Commissioner Klein inquired if a power point version was available. Senior Specialist Fujimura responded that the power point version is available and is included in the course materials submitted.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Klein, seconded by Commissioner Pang, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) – How Will Industry Changes Affect Your Transactions?" as a three (3) hour credit continuing education elective course, under the course category: Real Estate Law.

Course – "Land Use and Permit Requirements – Residential Zoning Standards, Optionals and Nonconformities;" Author/Owner: Philip Hale Wilia; Provider: Dower School of Real Estate; Course Category: Other – Land Use; Clock Hours: 3

Commissioner Klein noted that the course material was of great relavence, and included helpful visual aids/diagrams. Commissioner Klein also noted that the course was Oahu/Honolulu centric. Commissioner Sherley responded that although it may be Oahu/Honolulu centric, the same course can be researched in light of the different counties and taught on the neighbor islands.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Klein, seconded by Commissioner Lee, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Land Use and Permit Requirements – Residential Zoning Standards, Optionals and Nonconformities" as a three (3) hour credit continuing education elective course, under the course category: Other – Land Use.

Course – "Identifying Trouble Areas in Residential Building & Permitting;" Author/Owner: BIA-Hawaii; Provider: Shari Motooka-Higa; Course Category: Other – Residential Construction Basics; Deferred from 8/12/15 ERC

Chair Cobb noted that decision-making on this course was deferred from the previous Education Review Committee meeting of August 12, 2015 due to clarification of credit course hours, and request for additional course content. Commissioner Sherley noted that the current application should be corrected to reflect four (4) hours vs. five (5) hours as the revised application does not include the non-instructional time previously included. Commissioner Sherley also noted that the standard is three (3) hours per course. Senior Real Estate Specialist Fujimura stated continuing education courses may be approved for a minimum of three (3) hours up to fifteen (15) hours total, at \$50 per hour.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Sherley, seconded by Commissioner Pang, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Identifying Trouble Areas in Residential Building & Permitting" as a four (4) hour credit continuing education elective course, under the course category: Other – Residential Construction Basics.
