order at 9:02 a.m.

Hawaiian Electric Co Inc

Can a C-13 Electrical contractor enter into a contract with a customer to perform C-13 electrical work and then subcontract with another licensed C-13 Electrical subcontractor to perform part or all of the electrical work and, for example, also subcontract with a C-27 Landscaping subcontractor and with a C-31 Masonry subcontractor to perform work that each is licensed to perform that is "incidental and supplemental" to the electrical work?

John Moore, Esq., Mark Shimabukuro, and Shannon Alivado were present on behalf of Hawaiian Electric Co Inc. Mr. Moore stated that HECO is seeking information on work that the C-13 Electrical contractor may perform. The examples provided in Mr. Moore's inquiry are purely hypothetical. If HECO is hired by a customer to perform C-13 work, could HECO subcontract all or part of the work to another C-13 contractor and could HECO subcontract "incidental and supplemental" work to other licensed contractors? Mr. Moore stated that sometimes they enter into contracts and their crews are unavailable or too busy. For example, they sent eight crews to Maui to help with the effort there.

Mr. Suehiro asked if HECO directly contracts work in the C-13 classification. Mr. Moore responded yes, they installed a substation on the Maui Pono property.

Because they have a relationship with their customers, they want to contract C-13 work instead of referring their customers to other C-13 contractors. Mark Shimabukuro stated that sometimes customers have power quality issues. HECO's power quality engineers assess the problem and at times customers will ask HECO to install power quality equipment. Executive Officer Ito asked why HECO subcontracts the "incidental and supplemental" work instead of letting the C-13 subcontractor subcontract the work. Mr. Moore stated that subcontracting the "incidental and supplemental" work directly keeps costs down. HECO has relationships with these subcontractors and can get a better price. Also, if they are allowed to directly subcontract the "incidental and supplemental" work HECO can respond more quickly than the C-13 subcontractor. Executive Officer Ito stated that HECO has not stated what kind of "incidental and supplemental" landscaping or masonry work they would be subcontracting. She stated that restoration of surfaces is in the scope of the C-13 contractor thus, the C-13 contractor can perform this work; it is not "incidental and supplemental" work. Mr. Moore stated that when they are contracted to install electrical charging stations, part of the scope of the contract includes landscaping in and around the stations.

At 9:13 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Lau, seconded by Mr. Suehiro, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4) to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.

At 9:30 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Suehiro, seconded by Mr. Lau, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

Recommendation: Based solely upon the hypothetical project that was presented today, (1) Yes, a C-13 Electrical contractor can enter into a contract with a customer to perform C-13 electrical work and then subcontract with another licensed C-13 Electrical subcontractor to perform part or all of the electrical work; and (2) Yes, a C-13 Electrical contractor can enter into a contract with a customer to perform C-13 electrical work and, for example, also

subcontract with a C-27 Landscaping subcontractor and with a C-31 Masonry subcontractor to perform work that each is licensed to perform that is "incidental and supplemental" to the electrical work.

It was moved by Mr. Suehiro, seconded by Mr. Polischeck and unanimously caried to approve the above scope recommendation.

2. Board's Final Order

a. In the Matter of the Application for a Contractors License of Nicholas M. Clark; CLB-LIC-2022-006

DAG Leong represented DCCA in this matter and as it would not be appropriate for him to present this matter to the Board, DAG Paige presented the Hearings Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order.

Nicholas M. Clark ("Petitioner") requested a contested case hearing on the Board's denial of Petitioner's application for the "B" General building classification contractor's license. On May 2, 2023, a hearing in this matter was conducted. After review and consideration of the evidence and argument presented at the hearing, together with the entire record of the proceeding, the Hearings Officer recommended that the Board affirm its denial of the Petitioner's application for a "B" General building classification contractor's license.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Suehiro, seconded by Mr. Higashihara and unanimously carried to adopt the Hearing Officer's recommended decision as the Board's Final Order and affirm its denial of the Petitioner's application for a "B" General building classification contractor's license.

b. In the Matter of the Application for a Contractor's License of Power Constructors LLC and Fabian H. Taea; CLB-LIC-2022-005

DAG Leong presented the Hearings Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order.

Power Constructors LLC and Fabian H. Taea ("Petitioners") requested a contested case hearing on the Board's denial of Petitioner's application for licensure in the "B" General building classification. On May 25, 2023, a hearing was conducted. After review and consideration of the entire record of the proceeding, the Hearings Officer recommends that the Board find and conclude that Petitioners have failed to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that the Board's denials of their applications for licensure in the B classification were improper. The Hearings Officer further recommends that the Board affirm its denials.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Nishek and unanimously carried to adopt the Hearing Officer's recommended decision as the Board's Final Order, find and conclude that the Petitioners have not proven by a preponderance of the evidence that the Board's denials of Petitioner's applications for licensure in the B classification were improper, and affirm its denials of the Petitioner's applications in the B classification.

At 9:41 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS §92-5(a)(1), to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS §26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 2:11 p.m. it was moved by Mr. Suehiro, seconded by Mr. Lau, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

6. <u>Emergency Contractor's License</u>

The Governor's Fifth Proclamation Relating to Wildfires ("EP") was distributed to the Board. The Board discussed HRS section 444-10.6 relating to the issuance of emergency contractor's licenses during a state of emergency or disaster. DAG Leong stated that HRS section 444-10.6 requires that there be a disaster declared by the Governor under HRS chapter 209. The Governor determined that a state of emergency exists pursuant to HRS sections 127A-14 and 127A-16; however, the Governor has not invoked the provisions of HRS chapter 209 at this time. Individuals that inquire about the emergency contractor's license should be informed that HRS section 444-10.6 does not apply and they should submit applications for a contractor's license.

The Board also noted that the EP suspended the license requirement for certain professionals. It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Nishek, and unanimously carried that the Board would not be in support of the suspension of the license requirement for contractors because licensure is required to protect consumers.

8. Correspondence

Letter from Alvin Bongolan requesting clarification about licensure requirements for a C-13 Electrical contractor

Mr. Bongolan asked the following questions:

(1) Would my full time licensed EJs (and licensed EMs who plan on being a Licensed EJ) who are directly supervising as working foreman, meet the experience requirements for C-13 Licensure (Sole, Entity) if they so choose to apply for it?; and

(2) Would an employee who directly manages and supervises my Licensed EJs/EMs/PJs who has at least 4 years of experience in this role meet the requirements for C-13 Licensure (RME)?

The Board reviewed Mr. Bongolan's email which, among other things, described the work that his company performs and does not perform. The Board is aware that individuals who wish to obtain a responsible managing employee or sole proprietor contractor's license may need to seek employment at more than one company to gain the on-site supervisory experience in the broad scope of the classification they wish to be licensed in. The Board is not able to give a blanket response whether an employee meets the experience requirement for licensure based upon the work that their employer's company performs; the individual must apply for a license and the application will be evaluated based upon the qualifications of each individual applicant.
