<u>Call to Order</u>: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Arita called the meeting to

order at 9:02 a.m.

Agenda:

The agenda was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 92-7(b).

Minutes:

It was moved by Mr. Alejado and seconded by Mr. Polischeck, to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of May 6, 2024 and Board Meeting Minutes of March 22, 2024 and April 26, 2024. Mr. O'Donnell requested an amendment to the March 22, 2024 meeting minutes pertaining to the Scope of Activity Committee's recommendation on the Kapolei Police Station Installation of Photovoltaic System, City Project No. IX-73-22-0 inquiry. Mr. O'Donnell requested that the recommendation reflect "C-13 and C-48" because the recommendation of "C-13 or C-48" is very confusing. Chairperson Arita stated that the Board will reconsider the March 22, 2024 scope inquiry at the June 21, 2024 meeting. Mr. O'Donnell stated that the Kapolei judiciary building has a similar request for proposal; the word "or" is not definitive and the C-48 is not listed as a specification to perform the work. Executive Officer Ito stated that the Executive Officers checked their notes and the determination at the March 22, 2024 meeting was "C-13 or C-48". Today's meeting minutes will reflect that Mr. O'Donnell requested an amendment to the March 22, 2024 minutes, however. because that was the decision made, the March 22, 2024 minutes must reflect what occurred. Mr. O'Donnell asked DAG Leong whether the minutes could be amended. DAG Leong stated that if the minutes accurately reflect what happened at the meeting, the minutes cannot be amended. Mr. O'Donnell stated that under Robert's Rules of Order, additions and corrections to the minutes should be allowed. By not allowing an amendment to the minutes, bidders will not list a C-48 contractor and the Board is denving licensed contractors from participating in public works projects. Chairperson Arita stated that he understands Mr. O'Donnell's concerns, however the minutes are a record of what happened at the meeting and cannot be changed. The Board will reconsider the Kapolei Police Station Installation of Photovoltaic System, City Project No. IX-73-22-0 inquiry at its June 21, 2024 meeting.

The motion to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of May 6, 2024 and Board Meeting Minutes of April 26, 2024 was unanimously carried; and the approval of the Board Meeting Minutes of March 22, 2024 was carried by majority vote with Mr. O'Donnell voting no.

Committee Reports:

- 1. <u>Scope of Activity Committee</u>: Paul Alejado and John Polischeck, Co-Chairpersons
- a. City and County of Honolulu Pali Golf Course Upper Parking Lot Improvements; Project No. 20-P-14 ("Project")

Requests a determination on: (1) whether a C-41 Reinforcing steel contractor is required to perform the reinforcing steel work; (2) whether the reinforcing steel work is "incidental and supplement" to the C-31a Cement concrete classification held by a general contractor; and (3) whether an "A" General engineering or "B" General building contractor may self-perform the reinforcing steel work.

A licensed C-41 Reinforcing steel contractor will be fabricating all rebar work offsite and deliver to the jobsite. The general contractor with an "A" and "B" license will construct the concrete stairs and concrete curb. The total amount of bid for the Project is \$769,096.80.

The total cost of the C-31a Cement concrete portion of the Project is \$156,000 (Concrete Stairs: \$89,000, Concrete Curbs: \$67,000)

The cost of the individual components for the C-41 Reinforcing steel work is \$20,922 (Materials: \$20,502, Delivery: \$420).

Mr. Alejado stated that the scope of work of the total project is to improve the upper level of the parking lot at the Pali Golf Course to address soil erosion. The work includes regrading, pavement replacement and restriping, relocation of light poles, replacement of stairs, and installation of electrical wiring for future electrical vehicle charging stations.

Kim Holt, Peterson Bros. Construction stated that they were the lowest bidder on this project. At the time of bid, Simmons Steel, a C-41 contractor gave them a quote for "furnish only" which is why Simmons Steel was not listed as a subcontractor. There is currently a bid protest because a C-41 contractor was not listed as a subcontractor. Simmons Steel is performing the work because they are pre-tying everything in their shop and delivering it to the site. Ms. Holt is requesting that the Board determine that the C-41 work is incidental to the C-31a work. Mr. Polischeck stated that the rebar work for the stairs is considered structural and is not subordinate to the concrete work; therefore it the C-41 Reinforcing steel work is not "incidental and supplemental" to the C-31a Cement concrete work. Ms. Holt stated that the City initially told her that because the stairs are on structural plan sheets, the work is structural. She stated that most concrete work is on civil plan sheets; the curb and sign posts for this project are on structural plan sheets. She stated that she reached out to Alan Okamoto, an engineer with Hida, Okamoto & Associates who related that in general, the details could go either way (on a structural or civil plan sheet) at the preference of the design team. Ms. Holt asked the Board if the work was on a civil plan sheet, would the Board find that the work is not structural. Mr. Polischeck stated that the concrete on the face of the stairs is vertical and is considered to be structural. Ms. Holt stated that the rebar is "L" shaped and the C-41 contractor gave them a "furnish only" quote. The Board stated that it does not make determinations on procurement issues; the Board reviews the plans and specifications of the project provided by the inquirer and makes a determination on the license required for the work to be performed. Mr. Polischeck stated that any stair is structural whether it is sitting on the ground or free standing. Therefore, the rebar work is not subordinate to the cement work and is not "incidental and supplemental" to the C-31a work. Executive Officer Ito clarified that the Board's criteria to qualify as "incidental and supplemental" work is that the work must be subordinate to, directly related to, and necessary for the completion of the primary work, and less than 50 percent of the cost and extent of project. Because the rebar work is structural, it is not subordinate to the concrete work and does not meet the criteria for "incidental and supplemental" work.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, (1) A C-41 Reinforcing steel contractor is required to perform the reinforcing steel work; (2) The C-41 Reinforcing steel work is <u>not</u> "incidental and supplemental" to the C-31a Cement concrete classification held by a general contractor; because the C-41 Reinforcing steel work is structural, it is not subordinate to the C-31a Cement concrete work; and (3) an "A" General engineering or "B" General building contractor may <u>not</u> self-perform the reinforcing steel work; a C-41 Reinforcing steel contractor is required to perform the reinforcing steel work.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

Chapter 91, HRS, Adjudicatory Matters:

Chairperson Arita called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:17 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Corey A. Manley, dba Manley's Painting; CLB 2023-0230-L

In or about December 2018, Corey A. Manley, dba Manley's Painting ("Respondent") contracted with an Association of Apartment Owners to complete a fencing and painting project, which included replacing metal strips and rubber coatings on stairways, gates, gravel, and cinder blocks; repairing cement walls; and repairing and replacing all wooden fences for twenty-seven (27) buildings on the property located in Waipahu, Hawai'i ("Project").

Respondent did not provide Complainant with any written contract before performing contracting work. Respondent engaged in masonry (C-31) and wood fencing (C-32a) activities without possessing a C-31 and/or C-32a specialty classification license. Respondent did not complete the Project.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the foregoing allegations, would constitute violations of the following provisions of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes ("HRS") and Hawai'i Administrative Rules ("HAR"):

- HRS § 444-17(6) (Wilful violation of any law of the State, or any county, relating to building, including any violation of any applicable rule of the department of health, or of any applicable safety or labor law);
- HRS § 444-17(13) (Wilful failure or refusal to prosecute a project or operation to completion with reasonable diligence);

- HRS § 444-25.5(b) (failure to provide a written contract); and/or
- HAR § 16-77-33(c) (A licensee classified as a specialty contractor shall not act, assume to act, or advertise as a contractor in any classification other than those which the licensee holds).

Respondent agrees to pay a fine in the amount of two thousand five hundred and no/100 U.S. dollars (\$2,500.00).

 In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Valley Isle Builders, Inc.; Lars Bertelsen, RME; CLB 2022-0046-L

Valley Isle Builders, Inc. and Lars Bertelsen, RME ("Respondents") entered into an agreement to renovate a residence in Lahaina, Hawai'i (the "Project").

Respondents provided a written contract to the homeowner ("Complainant"), which failed to include all required information and disclosures. The written contract was not executed and signed by Complainant and/or Respondents. Respondents subsequently performed work on the Project, which involved home construction and/or improvement.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the foregoing allegations, would constitute violations of the following provisions of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes ("HRS") and Hawai' i Administrative Rules ("HAR"):

- HRS § 444-25.5(a) (required disclosures prior to entering a contract with a homeowner);
- HRS § 444-25.5(b) (required disclosures in homeowner contracts; required to sign and execute written contract before performing any home construction or improvement);
- HAR § 16-77-71(a)(5) (RME held responsible for violations of HRS Chapter 444 and HAR Title 16, Chapter 77); and/or
- HAR § 16-77-80(a) (disclosures required in homeowner contracts).

Respondents agree, jointly and severally, to pay an administrative fine in the amount of six thousand and no/100 U.S. dollars (\$6,000.00) as follows:

a) Three thousand and no/100 U.S. dollars (\$3,000.00) due at the time this Settlement Agreement is returned to RICO and

> Three thousand and no/100 U.S. dollars (\$3,000.00) due no later than thirty (30) days following Board approval of this Settlement Agreement.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Arita announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:22 a.m.

Executive Session:

At 9:23 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Nishek and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(1), to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS section 26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 1:26 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Torigoe and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

After discussion, Mr. Jenevein withdrew his RME and Schnabel Foundation Company's applications for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification and amended his applications to apply for licensure in the C-34 Soil stabilization and C-35 Pile driving, pile and caisson drilling and foundation in addition to the C-23 Gunite classification. Mr. Jenevein requested that the Board review the project list he submitted for the "A" General engineering classification for his onsite supervision and direction of his employees in the C-35 Pile driving, pile and caisson drilling and foundation classification. It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Schnabel Foundation Company and Mr. Jenevein's RME applications for licensure in the C-34 Soil stabilization and C-35 Pile driving, pile and caisson drilling and foundation classifications pending the submittal of a project list (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the C-34 Soil stabilization classification, specifying the work that was performed in-house with his own employees and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors.

b. Meade Electric LLCZachariah Meade, RMEC-13 Electrical

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Meade Electric LLC and Mr. Meade's applications

for licensure in the C-13 Electrical classification pending the submittal of additional projects (on the Board's form), to verify his forty-eight months of on-site supervision and direction of his employees, which include but is not limited to the hospital project he described, a detailed description of his supervision and direction of his employees on the large solar projects that involved interconnection to the utility, work with switchgears, VFDs, primary power and secondary power distribution from the utility. For each project listed, provide a more detailed description of the project and work he supervised. Do not provide any additional residential solar PV projects. Also submit a copy of his apprenticeship certificate.

c. Core Tech Hawaii LLC
Dominic K Jeon, RME
"B" General building

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Core Tech Hawaii LLC and Mr. Jeon's applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of additional projects (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his employees constructing buildings from the "ground-up", specifying the work that was performed in-house with his own employees and the work or trades that was subcontracted to other licensed contractors. The projects should include his on-site supervision and direction of his employees performing work in the broad scope of the "B" General building classification (such as concrete, drywall, framing, etc.), including stand-alone buildings. He may also submit a copy of his architectural engineering degree. Mr. Jeon may document projects where he was on-site directing and supervising his own crew performing work in the broad scope of the "B" classification from more than ten years ago.

d. Good Tree Construction IncDong Jin Huh, RME"B" General building

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to deny Mr. Huh and Good Tree Construction Inc's applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification in accordance with HRS section 444-11(a)(2), HAR sections 16-77-11(a)(1) and (2) and HAR section 16-77-18 for lack of experience and HRS section 436B-19(5) for procuring a license through fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit by providing inconsistent and conflicting information on their applications and supporting documentation.

e. Dwight D Burdick (Individual) "A" General engineering

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Dwight D Burdick's application for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification pending the submittal of additional projects (on the Board's form) to verify forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the "A"

General engineering classification (e.g. mass excavation, public utilities, road work, building bridges, etc.) specifying the trades performed in house and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. Also, the "Amount of Supervisory Experience" should only include the actual time spent on-site supervising his own crew. It should not include time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling, or downtime for rainouts, or waiting for delivery of materials. All information on the "A" General engineering project list should be specific to his time on-site supervising his employees performing "A" General engineering work. In addition, he may document projects where he was on-site directing and supervising his own crew performing "A" General engineering work from more than ten years ago.

f. Trade Mark Construction LLCMark J S Wasden, RME"B" General building

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Trade Mark Construction LLC and Mr. Wasden's applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of a revised project list (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees constructing buildings from the "ground-up" specifying the trades performed inhouse and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. Mr. Wasden's revised project list should include additional projects supervising his own employees building new stand-alone structures from the "ground-up" and from start to finish. The "Amount of Supervisory Experience" on his revised project list should only include the actual amount of time spent on-site supervising his own crew constructing buildings. Do not include the time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling, downtime for rain-outs, or waiting for delivery of materials. Also, the projects on his "B" project list should not overlap with his C-5 Cabinet, millwork, and carpentry remodeling and repairs project list.

g. Streamline Industries LLCEdwin E Apostadiro, RMEC-56 Welding

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Streamline Industries LLC and Mr. Apostadiro's applications for licensure in the C-56 Welding classification pending the submittal of a revised project list (on the Board's form) verifying his forty-eight months of on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the C-56 Welding classification specifying the trades performed in house and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. Provide additional projects to verify his forty-eight months of on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the C-56 Welding classification. In the description of the work he supervised, include the type of welding performed. In addition, the "Amount of Supervisory Experience" should only include the actual amount of time spent on-site supervising his own employees performing work in the broad scope of the C-56 Welding classification for that specific project. Do not include time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling or downtime for rain outs or waiting for

delivery of materials. All information must be specific to each project. Mr. Apostadiro may document projects where he was on-site directing and supervising his own crew performing work in the broad scope of the C-56 Welding classification from more than ten years ago.

h. Trilink Enterprises Inc Mark J Strachan, RME "B" General building

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Trilink Enterprises Inc and Mr. Strachan's applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of additional projects (on the Board's form), verifying his on-site supervision and direction of his employees constructing buildings from the "ground-up", specifying the work performed in-house by his own employees and the work performed by other licensed contractors. Mr. Strachan's revised project list should include additional projects supervising his own employees building new stand-alone structures from the "ground-up" and from start to finish. He may document projects that date back to when he had his own employees and he was on-site supervising and directing his workers (employees) constructing buildings from the "ground-up" and from start to finish. Also submit a current criminal history record from the State of California and a signed explanation providing the underlying facts and circumstances surrounding his convictions that have not been annulled or expunged.
