Developers - Temporary Reenactment of Chapter 514A, HRS

Select development sections of chapter 514A, HRS, were temporarily reenacted until July 1, 2020 to allow developers who missed the first repeal deadline of chapter 514A, HRS, to update and reactivate their reports to make the transfer into chapter 514B, HRS, so that they may <u>legally offer units for sale</u>. Please see the <u>Commission website</u> for more information. The Commission strongly recommends developers submit their reports <u>as soon as possible</u> as the review process can be lengthy. Note that governance sections were not reenacted.
