At 2:13 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Kevin Thompson RME and Bellingham Marine Industries Inc applications for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification pending the submittal of additional projects (on the Board's form) to verify his forty-eight months of onsite supervision of his own employees and direction of the means and

methods in the broad scope of the "A" General engineering classification.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Michael K Matsuzaki's RME and Elite Plus Real Estate – Orem A Professional Limited Liability Company's applications for licensure in the C-5 Cabinet, millwork, and carpentry remodeling and repairs and C-68MI Prefabricated metal buildings classifications pending the submittal of project lists verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision of his own employees in the broad scope of the C-5 and C-68MI classification and ensure that the respective project lists are specific to C-5 and C-68MI work.

Mr. Malley may document projects where he was on-site directing and supervising his own crew in the broad scope of the C-5 classification from more than ten years ago.

The Applications Committee is recommending approval of R & R Equipment Rentals LLC and Ryan K Paik's RME applications for licensure in the "B" General building classification. After discussion Ryan K Paik withdrew his RME and R & R Equipment Rentals LLC's applications for licensure in the "A" General engineering and amended his applications to also apply for licensure in the C-17 Excavating. grading, and trenching and C-37a Sewer and drain line classifications. It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and carried by majority vote (with Chairperson Nishek recusing himself) to defer Ryan K Paik's RME and R & R Equipment Rentals LLC's applications for licensure in the C-17 Excavating, grading, and trenching and C-37a Sewer and drain line classifications pending the submittal of project lists verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision of his own employees in the broad scope of the C-17 and C-37a classifications and ensure that the respective project lists are specific to C-17 and C-37a work.

g. Nathan M Trahern, RMEEric F Anderson Inc"B" General building

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Nathan M Trahern's RME application for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of additional projects to verify his forty-eight months of on-site supervision and direction of his own crew constructing building from the "ground-up" and from start to finish.

- a. Dome Technology LLCMitchell Cade South, RME"B" General building

At its February 21, 2025 meeting the Board determined that an "A" General engineering classification is required to construct industrial storage domes and requested additional information on the work that will be self-performed to determine whether other contractor licenses are required. Thus, Jason South submitted an application for licensure in the "A" General Engineering. After discussion, Dome Technology LLC withdrew its application and Mitchell Cade South's RME application for licensure in the "B" General building classification and amended Jason South's RME and Dome Technology LLC's applications to apply for licensure in the "A" General engineering, C-41 Reinforcing steel and C-48 Structural steel classifications. It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Dome Technology LLC and Jason South's RME applications for licensure in the "A" General engineering, C-41 Reinforcing steel and C-48 Structural steel classifications pending the submittal of project lists verifying forty-eight months of Jason South's on-site supervision of his own employees in the broad scope of the "A" General engineering, C-41 Reinforcing steel, and C-48 Structural steel classifications.

b. Stellex Power Line Opco LLCFred Kauhane RMEC-62 Pole and line

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to approve Stellex Power Line Opco LLC and Fred Kauhane's RME applications for licensure in the C-62 Pole and line classification.

Hawaii

Administrative Rules: Proposed Amendment to HAR section 16-77-34 Definition of "Incidental and Supplemental" Work

> The Board received testimony on the proposed amendment to HAR section 16-77-34 from the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, District Council 50 ("DC 50"). DC 50 requests that all references to the term "contractor" be changed to "specialty contractor". In their testimony, DC 50 stated that this revision is to conform the proposed amendment to Hawaii Revised Statutes section 444-8(c) which only allows specialty contractors to perform "Incidental and supplemental" work.

At 2:22 pm, it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to carried to enter into executive session to consult with Jordan Ching, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties,

privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 2:29 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Torigoe and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

The Board reviewed the Board's Final Order Upon remand in which the Supreme Court disagreed with DC 50's assertion that the Okada Trucking case prohibited general contractors from engaging in "incidental and supplemental" work in trades or crafts in which they are not licensed because the Court recognized that general contractors also hold specialty contractor licenses. The Board reaffirmed its longstanding interpretation that "A" General engineering and "B" General building contractors who hold specialty contractor's license(s) that were automatically provided under HAR chapter 16-77 or obtained on their own, may perform other specialty contracting work that is "incidental and supplemental" to the licensed specialty contracting work. In other words, general contractors are not prohibited under Okada Trucking from performing specialty contracting work outside of their specialty contractor licenses when that work is "incidental and supplemental" to work performed within the scope of their specialty contractor licenses. In those situations, they are acting as specialty contractors, and not as general contractors.

Executive Officer Ito stated that the Board reviewed the testimony submitted by DC 50 and based upon their interpretation of the Board's Final Order Upon Remand, which has been reviewed and affirmed by the Supreme Court, the Board is declining to accept the amendments proposed in DC 50's testimony. It was moved by Mr. O'Donnell, seconded by Mr. Higashihara, and unanimously carried to decline to accept the amendments proposed in DC 50's testimony.

Examination Committee

Contractors Examination Summary

The Contractors Examination Summary for February 2025 was distributed to the Board for their information.

2025 Legislation Relating to Contractors

a. H.B. 421, H.D.1

Repeals the leasing restriction on owner-builders who obtain an owner-builder exemption to act as their own contractor and who build or improve residential or farm buildings or structures on property they

own or lease and do not offer the buildings or structures for sale. Requires an owner or lessee to provide signed written notice that the structure for lease or sublease was built or improved by an individual who is not a licensed contractor. Effective 7/1/3000.

The House Committee on Housing ("HSG") referred H.B. 421, H.D.1 to the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Commerce ("CPC"). CPC did not hold a hearing on this bill.

b. H.B. 846

Raises the threshold exemption under the contractor licensing law's handyman exemption from \$1,500 to \$2,500.

This bill had a single referral to CPC and was not scheduled for a hearing.

c. S.B. 417, S.D.1

Establishes as a class B felony the unlicensed performance of contractor work, during or within 5 years following a national emergency, state of emergency, or disaster proclamation, in an affected political subdivision. Effective 7/1/2050.

The Senate Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection ("CPN") and the Senate Committee on Public Safety and Military Affairs ("PSM") referred S.B. 417, S.D.1 to the Senate Committee on Judiciary ("JDC"). JDC did not hold a hearing on this bill.

Relating to Renewable Energy

a. S.B. 588, S.D.2

Authorizes certain government entities to establish a self-certification process for behind-the-meter, customer-sited solar distributed energy resource systems and exempt the systems from the Federal Emergency Management Agency No-Rise/No-Impact declaration requirements under certain circumstances. Effective 7/1/2050.

On March 11, 2025, the Senate Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection ("EEP") held a hearing on this bill and deferred this measure.

Relating to Building Permits

H.B. 367, H.D.2

Allows for county permit exemptions for certain kinds of activities, including maintenance activities, installing group U structures, and interior remodeling work, when located outside a special management area. Effective 1/1/3000.

On March 7, 2025 the Senate Committee on Housing ("HOU") held a hearing on H.B. 367, H.D.2 and passed it with the following amendments:

- (1) Clarifying that exempted interior remodeling shall not change the use of a group U structure;
- (2) Inserting language requiring an owner or occupier to submit plans, in addition to providing written notice, to the appropriate county agency about the type of proposed work;
- (3) Inserting an effective date of July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (4) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

HOU referred H.B. 367, H.D.2, S.D.1 to JDC. JDC has not scheduled a hearing in on this bill.

Relating to Remedies

a. H.B. 420, H.D.3

Clarifies the applicability of the statute of repose for actions arising from construction defects. Repeals the two-year limitation for actions arising from construction defects. Clarifies the required contents of a notice of claim of construction defect served on a contractor. Specifies that claimants must comply with the Contractor Repair Act and bars persons from joining a class for failure to comply with the Contractor Repair Act. Amends the process and time frame for a claimant to accept a contractor's offer to settle or inspect. Limits the amount a claimant can recover if the claimant rejects a contractor's reasonable proposal for inspection or a reasonable offer to remedy. Clarifies the consequences of rejecting an offer of settlement. Effective 7/1/3000.

On March 19, 2025, CPN amended this measure by deleting its contents and inserting the contents of S.B. 1650, a substantively similar measure that:

- (1) Clarifies that the Statute of Repose applies to contract, tort, and statutory claims;
- (2) Specifies the required contents in a notice of claim of construction defect served on a contractor;
- (3) Requires a claimant to provide actual evidence of the nature and cause of the construction defect, the extent of necessary repairs, and the notice of the claim; and
- (4) Amends the process and time frame for a claimant to accept a contractor's proposal to inspect and authorize the contractor to proceed with repairs.

CPN referred H.B. 420, H.D.3, S.D.1 to JDC.

Tracy Tonaki, DR Horton Hawaii, stated that she is available to answers any questions.

The Board came to a consensus to continue to track this bill.

b. S.B. 179, S.D.1

Clarifies the applicability of the statute of repose for actions arising from construction defects. Clarifies the required contents of a notice of claim of construction defect served on a contractor. Amends the process and time frame for a claimant to accept a contractor's offer to settle or inspect and authorize the contractor to proceed with repairs. Limits the amount a claimant can recover if the claimant rejects a contractor's reasonable proposal for inspection or a reasonable offer to remedy. Clarifies the consequences of rejecting an offer of settlement. Effective 7/1/2050.

S.B. 179, S.D.1 was referred to JDC. JDC did not hold a hearing on this bill.

Recovery Fund: Recovery Fund Report:

Ms. Okazaki's Recovery Fund Report dated March 16, 2025 was distributed to the Board for their information.

Education Fund:

Media on Hiring Licensed Contractors

Wiliam Nhieu, DCCA Communications Officer stated that during the past 18 months, the Board has discussed advertising for unlicensed contracting through PSAs. The Contractor Education Fund monies went to a Maui centric PSA, a more general PSA, and a storytelling PSA on rebuilding Lahaina. The Department also produced a contractor PSA and is working on a Business Check PSA. There are four PSAs in the hopper for production. In addition, there is a 30 second PSA, a couple of 15 second cuts and a couple of 5 second cuts for radio, online platform, TV and social media advertising.

The Board viewed the Maui centric PSA funded by the Contractor Education Fund. It featured a girl scout, surfing instructor and construction worker soliciting a homeowner. Mr. Nhieu stated that the PSA was filmed on Maui and the Deputy Director was there for the filming. The point of this PSA was to say no to unlicensed contractors. The PSA could direct the consumer to the Hire A Licensed Contractor website or the Business Check website. The vendor is filming a second PSA that will be delivered in late April. Executive Officer Ito asked if the second PSA will include some types of work that require a licensed contractor. Mr. Nhieu stated, no because it would take more than 30 seconds. Executive Officer Ito stated that the original PSA mentioned a few examples of work that requires a contractor, and it would be good if the PSA could mention a few classifications that people don't normally think requires a contractor. Mr. Nhieu stated that is possible and he would take a look at the story board.

The Board viewed a second PSA that was produced by a different vendor and did not use money from the Contractor Education Fund. It featured a contractor repairing a ceiling fan. Mr. Nhieu stated that the Communications Team is trying to create a range of PSAs.

Mr. Nhieu stated that now that the PSAs are produced, we need to discuss funding the advertising. The Communications Team had previously asked the Board to consider a \$100,000.00 advertising budget. The options are to advertise through TV using the Hawaii Association of Broadcasters ("HAB"), partnering with Spectum to do an integrated campaign which includes Over The Top advertising (advertising via streaming services), for example, commercials on HGTV and Hulu. Using HAB is more economical because TV stations donate spots to HAB, however, you don't get to pick when your PSA airs. HAB guarantees a 3 to 1 rate of return. HAB rules do not allow us to buy direct if we use HAB. He recommended supplementing the HAB TV ads with a digital campaign including pre-roll on websites, you tube, HGTV, and streaming Apps like Amazon. Mr. Nhieu stated that the Department is asking for approval of up to \$100,000.00 and the Communications Office in collaboration with PVL will utilize the

funds to the best viable campaign which will be a combination of HAB and a digital campaign, social media, and streaming.

The Board asked for the amount in the Contractors Education Fund; Executive Officer Ito stated, \$717,547.87. Executive Officer Ito asked if there was a ballpark figure of the number of times the PSA would be aired with the \$100,000.00 advertising budget. Mr. Nhieu stated that he did not have the figures with him, however, in the past DCCA experienced an 8 to 1 rate of return. Typically, an ad on the 6 pm, 7:00 pm, and 10 pm news costs \$250.00 to \$300.00 for a 30 second spot. HAB will provide an affidavit of the time slots. Most State agencies use HAB.

Mr. Lau asked if the PSAs are completed and whether the Board has a choice on the productions. Mr. Nhieu stated that the girl scout PSA is completed and has been approved by the Directors Office. Mr. Nhieu stated that the ask is for a \$100,000.00 advertising budget as discussed earlier. The Deputy Director would like to run a flight at the Maui Film Festival. The Board asked why the Communications Team is coming to the Board when the decision to approve the PSA has already been made by the Directors Office. Mr. Nhieu stated that he could not speak to that.

The Board stated that they want to be sure to get the best value for the money they are spending because they are approving the use of funds from the Education Fund. Mr. Nhieu stated that CLB's contract with International Cultural Arts Network was for 2-30 second PSAs, 4-15 second PSAs, and 4-5 second PSAs. The total cost of their contract was \$75,959.00. The request from the Directors Office is if the Board would be open to fund the remainder of the contract (\$26,000.00). The Board expressed concerns about the amount of funds being requested as it is approximately 20% of the Education Fund and stated that they need to discuss this matter. Mr. Nhieu stated that he had another meeting to attend and excused himself.
