ARELLO Boundaries

ARELLO Annual Conference Reports

The committee acknowledged receipt of the 2018 Annual ARELLO Conference reports submitted by Commissioners Arakaki, Faulkner, Lee, Love and Klein, and Executive Officer Inc.

Commissioner Klein commented that her attendance at the ARELLO Conference was a great experience. The conference provided a lot of information and allowed the participants to discuss concerns, trends, and share perspectives with regulators from across the country. She questioned if others discussed "teams" during their sessions.

It was noted that District 1 discussed teams during their meeting. Executive Officer Ino noted that staff has drafted rules that address teams and will circulate it to the Commissioners for their review. Currently all jurisdictions are struggling with teams and each is tackling it differently. There is currently no general consensus among all of the jurisdictions. Commissioners did note that at least one state had commented that the team leader had to be a broker.

Commissioner Love commented that he found the Commissioners College 102 to be very beneficial. He was able to work with other commissioners and see how others approach issues in their jurisdictions. He noted that it would be great if the Commissioners College were available in an electronic platform.

Commissioner Faulkner commented that during the Commissioners College it is emphasized that the duty of a Commissioner is to protect the public as a whole.

Supervising Executive Officer Fujitani presented Commissioner Faulkner and Commissioner Klein with their Commissioner College completion certificates issued by the Association of Real Estate License Law Officials.
