## **Government and Legislative Participation & Report**

Legislative Report No. 2 was provided to the Commissioners during the Laws and Rules Review Committee meeting. Specialist Yee reported on the status of the following bills:

Senate Bill No. 2078, S.D. 1 – Relating to condominiums. Clarifies the applicability of §205-4.6, HRS, relating to private restrictions on agricultural uses and activities, to condominium projects on lands classified as agricultural. A hearing before the House Committee on Agriculture is scheduled for tomorrow.

House Bill No. 2401 – Relating to condominiums. It was also reported that staff, in connection with this bill, worked in collaboration with RICO to create a brochure on information for condominium owners. The brochure is available at both the Commission's and RICO's websites.

### **Condominium Laws and Education**
