It was motioned by Mr. Montalbo, seconded by Dr. Tay, and carried by the majority to approve or defer applications as noted above, with Mr. Manago recusing himself for the PCO application of Pest Help Hawaii LLC / Bronson Tokioka, RME, and Vice Chairperson Speed recusing himself for the PCFR application of Alex Brooks.

Steven Russo, from The Terminix International Company Limited Partnership, asked the Board to clarify what it means for an individual to have "supervisory experience". He stated that he had two employees listed on the agenda, Tyler Mayekawa and Bronson Tokioka, and he did not submit verification of their supervisory experience. He stated that Mr. Mayekawa's application was approved, and he doesn't understand how he qualified with supervisory experience as he didn't provide verification of Mr. Mayekawa's supervisory experience. In addition, while Mr. Tokioka is no longer his employee, he didn't provide verification of Mr. Tokioka's experience in the trade.

At 3:56 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Montalbo, seconded by Mr. Manago, and unanimously carried to move into Executive Session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(1), and to consult with the Board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 4:05p.m., it was moved by Vice Chairperson Speed, seconded by Ms. Simmons, and unanimously carried to return to the Board's order of business.

Executive Officer Green stated that the Board requires verification of an applicant's qualifications, and one experience certificate must be signed by the RME who can attest to the applicant's experience. If an application is approved, then appropriate documentation was received to verify the applicant's qualifications for licensure.

Mr. Russo asked if he can attest to anyone's experience, from anywhere.

Vice Chairperson Speed responded that if he's attesting to an individual's experience as the supervising RME, then he should be the individual's supervising RME.

<u>Legislative</u> Designation:

The Board considered delegating authority to a Board member to provide general subject matter information and/or testimony to the Legislature for the 2024 Legislative Session. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to delegate authority to Mr. Montalbo and Vice Chairperson
