b. <u>Applications</u>

Michelle Kuroda was introduced to the Board. Ms. Kuroda stated she has been an acupuncturist for the past 20 years. She currently holds licensure in the state of California and has taken the California state exam. She is NCCAOM certified but did not take the NCCAOM exam. Ms. Kuroda asked the Board to consider her examination waiver.

Chair Kroll stated that the current rules and statues that govern the license do not accept the California exam or California Route 8. Applicants must pass the NCCAOM exam. Executive Officer Doi stated she reached out to NCCAOM and NCCAOM stated that the California exam is not equivalent to the NCCAOM exam. Dr. Kroll explained that the NCCAOM exam has different modules that the applicant needs to pass, while the California exam has questions on various areas. The Board advised Ms. Kuroda to complete the required NCCAOM modules for Diplomate of Acupuncture: Foundations of Oriental Medicine, Acupuncture with Point Location, and Biomedicine.

Kat Brooks asked about the Use of Doctor Tile application. Dr. Kroll clarified that one must be licensed before completing the Use of Doctor Title application.
