Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 10:31 a.m. by Chair Collins.

Chair Collins, Vice-Chair Chu, Chief Moszkowicz, and Mr. Inouye confirmed they were present.

Approval of the Board Minutes: Chair Collins asked if there were any corrections to the January 30, 2024, open session minutes and executive session minutes.

Executive Officer Report: A. Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires

EO Roldan reported that on March 5, 2024, Governor Green issued the Tenth Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires. The proclamation suspended Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 463-10.5 to the extent necessary to allow out-of-state licensed guards with a current and active license, or those previously licensed pursuant to Chapter 463, HRS, but who are no longer current and active, to engage in the business of guarding statewide without a Hawaii license; provided that they have never had their license revoked or suspended, have not been convicted of a felony within the last five years, and are hired by a Hawaii licensed guard agency who license is current, active, and in good standing.

EO Roldan stated that this proclamation was superseded by the Ninth Emergency Proclamation Relating to Wildfires which was issued on January 5, 2024, and is due to expire on May 4, 2024, unless terminated or superseded by a separate proclamation.

EO Roldan noted that the proclamation only exempts licensure under HRS section 463-10.5 under certain circumstances. All other provisions under HRS Chapter 463 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”) Chapter 97 are in effect.

EO Roldan noted that guards using the proclamation to work in the State, must be hired by a Hawaii licensed guard agency, have never had their license revoked or suspended, and have not been convicted of a felony within the last five years. EO Roldan added that licensed Guard Agencies are still responsible for ensuring that they conduct pre-employment and post-hire employment criminal history record checks of county, state, and federal agencies of any individuals hired under the proclamation, pursuant to HAR section 16-97-7(b)(5). Guard Agencies utilizing the proclamation will be held responsible for any non-compliance with the terms of the proclamation.

2024 Legislative Session:

A. HCR 112/ HR 93 URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE OFFICE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES AND SUPPORT SERVICES, TO DEVELOP PROCEDURES THAT WILL EXPEDITE THE HIRING PROCESS FOR SECURITY GUARDS REGULATED UNDER CHAPTER 463, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.

EO Fukunaga reported that HCR 112 and HR 93 was most recently transmitted to the Senate as an HD1.

EO Fukunaga explained that testimony was submitted on behalf of the Board, but no position was taken as the Board had not yet met to discuss the measures. EO Fukunaga stated that the submitted testimony clarified the requirements of HRS §463-10.5, while noting that the Board previously provided guidance to the Department of Education regarding this matter.

EO Fukunaga asked the Board whether they would like to take a position on the measures. EO Fukunaga stated that the Board had the following options: support, oppose, provide comments, or appreciate the intent.

Chair Collins stated that he supports the testimony that was submitted. Chair Collins noted that the DOE's testimony mentioned that their training is superior to the training required for licensure. Chair Collins stated that if this is true, the standardized training, background checks and regulation that licensure provides would only complement and enhance the protection being provided by individuals who are hired to protect students.

Chair Collins added that the Board has the ability to discipline, suspend, or revoke a license, should a violation occur; whereas the DOE would be subject to their HR policies and collective bargaining agreements that may prolong the process of terminating an employee who should not be working around children. Further, the license status and license history of individuals who have been disciplined or terminated can be viewed by the public; which allows for additional vetting of prospective guards.

Mr. Inouye stated that he is fine with the Board only submitting comments and taking no position.

EO Fukunaga asked whether the Board had any further comments or discussion.
