Virtual Meeting
Instructions:

A short video regarding virtual meetings was played for attendees. The Chair provided information on internet and phone access for today's virtual meeting and announced that today's meeting was being recorded and that the recording will be posted on the Board's web page.

Call to Order:

The Chair took roll call of the Board members, noting that the Vice Chair was excused.

In accordance with Act 220, SLH 2021, all Board members attending virtually confirmed that they were alone in their nonpublic location.

After taking roll, quorum was established, and the meeting was called to order at 9:08 a.m.

Approval of
Minutes:

Approval of the August 1, 2024 Open Session Minutes

The Chair took the agenda slightly out of order and began with discussion of prior minutes. The Chair asked if there were any discussion or corrections to the minutes of the August 1, 2024 Open Session minutes.

Upon a motion by Mr. Kuo, seconded by Ms. Shields-Hanson, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the aforementioned minutes.

Chair's Report:

Announcements

The Chair announced that Executive Officer Lee Ann Teshima had retired. She noted that nursing regulation in the State of Hawaii was synonymous with EO Teshima's name and thanked EO Teshima for her enormous contribution to nursing regulation.

The Chair gave the following report on her attendance at the 2024 Nurse Licensure Compact ("NLC") and National Council of State Board of Nursing ("NCSBN") Annual Meetings in Chicago, IL:

1. NLC

- a. States that have not yet implemented the NLC are questioning the assumptions that the Compact will:
 - have any effect on a state's workforce; and
 - that any workforce impact will be positive
- b. California is projected to have a nursing workforce surplus by 2030. As the highest paid workforce in the country, there is concern that multistate license holders who commute into the state to work on a per diem basis may hasten or exacerbate the surplus.
- c. New York's legislature expressed concern that the implementation of the compact would lead to an unknown number of outflows from the state; trying to avoid a net loss of nurses.

2. Member Engagement

- a. Decline in engagement between member boards and NCSBN since the pandemic. Result of high turnover in executive officers.
- b. NCSBN is planning a listening tour to help learn what member boards need in the way of support or other resources. Plans seem unclear – not sure yet on dates, methods of feedback, etc.
- c. Research team is working on identifying a set of metrics that BONs would like to see about each other. Very preliminary; not clear what NCSBN's goals are for the work.

3. NCLEX

- a. No major updates about NCLEX in the plenary sessions but got some updates at the Presidents (Chairs) Meeting.
- b. Question posed as to whether the NCLEX gotten easier as it appears pass rates went up after the clinical judgment questions were added.
 - i. Psychometric team indicated that, no this was not the case. Item and difficulty analysis suggests that the test is about as difficult as it has always been, especially on the nursing knowledge questions.

- ii. Test takers perform very well on the clinical judgment questions.
 - iii. Test takers (including those who fail) and educators find that the clinical judgment questions are an authentic representation of content from nurse education programs and first year practice.
- c. Chair asked what kind of policies will exist for remote NCLEX proctoring (for neighbor island applicants)? Will a test taker be prohibited from taking the exam from a location other than their home? A library for example.
- i. There are no policies yet. Current focus of development is ensuring comparability of the test experience across different operating systems, device types and screen sizes.
 - ii. NCSBN is aware that a test taker may not be able to access a Pearson Vue testing center AND may not want or be able to test from home. NCSBN will develop test policies that take that fact into consideration. There is reason to expect that a test taker could take the exam from any location that meets NCSBN's security requirements.
 - iii. Stakeholder feedback will be solicited for proposed policies for "NCLEX at Home" in mid- to late 2025.
 - iv. Information is not yet available about the timing, duration, or location for pilot testing or how pilot test takers will be selected.

4. Nurse Education Programs

- a. Out of State Nursing Education Programs and Faculty:
 - i. Concern about quality of and regulatory oversight (or lack thereof) of out of state (online) nurse education programs.
 - ii. Many states' boards do not have regulatory oversight of any post-license programs in their own state, so out of state schools are also outside of their regulatory purview.
 - iii. Of the states that have regulatory oversight over out

of state schools, enforcement is difficult because there is no reliable way to know that a school is operating. Generally, BONs become aware of out of state schools after a complaint is lodged.

- b. Updated Evidence-Based Quality Indicators for Pre-License Nurse Education Programs
 - i. Based on data collected via its pre-licensure education annual report program, NCSBN is planning to update its Nursing Education Approval Guidelines for Pre-Licensure Programs.
 - ii. 2025 is the likely release date for revised guidelines.

EO Pang gave the following report:

- Other states had given updates about upcoming legislation that potentially conflicted with the Nurse Licensure Compact.
- Florida is standardizing its endorsement requirements among all of its professional licenses.
 - These requirements included: no discipline within the last 5 years before applying, no pending complaints, no felony or misdemeanor convictions related to the profession, and no suspensions, violations, or voluntary withdrawal of license in lieu of suspension unless the license has been restored.
 - The most notable requirement was that a Florida endorsement applicant must have practiced within the last 3 of 4 years, meaning that an applicant could not get licensed in a different state and then immediately endorse to Florida without having ever practiced nursing.
 - There was concern at the meeting that this would conflict with the Compact. EO Pang noted that under the language of the NLC, in the event of conflicting legislation, the NLC was supposed to supersede. With Florida's new law going live on January 1, 2025, time would tell how this law would interact with the NLC. If an applicant did not qualify under Florida's new law by endorsement, they would have to apply by exam and retake the NCLEX.

- During the EO Meeting, Canadian representatives announced that Canada was going to standardize its APRN licensure requirements so that no specialization was required.
 - Some U.S. executive officers commented that this might cause problems if Canadian nurses apply to U.S. states, as some U.S. states have specialization requirements for APRN applicants.
 - The Canadian representatives replied that the focus of this measure was to streamline the Canadian application process.

The Chair asked if there was anyone attending wishing to testify on this specific agenda item.

Staff reported that no one raised their hand.

Delegation

Creation of an Application Review Committee – for discussion purposes only

EO Fukunaga stated that the intention of this discussion was to gauge the Board's inclination on delegating a licensed Board member to review applications outside of a Board meeting; specifically applications that fall outside of an Executive Officer's delegation. This could help with expediting applications and lessening the amount of applications that go before the full Board. EO Fukunaga explained that the delegated Board member would have a specific set of criteria that they would be allowed to approve.

The Chair asked whether the delegated Board member be making decisions on applications on behalf of the entire Board?

EO Fukunaga replied that this Board member would only have authority to approve applications. EO Fukunaga clarified that only the Board is able to condition or deny an application.

The Chair asked DAG Wong if she saw any issues with this idea.

DAG Wong asked EO Fukunaga if this Board delegate would have delegations in addition to those previously delegated to EOs.

EO Fukunaga commented that she was concerned about the broad spectrum of delegations that EOs already possess. EO Fukunaga

believes a licensed Board member would be better suited to reviewing application with practice-related issues.

DAG Wong asked if the suggestion included revising the EO's existing delegations in addition to creating new delegations for the elected Board member. EO Fukunaga replied that DAG Wong was correct. DAG Wong stated that the Board will have to define the delegations for both EOs and the delegated Board member.

Mr. Kuo said he had no issues with the idea. Ms. Boyer said that she was thinking about the advantages of this proposal. EO Fukunaga reiterated that this would result in less applications having to come before the full Board. Mr. Kuo agreed that this proposal was a move towards more efficient processing of applications without delaying people's licensure unnecessarily.

Ms. Boyer commented that she liked being able to discuss applications among her peers and having a degree of support and consensus, but she could also appreciate the intent of expediting licenses being issued.

EO Fukunaga added that if the delegated Board member felt uncomfortable with approving an application for whatever reason, that individual would always have the option of forwarding the application for full Board review..

Ms. Shields-Hanson said that she liked that an applicant could get their license without having to wait for the Board meeting.

EO Fukunaga stated that staff would put together a metric and have the Board review it and have a public discussion with any interested public members.

Mr. Aratani commented that he was very comfortable with the idea. He added that while he was on the Board of Public Accountancy, a licensed board member reviewed applications in the interim between meetings.

Mr. Kuo said he would like to know the process of selecting the delegated Board member.

EO Fukunaga said that it would be up to the Board to elect this Board member; the Board would also decide what types of approval would be delegated to this individual.

DAG Wong asked if the applications reviewed by this delegate would be ratified. EO Fukunaga replied that they would; a license would be issued upon approval and the applicant's name would be included on the ratification list.

The Chair asked if there was anyone attending wishing to testify on this specific agenda item.

Staff reported that no one raised their hand.

Executive Officer's Report: **Amendments to Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") Chapter 89, Relating to Nurses – Proposed Amendments to HAR §16-89-22, Pertaining to Temporary Permits – Status Report**

EO Pang reported no change to the status of the rules since the last meeting.

The Chair proposed leaving this item off the agenda until there were any updates in this matter.

Random Audit – Status Report

EO Pang reported no change to the status of the random audit since the last meeting.

The Chair proposed leaving this item off the agenda until there were any updates in this matter. She asked about an estimated timeframe for completing the audit. EO Fukunaga replied that both EOs hoped to give a favorable update by the end of the year. The Chair commented that she was tasked with updating the Continuing Competency Guidebook, and felt unmotivated to do so given that the audit was taking so long. She hoped to have a conversation about the continuing competency requirement, possibly in January.

Joint Statement Regarding IV Therapy Clinics from Vermont

EO Pang read the very beginning of this statement, which the Board had received from the Vermont Office of Professional Regulation and Boards of Medical Practice, Nursing, Osteopathic Medicine, and Pharmacy:

"The Office of Professional Regulation (OPR) and Board of Medical Practice (BMP) have received complaints and reports about inappropriate activities occurring at IV (intravenous) therapy clinics and medical spas. These activities may include out-of-scope practice, delegation of

tasks to unqualified individuals, and unlicensed practice of medicine.

Nationally and in Vermont it is becoming increasingly common to see retail IV therapy clinics or “medical spas” that offer IV “cocktails” of additives to saline that may include vitamins, minerals, or prescription drugs. They are marketed to consumers as treatments for conditions such as dehydration, fatigue, and hangovers, or to aid individuals with athletic recovery or weight loss.

Vermont does not have laws and regulations that specifically govern IV therapy clinics and medical spas. Rather, these businesses are subject to the same laws and regulations that govern all spas and medical practices.

We believe this advisory statement will benefit licensed professionals who provide such services at these businesses by providing clarity about the legal and regulatory requirements that apply.”

EO Pang said that the rest of the statement went on to say that IV therapy services do constitute the practice of medicine, and individuals without the authority to administer IV therapy should not be doing so. EO Fukunaga asked if the Board was inclined to issue a similar statement. Otherwise, this statement was being offered for the information of the Board. EO Fukunaga added that the Board does receive inquiries about IV hydration at least once a month and the Board’s staff usually directs inquirers to the Board’s minutes.

The Chair said she felt that the Board has discussed this issue extensively. EO Fukunaga agreed. Mr. Kuo asked if the Board’s position is clear? EO Fukunaga said she believed it was, but conceded that some parts were unclear given the scope of the State Nursing Practice Act, such as the compounding issue. EO Fukunaga added that the Board was still waiting on clarification from the FDA, but to her knowledge no response was received.

The Chair said she appreciated the conversation around RN compounding that Vermont specified. She agreed that RNs compound drugs into saline bags on a regular basis, provided that they have a prescription and orders to do so. The Chair said that the Board has always informally opined that it is within the RN’s scope of practice to administer, as long as you have a valid order and prescription for the drugs.

Ms. Boyer commented that is not the practice in hospitals any longer. It is possible to do, but the pharmacy is really the one doing that, as well as specialty settings. A standard med surg unit is not adding medications to IV bags.

The Chair asked whether it is permissible within the scope of practice. She added that facility policy is different from the scope of practice of a nurse.

Mr. Kuo added that hospital settings should not be the standard because that would be very limiting, and that standard is potentially too high. The Chair said that there are plenty of places where nursing care is delivered. Mr. Kuo agreed.

The Chair said that putting out a policy statement was probably unnecessary if the Board has opined on the issue in the minutes to a citable degree.

The Chair asked if there was a notice about this issue on the Board's website. EO Fukunaga replied that there was a policy statement that was posted, following a webinar panel of the FDA, FSMB, NCSBN, and NABP regarding IV hydration clinics, but it may have been removed. The Chair requested to post a copy of the minutes in which the Board discussed this issue and the policy statement to the Important Announcement section on the Board's website.

The Chair asked if there was anyone attending wishing to testify on this specific agenda item.

Staff reported that no one raised their hand.

Reports:

**Hawai'i State Center for Nursing –
Laura Reichhardt, Executive Director**

Ms. Reichhardt reported on the following:

Research

- Hawaii State Nurse Education Capacity Report for 2022-2023 will be released this month. Provides really good insight as to the health of our local schools of nursing as well as the contributions they make to our nursing workforce by producing new nurses.

Quality Outcomes and Best Practices

- Clinical nurse faculty support efforts continue, which are in part funded by legislative funding. Since 2023, the outcomes include:
 - 47 clinical faculty completed HSCN Workforce's clinical faculty training course.
 - 20 clinical faculty completed Health Impact & Benner Institute's (California Nursing Workforce Center) 3-day, in-person clinical faculty training.
 - NurseTim – online faculty development workshops & webinars offered to all full-time and part-time faculty, and graduate students.
 - We are evaluating the participant outcomes
- The first Research Symposium will be held next month! Currently at capacity which shows an interest in nursing research and nurse engagement in advancing nursing care through research and evidence-based practice

Recruitment and Retention

- Hawai'i State Center for Nursing has received generous funds since 2020 for nurse recruitment and retention efforts. Since that time and through funding from the Dept of Labor and Industrial Relations Workforce Development Council, Department of Health Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division, and UH Community Colleges Good Job grant, HSCN has facilitated over \$800,000 in funds to support nurse residencies, preceptor training, and specialty training for new and incumbent nurses.
- Since 2023 – 2800
 - Specialty training- over 1000 nurses
 - Preceptor training – over 900 nurses
 - Acute Residencies – over 900 nurses (and over 2,100 nurses since 2012).
 - LTC Residency Pilot – 12 residents and 9 preceptors
 - Rural nurses are represented proportionally to their presence in the workforce
 - Acute NRP residents first year retention remains at 96%, which is 19% higher than the national first year retention rate.

HSCN Overall

- We are starting an intensive community focus group activity over the next several months and across the Hawaiian Islands. This will lead to updating our strategic plans. These two activities will reinforce our commitment to being community-driven in our strategic priorities, initiatives, and activities.
- Comment and Question for the board: This month 772 RNs are being ratified.
 - Please extend our thanks to the PVL team who processes through the licenses. This is no small feat.
 - Is this a record? I have noticed maintained high numbers of RNs ratified.
 - Is it possible to learn the in-state / out-of-state residency status for ratified nurses similar to what is reported on the PVL Geo Reports

The Chair noted that there was construction noise that made it very difficult to hear Ms. Reichhardt.
