hi all, I would like to request to be on the agenda to discuss a proposed change to our Graduate Entry Pre-licensure Nursing (GEPN) Program. We are exploring the options of conversion to a Master's Direct Entry Program. This type of program is increasingly being offered across the country and is approved by the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN), our professional accrediting body.

The key distinction between the current GEPN program and the proposed Master's Direct Entry Program is that students with a bachelor's or graduate degree in a discipline other than nursing would graduate with a Master of Science (MS) in Nursing, functioning as a generalist. The program would be extended by one semester. -total 15 months in length,.

Please let us know if we can be on the agenda and if so, what would we need to prepare and send ahead of time.


