Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. by Chair Denis.

Chair Denis, Vice-Chair Inouye, Mr. Chu, and Mr. Collins confirmed they were present.

- 3) Mr. Falaniko shall refrain from any actions that may result in his arrest or conviction for any crimes against persons or property (including but not limited to theft, burglary, assault, etc.) or any other act that is directly related to the guard profession.
 - a. Mr. Falaniko shall report any such arrests or convictions to the Board within thirty (30) calendar days of the arrests or convictions, and

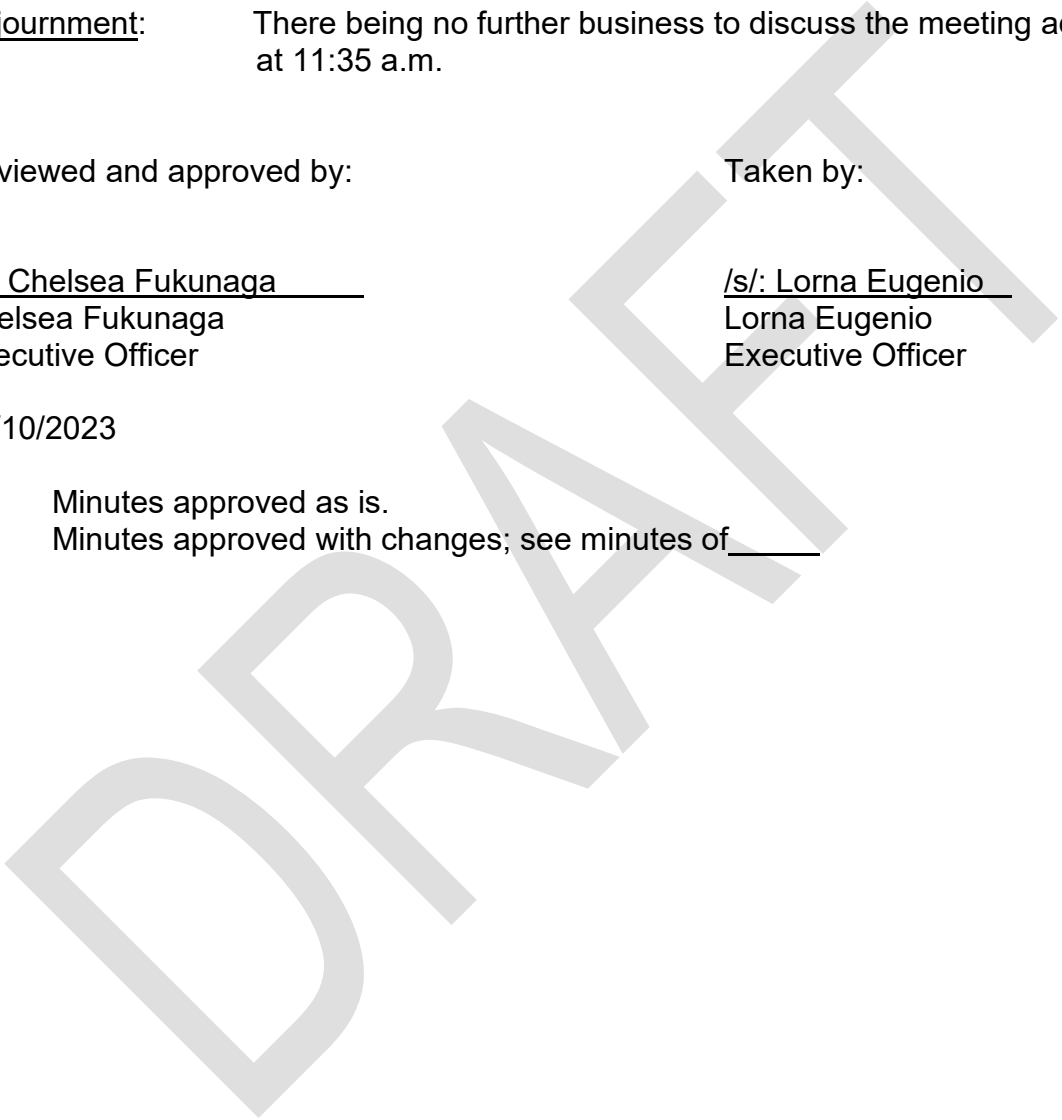
