    - S.B. 725, S.D 1 Act 007 April 15, 2019 GM 1108 Relating to Condominiums (HRS Section 514B-154); Specifies that a condominium association's proxies and ballots may be destroyed ninety days, rather than thirty days, after an association meeting, unless the election is contested, in which case the documents shall be retained until resolution of the contested election
    - S.B. 1288, S.D. 1 Act 014 April 24, 2019 GM 1115 Relating to Condominium Voting (HRS sections 514B-106 and 121); Permits a condominium board to direct the use of an electronic voting device at any condominium association meeting regardless of whether a secret ballot is used or required. Requires a condominium board to take reasonable steps to ensure secrecy and integrity of the votes, and that an audit trail be available after the meeting
    - S.B. 1325 Act 027 April 25, 2019 Relating to Condominiums (HRS Section 514B-3); Clarifies that condominium associations may invest in government money market funds
