Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m., at which time quorum was established.

Chair's Report: The Chair announced that the Commission may move into executive session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with section 92-5(a)(1), HRS, and/or to consult with the Commission's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Commission's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with section 92-5(a)(4), HRS.

Laws and Rules Review Committee

Legislative and Government Participation Report – Supervising Executive Officer Fujitani informed the Commission that SB 770 Relating to Real Estate Licenses and SB 335 Relating to Public Meetings, were passed by the Governor.

Preliminary Rough Draft of Proposed Rule Amendment for Registered Real Estate Schools & Continuing Education Providers – Executive Officer (“EO”) Ino informed the Commission there was currently no language in the rules regarding real estate schools and continuing education providers being able to advertise under a trade name. Staff’s suggestion was to allow real estate schools and continuing education providers be able to use trade names currently registered with BREG and the Commission. EO Ino stated upon Commission’s approval, he would update rules and submit them to the Hawaii Association of REALTORS® and public for comment.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Faulkner, seconded by Commissioner Kyono, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve an amendment to the rules and to set a deadline of 60 day for public comment.

Condominium Review Committee

Senior Condominium Specialist Richelieu stated that Commission approval was required for 2019 & 2020 CAI Hawaii seminar topics and for reimbursement of air and ground travel expenses for August 2019 CAI guest speaker, Julie Adamen.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Lee, seconded by Commissioner Faulkner, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve the August 2019 CAI guest speaker’s air and ground travel reimbursement.

The Executive Officer informed the Commissioners that the information provided to the Commissioners is related only to the issue that is before the Commission for consideration. The other materials submitted are available for the Commissioners review should they desire to review it. If the applicants have an issue, which is personal in nature, they have the right to request that their application be considered in executive session.

Judith A. Rod fka Judith A. Means

Ms. Rod was present and was asked if she wished to have her application for real estate salesperson considered in executive session. She accepted the offer.

Davelyn R. Tengan

Ms. Tengan was present and was asked if she wished to have her preliminary decision application for real estate broker considered in executive session. She accepted the offer.

Executive Session: Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Ginoza, it was voted on and unanimously carried to enter into executive session, pursuant to section 92-5(a)(8), HRS, "To deliberate or make a decision upon a matter that requires the consideration of information that must be kept confidential pursuant to a state or federal law, or a court order." And pursuant to section 92-5(a)(4), HRS, "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities."

Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Kyono, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Licensing –
Applications:

Charlie Min

Mr. Min was present and was asked if he wished to have his application for real estate salesperson considered in executive session. He declined the offer.

Mr. Min stated he was present to answer any questions the Commission may have and that he took responsibility for his actions in the past and that he could have taken himself out of those situations.

Chair Pang asked the applicant what kind of real estate he would practice if he were granted his license. Mr. Min responded he would like to work in real estate full time as he enjoyed being of service to people. He added he would like to be a part of the industry and felt he gained the confidence through his previous employment and stated honesty and integrity were important to him.

Chair Pang inquired why it took so long for the applicant to reacquire his driver's license. Mr. Min answered that he had no explanation and that he procrastinated and has learned from it. Chair Pang asked if the applicant chose not to renew his license or if it was revoked. Mr. Min responded that his license was revoked due to his second DUI offense. Commissioner Faulkner asked how the applicant got around when his license was revoked. Mr. Min answered his friends and family drove him to and from work.

Commissioner Arakaki asked the applicant when he was found guilty of DUI in 2005, how long did he lose his license. Mr. Min stated his license was suspended for 3 months; he did not lose his license. Commissioner Arakaki asked about the applicant's multiple infractions of driving without a valid license calling into question his 2013 infraction. Mr. Min responded he did not recall the 2013 charge. Commissioner Arakaki asked how many times the applicant was convicted of driving without a valid license. Mr. Min answered he was not sure why he didn't follow up and during that time he did not own up to his responsibilities.

Commissioner Klein stated she was struggling with the overarching appearance that the applicant does not follow rules and added that the real estate industry is rule intensive. Mr. Min stated there was nothing he could do about his past and that through his different jobs, he became a leader and a trainer, he has learned from those experiences, and he was aware of what needed to be done. He added he would like to mimic a good broker and that everyone needed to start somewhere.

Commissioner Faulkner stated driving was required in the real estate industry and the applicant's history was concerning.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Klein, it was voted on and unanimously carried to take the matter under advisement.

Executive Session: Upon a motion by Commissioner Arakaki, seconded by Commissioner Faulkner, it was voted on and unanimously carried to enter into executive session, pursuant to section 92-5(a)(8), HRS, "To deliberate or make a decision upon a matter that requires the consideration of information that must be kept confidential pursuant to a state or federal law, or a court order." And pursuant to section 92-5(a)(4), HRS, "To consult with the board's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities."

Upon a motion by Commissioner Faulkner, seconded by Commissioner Kyono, it was voted on and unanimously carried to move out of executive session.

Licensing –

Jack L. Pflum

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Klein moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Jack L. Pflum. Commissioner Ginoza seconded the motion. Commissioners Klein, Ginoza, Arakaki, Faulkner, Kyono, Love, Pang, and Yamane voted aye. Commissioner Lee voted nay. The motion passed.

Damon Mario Quintana

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Ginoza moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Damon Mario Quintana. Commissioner Kyono seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried.

Charlie Min

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Pang moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Charlie Min. Commissioner Kyono seconded the motion. Commissioners Pang, Kyono, Arakaki, Ginoza, Klein, Lee, and Love voted aye. Commissioners Faulkner and Yamane abstained from the vote. The motion passed.

Grace Helene Bradshaw fka Grace Helene Forney

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Arakaki moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Grace Helene Bradshaw, with conditions. Commissioner Ginoza seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried.

The conditional real estate salesperson license is **approved** for the Applicant, subject to the following conditions:

1. That during the term of this conditional license, any violation of the terms and conditions of the conviction in the Justice Court, Flagstaff Precinct, County of Coconino, State of Arizona, including but not limited to compliance with the time payments of fines assessed, shall be grounds for revocation of license.
2. That during the term of this conditional license, any violation of the terms and conditions of the Arizona Department of Real Estate Consent Order dated August 28, 2017, shall be grounds for revocation of license.

3. That failure to provide written notice within 30 days to the licensing authority of any judgment, award, disciplinary sanctions, order, or other determination, which adjudges or finds that the licensee is civilly, criminally or otherwise liable for any personal injury, property damage or loss caused by the licensee's conduct in the practice of the licensee's profession or vocation shall be grounds for revocation of license.
4. That the Applicant shall at all times be associated with and under the direct supervision of a principal broker ("PB") or one or more brokers in charge ("BIC"), for all real estate transactions.
5. That the Applicant shall inform the PB, sole proprietor real estate broker, or BIC of a real estate branch office with whom the Applicant associates that the Applicant holds a conditional real estate salesperson license and may only practice pursuant to certain terms of the conditional license. The Applicant shall present to the Applicant's PB, sole proprietor real estate broker, or BIC of a real estate branch office a copy of the Commission-issued conditional letter. The Applicant shall ensure that the PB, sole proprietor real estate broker, or BIC of a real estate branch office acknowledges the terms of the Applicant's conditional license by signing and returning a signed copy of the conditional letter to the Commission.
6. That **ALL** changes of association and/or employment by Applicant to another real estate broker shall be submitted in writing to the Commission. The new PB, sole proprietor real estate broker, or BIC of a real estate branch office shall acknowledge the terms of the Applicant's conditional license within ten (10) days of the change by submitting a completed Change Form along with a copy of the conditional letter signed by the new PB. Failure to attach the signed conditional letter by the new PB may result in disciplinary action.
7. That the satisfaction of the Applicant from said time payment(s) shall not change any terms of the conditional license.
8. That upon completion of time payment(s) with Justice Court, Flagstaff Precinct, County of Coconino, State of Arizona, and removal of the provisional status of the Applicant's Arizona Real Estate License, the Applicant must submit a written request to the Commission if the Applicant desires to have the conditions removed.

Heather M. Seegmiller

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Kyono moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Heather M. Seegmiller. Commissioner Ginoza seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried.

Steven Patrick De Los Reyes

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Arakaki moved to approve the real estate salesperson's license of Steven Patrick De Los Reyes. Commissioner Kyono seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried.

Judith A. Rod fka Judith A. Means

After review of the information presented by the applicant, Commissioner Ginoza moved to defer the real estate salesperson's application of Judith A. Rod. Commissioner Kyono seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried.
