Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Vice Chairperson Nishek called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of August 1, 2022, and the Board Meeting and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of July 22, 2022, as circulated.

Committee Reports:

1. Scope of Activity Committee:
Paul Alejado, Chairperson

a. Jason Verdadero – Fresh Roof / Peak 301

Requests a determination on whether a specific type of license is required or whether he can operate under his current license to apply Fresh Roof / Peak 301, an all-natural soy-based oil solution to asphalt shingle roofs. Fresh Roof / Peak 301 is a roof rejuvenator which is an alternative to re-roofing. It revives the oils and minerals that makes the asphalt shingles stronger and durable which prolongs the lifespan just like new.

Members reviewed information provided by Jason Verdadero. The Board noted that this product appears to be similar to Roof Maxx which does not require a contractor's license to apply to asphalt shingles. Based upon the information provided by Mr. Verdadero, he will only be applying Fresh Roof / Peak 301 to the asphalt shingles and will not be performing any type of roofing work.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, a contractor's license is not required to apply Fresh Roof / Peak 301; provided that this does not include the performance of any roofing or roof repair work.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

b. Charles Reemes, F&S Services LLC

Requests a determination on the contractor's license that is required to process complex pieces of equipment and/or machinery to be recycled using heavy industrial torch dismantling on the following projects:

- i. Pearl Harbor IMF project in which a big piece of salvage equipment is going to be removed and staged at a laydown yard within the confines of the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard IMF JBPHH by Mr. Reemes. Electrical service has been completely disconnected by others, and all petrohydrocarbons have been drained by others and disposed of. The piece of salvage equipment will be processed with a cutting torch. Snitzer Steel Hawaii will be providing roll off services once Mr. Reemes downsizes the pieces for removal.
- ii. MCBH at Kaneohe Bay project in which a big piece of salvage equipment is going to be removed and staged at a laydown yard within the confines of the MCBH at Kaneohe Bay by others. The piece of salvage equipment will be processed with a cutting torch. Snitzer Steel Hawaii will be contracted to haul the dismantled pieces for disposal or recycling.

Members reviewed information provided by Charles Reemes. The Board noted that Mr. Reemes would be removing the salvage equipment for the Pearl Harbor IMF project. It was also noted that the federal government requested that Mr. Reemes obtain a contractor's license.

Recommendation:

i. Pearl Harbor IMF project: Based solely on the information provided, the C-24 Building, moving & wrecking contractor's license is required to remove the salvage equipment from the building; and a contractor's license is not required to process salvage equipment with a cutting torch.

ii. MCBH at Kaneohe Bay project: Based solely on the information provided, a contractor's license is not required to process salvage equipment with a cutting torch.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

Chapter 91, HRS.
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Vice Chairperson Nishek called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:11 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Central Striping Service, Inc. and James R. Lesniewski; CLB 2022-80-L

The State of Hawaii Department of Labor and Industrial Relations – Wage Standards Division (DLIR-WSD) issued a Notification of Violation (Case Nos. 011989 and 011991) to Central Striping Service Inc. ("Respondent CSS") on October 6, 2021.

The Notification of Violation found Respondent CSS in violation of Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") Chapter 104-2(b) (prevailing wage), 104-2(c) (overtime) and 103(a)* (submission of certified copies of payroll required) in connection with the Airport Pavement Markings and Miscellaneous Improvements at Kahului Airport and at Opolu Airport projects.

The DLIR-WSD issued a Wage and Penalty Assessment against Respondent CSS in the amounts of \$22,436.14 (Kahului Airport) and \$1,289.68 (Opolu Airport) which Respondent CSS paid in full on November 24, 2021.

RICO alleges that the Notification of Violation establishes Respondent CSS failed to pay one employee the prevailing wage in violation of HRS section 104-2(b) and eight employees overtime in violation of section 104-2(c). The Notification of Violation also establishes Respondent CSS failed to submit weekly certified copies of payroll to the contracting agency in violation of HRS section 104-3(a).

Respondent CSS failed to provide written notification of the Notification of Violation to the Board within thirty (30) days.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statutes and rules: Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 444-17(6) (willful violation of any law of the State, or any county, relating to building, including any applicable safety or labor law); HRS section 436B-16(a) (failure to provide written notice within thirty days to the licensing authority of any disciplinary action which adjudges or finds that the licensee is liable for any loss caused by the licensee’s conduct in the practice of the licensee’s profession; and Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”) sections 16-77-71, 16-77-75 (RME responsible for acts and omissions of contracting entity).

Respondents CSS and James R. Lesniewski agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of two thousand three hundred seventy-five and no/100 U.S. dollars (\$2,375.00).

*A typographical error was noted in paragraph A.7.: the citation of “103(a) should be “104-3(a)”.

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors’ Licenses of Dickinson-Cameron Construction Company, Inc. and Ronald G. Gordines; CLB 2015-171-L

On or about April 22, 2015, Dickinson-Cameron Construction Company, Inc. and Ronald G. Gordines (“Respondents”) entered into a written contract with Southern Acoustics (hereinafter “Southern”) to install acoustic panels in the Cartier Store located at the Ala Moana Shopping Center in exchange for \$136,240.00. Southern was not licensed in Hawaii.

Respondents did not possess a C-1 (acoustical & insulation) specialty classification.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statutes: Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) sections 444-17(17) (entering into a contract with an unlicensed contractor involving work for which a license is required), 436B-19(6) (aiding and abetting an unlicensed contractor in performing activities requiring a license) and 444-23(a) (contracting outside the scope of the appropriate classification) as to both Respondents.

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$25,000.00.

- c. In the Matter of the Contractor’s License of Albert Selga; CLB 2022-281-L

RICO alleges that in January of 2020, Albert Selga (“Respondent”) entered into an agreement to perform plumbing activity at a

residence in Hawaii in exchange for compensation. Respondent's license was active on this date.

RICO alleges that Respondent engaged in plumbing activity without possessing a plumbing license or a C-37 (plumbing) specialty classification license.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violation of the following statute: Hawaii Revised Statutes section 444-23(a) (contracting outside the scope of appropriate classification).

Respondent agrees to the voluntary surrender of Respondent's license.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. O'Donnell, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in each of the above cases.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Vice Chairperson Nishek announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:17 a.m.

Executive Session:

At 9:18 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(1) to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS section 26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 2:20 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Nathan M. Hendricks' application for licensure in the "A" General engineering classification pending the submittal of a revised project list (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees performing projects in the broad scope of the "A" General engineering classification (e.g. with additional projects such as bridges, roads, water lines, underground utilities, mass excavation) which may date back beyond the past ten years.

It was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Alejado, and unanimously carried to defer Ryan S. Hoffman's application for licensure in the "B" General building classification pending the submittal of a revised project list (on the Board's form) verifying forty-eight months of his on-site supervision and direction of his own employees constructing buildings from the "ground-up", noting the trades performed in-house and the work or trades subcontracted to other licensed contractors. The Board suggested that Mr. Hoffman may consider amending his application and apply for the C-5 Cabinet, millwork, and carpentry remodeling and repairs classification. Mr. Hoffman stated that he will review his experience and inform the Board in writing should he decide to apply for the C-5 classification.
