markiewicz, Trustee's Petition for Declaratory Relief ("Petition") is seeking a binding opinion confirming the Contractors License Board's November 18, 2022 determination that a C-22 Glazing and tinting contractor's license is required to install Fleetwood Aluminum Sliding Door Series 3050, 3070, and 3200-T; and Fleetwood Aluminum Framed Glass Window Series 250-T.

The Board reviewed the Petition and after discussion, it was moved by Mr. O'Donnell, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to assign the Petition to a Hearings Officer for further proceedings in accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules Title 16, Chapter 201, Subchapter 3.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Arita announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:55 a.m.

performed in the same time period; and (2) signed and notarized Experience Certificates from the RMEs of Unlimited Inc., Husky Electrical Services Inc., and Hawaii Construction & Development Corporation describing your experience performing on-site supervision and direction of employees in the “B” General building classification.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to deny ANR Builders LLC’s application in accordance with HAR section 16-77-11(b), HRS sections 444-17(10) and 436B-19(5) for misrepresentation of a material fact, by the member of the entity, in obtaining a license by not disclosing prior convictions.

- c. Mark H. Shimabukuro, RME
Hawaiian Electric Co. Inc.
“A” General engineering

Mr. Shimabukuro requested the Board to reconsider the denial of his application for licensure in the “A” General engineering classification; and Hawaiian Electric also requested that if Mr. Shimabukuro does not possess enough experience supervising construction in other areas covered by the “A” General engineering license, he be granted a

conditional "A" General engineering license that would allow him and Hawaiian Electric to act as a general engineering contractor when performing customer utilities installation construction or other similar work requested by customers, such as the "make ready" program for the installation of electrical vehicle charging stations in Hawaii.

After careful consideration, the Board reaffirmed its October 21, 2022 denial of Mr. Shimabukuro's application for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification. With regard to the issuance of a conditional license, the Board does not issue conditional licenses under Hawaii Administrative Rules section 16-77-24 to an applicant who has not, at a minimum, met the experience requirement. The Board has always required an applicant to satisfy the experience requirement first before considering whether to issue a conditional license or not. In addition, Hawaiian Electric currently holds a C-13 Electrical contractor license which is the license required to install electrical vehicle charging stations. The "A" General engineering license is not the appropriate license to contract for the installation of electrical vehicle charging stations.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to deny Mr. Shimabukuro's request for reconsideration of the denial of his application for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification; and to deny Hawaiian Electric's request to grant Mr. Shimabukuro a conditional "A" General engineering license.

d. HOA Construction Consulting
Ryan L. Eck, RME
"B" General building

HOA Construction Consulting and Mr. Eck's applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification were deferred pending the submittal of (1) a revised project list, verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees constructing buildings from the "ground-up", which includes the trades performed in-house with his own employees and the trades that were subcontracted to other licensed contractors; (2) clarification of the entity applicant's name, HOA Construction Consulting, because the name of the entity is not consistent with the name registered with our Business Registration Division and on application documents; and (3) a copy of the license of the CPA that performed the financial statement. The Applications Committee of the Contractors License Board requested Mr. Eck's appearance at a Board meeting to discuss his application.

Mr. Eck requested that the Board determine whether or not HOA Construction Consulting requires a general building contractors license because it is a consulting firm. He stated that HOA Construction Consulting uses its construction knowledge and advice to consult exclusively with Home Owner Association Clients, aka Association of Apartment Owners ("AOAO"). The Board reviewed the definition of

“contractor” in HRS section 444-1 and HAR section 16-77-4. Based solely on the information provided by Mr. Eck and the definition of “contractor”, the Board determined that a “B” General building classification is not required for the work that HOA Construction Consulting stated that it is performing.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to defer HOA Construction Consulting and Ryan L. Eck’s applications for licensure in the “B” General building classification pending further communication from Mr. Eck.

Martin Steel Constructors Inc
C-41 Reinforcing steel

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to deny Martin Steel Constructors Inc. and Mr. Aguon-Kona’s applications for licensure in the C-41 Reinforcing steel classification in accordance with HAR section 16-77-11(a)(4), HRS sections 444-12(a) and 436B-10(a)(9) for failing to provide the additional information requested by the Board to demonstrate forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his employees performing projects in the broad scope of the C-41 Reinforcing steel classification.
