- Amend the anticipated initial offering date from August 26, 2015 to a 2016 offer date.
- 2. There are numerous typos and incomplete sentences throughout the course materials which should be corrected.
- 3. A more recent time frame for the claims against real estate licensees be included in the course materials. The ten year review period of 1/1/2001 7/3/2010 is a bit dated.
- 4. There are two section (d)'s included on page 6. Please delete the duplicate section (d).
- Section 1.02: It was suggested that two additional bullet points be added:
 - Failing to notify the commission of a conviction within 30 days
 - b. Failing to notify the commission of a judgment or lien However, as this section is a summary of Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), §467-14, please include HRS, Chapter 436B, which addresses items 5.a. and 5.b. above.
- 6. When referencing the laws and rules, please include Hawaii Revised Statutes or Hawaii Administrative Rules with the chapter number, i.e. Hawaii Administrative Rules, Chapter 99.
