Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 10:37 a.m. by Chair Denis.

Chair Denis, Vice-Chair Inouye, Mr. Chu, and Mr. Collins confirmed they were present.

Approval of the Board Minutes: Chair Denis asked if there were any corrections to the July 14, 2023, open session minutes.

It was moved by Mr. Collins, seconded by Vice-Chair Inouye, and unanimously carried to approve the open session minutes of the July 14, 2023, meeting.

Executive Session: At 10:39 a.m., it was moved by Vice-Chair Inouye, seconded by Mr. Collins, and unanimously carried to move into executive session pursuant to HRS §92-5 to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in section HRS §26-9 or both, and to consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities, as provided in HRS §92-5(a)(1) and (4).

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Chair Denis, seconded by Vice-Chair Inouye and unanimously carried to approve Sugal Galu's application for licensure subject to certain conditions:

The Board based its decision on the following citation of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which finds factual support in the records and files of Mr. Galu's application:

HRS section 436B-19 provides that:

In addition to any other acts or conditions provided by law, the licensing authority may refuse to renew, reinstate or restore, or may deny revoke, suspend, or condition in any manner, any license for any one or more of the following acts or conditions on the part of the licensee of the applicant thereof:

* * *

- (14) Criminal conviction, whether by nolo contendere or otherwise, of a penal crime directly related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of the licensed profession or vocation.

For reasons contained in the records and files of Mr. Galu's application, the Board placed the following conditions on his conditional license:

- 1) Mr. Galu shall comply with all the terms and conditions of his probation.
 - a. Mr. Galu shall provide the Board with semiannual progress reports from his probation officer. For the semiannual periods of January to June; and July to December; the progress report shall be due on or before July 31st and January 31st respectively. The progress reports shall indicate whether he is complying with the terms and conditions of his probation.

- b. Upon completion of his terms, Mr. Galu shall submit proof of discharge to the Board; and if his probation is amended in any way or is revoked:
 - c. Mr. Galu shall report any such amendment or revocation to the Board within thirty (30) calendar days of the amendment or revocation; and
 - d. If Mr. Galu fails to timely notify the Board of such amendment or revocation, it shall be recommended to the Board that Mr. Galu's registration be forwarded to the Regulated Industries Complaints Office for investigation for non-compliance with the terms of this conditional approval.
- 2) Mr. Galu shall submit semi-annual FBI national criminal history record checks and State of Hawaii criminal history record checks from the Hawaii Criminal Justice Data Center ("**criminal abstracts**") to the Board for the duration of his probation.
 - a. For the semiannual periods of January to June; and; July to December, the criminal abstracts shall be due on or before July 31st and January 31st respectively.
 - b. In order to obtain these criminal abstracts, Mr. Galu shall be fingerprinted electronically at Fieldprint Inc. at his own cost and expense; and
- 3) Mr. Galu shall refrain from any actions that may result in his arrest or conviction for any crimes against persons or property (including but not limited to theft, burglary, assault, etc.) or any other act that is directly related to the guard profession.
 - a. Mr. Galu shall report any such arrests or convictions to the Board within thirty (30) calendar days of the arrests or convictions, and
 - b. If Mr. Galu fails to timely notify the Board of such arrests or convictions, it shall be recommended to the Board that Mr. Galu's registration be forwarded to the Regulated Industries Complaints Office for investigation for

non-compliance with the terms of this conditional approval.

Executive Officer Report:

A. Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires

EO Fukunaga reported that on August 19, 2023, Governor Green issued the Sixth Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires. The proclamation suspended Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 463-10.5 to the extent necessary to allow out-of-state licensed guards with a current and active license, or those previously licensed pursuant to Chapter 463, HRS, but who are no longer current and active, to engage in the business of guarding statewide without a Hawaii license; provided that they have never had their license revoked or suspended, have not been convicted of a felony within the last five years, and are hired by a Hawaii licensed guard agency who license is current, active, and in good standing.

EO Fukunaga stated that this proclamation was superseded by the Seventh Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires which was issued on September 8, 2023 and is due to expire on November 6, 2023 unless terminated or superseded by a separate proclamation.

EO Fukunaga noted that the proclamation only exempts licensure under HRS section 463-10.5 under certain circumstances. All other provisions under HRS Chapter 463 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”) Chapter 97 are in effect.

EO Fukunaga stated that guards using the proclamation to work in the State, must be hired by a Hawaii licensed guard agency, have never had their license revoked or suspended, and have not been convicted of a felony within the last five years. EO Fukunaga added that licensed Guard Agencies are still responsible for ensuring that they conduct pre-employment and post-hire employment criminal history record checks of county, state, and federal agencies of any individuals hired under the proclamation, pursuant to HAR section 16-97-7(b)(5). Guard Agencies utilizing the proclamation will be

held responsible for any non-compliance with the terms of the proclamation.
