### **Applications**

Course - "Mediation and Arbitration for Hawaii Real Estate Professionals"; Author/owner: Catherine Lampton; Course Categories: Real Estate Law, Dispute Resolution; Clock Hours: 3

Ms. Catherine Lampton was present to answer any questions. Ms. Lampton introduced herself and stated that she was a realtor in Hawaii for 6 years and is a mediator/facilitator with 10 years of experience.

This course was developed to help licensees become familiar with the UMA (Uniform Mediation Act) and UAA (Uniform Arbitration Act). Also, the course will help licensees understand mediation, arbitration, and litigation, and provide information to licensees that will help them communicate with their client/customer.

Ms. Lampton explained that it is not an exciting subject to teach, but is important. She commented that she tries to incorporate pictures in her slides to keep her students interested.

The Commissioners had questions regarding tracking the use of mediation/arbitration vs. litigation and whether UMA has impacted mediation practices. The Commissioners commented that it is important that licensees consult with their principal brokers or brokers-in-charge regarding any potential involvement in mediation or other dispute resolution.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Klein, seconded by Commissioner Sherley, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Mediation and Arbitration for Hawaii Real Estate Professionals" as a 3 credit-hour continuing education elective course under the course categories: Real Estate Law, Dispute Resolution.

Course – "Code of Ethics: Good for Your Clients and Your Business"; Author/Owner: The CE Shop, Inc.; Provider: The CE Shop, Inc.; Course Categories: Other - Ethics; Clock Hours: 3

Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Sherley, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Code of Ethics: Good for Your Clients and Your Business" as a 3 credit-hour continuing education elective course under the course category: Ethics.

Course – "Did You Serve? Identifying Homebuying Advantages for Veterans"; Author/Owner: The CE Shop, Inc.; Provider: The CE Shop, Inc.; Course Categories: Property Ownership and Development; Clock Hours: 3

Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Sherley, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Did You Serve? Identifying Homebuying Advantages for Veterans" as a 3 credit hour continuing education elective course under the course category: Property Ownership and Development.

Course – "Landlord Tenant Laws 2014"; Author/owner: Hawaii Island REALTORS® and County of Hawaii, Office of Housing and Community Development; Provider: Hawaii Island REALTORS®; Course Categories: Real Estate Law, Property Management, Property Ownership and Development; Clock Hours: 3

Senior Real Estate Specialist Fujimura stated that the County of Hawaii regularly offers a course related to the Hawaii Landlord Tenant Code. This time they are co-authoring the course with the Hawaii Island REALTORS®.

Commissioner Senter questioned the title of the course using "laws" vs. "code" as used in the course agenda. The Commissioners agreed that the author should change the heading on the agenda page to read "Landlord Tenant Laws 2014" to be consistent with the course title.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Klein, seconded by Commissioner Sherley, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Landlord Tenant Laws 2014" as a 3 credit-hour continuing education elective course under the course categories: Real Estate Law, Property Management, Property Ownership and Development.

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Course – "Understanding the Americans with Disabilities Act"; Author/Owner: Scott A. Sherley; Provider: Real Class Inc.; Course Categories: Real Estate Law, Property Management, Property Ownership and Development, and Risk Management; Clock Hours: 3

Commissioner Sherley recused himself from discussion and voting on this matter.

Mr. Sherley explained that this is a newly revised edition of his previous ADA course. This new edition adds in rules under Web Page Accessibility Guidelines, Design Guidelines including Fair Housing Multi-Family Design Guidelines and barrier-free housing. Also added is information on condominium rental pools and service animals. He explained that changes were made to 40-50% of the course because of the new laws going into effect in 2015-2016.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Faulkner, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Understanding the Americans with Disabilities Act" as a 3 credit-hour continuing education elective course under the course categories: Real Estate Law, Property Management, Property Ownership and Development.
