Final Developer Reminder - The Repeal of Chapter 514A, HRS

The time for developers to update and reactivate their reports to make the transfer into chapter 514B, HRS, so that they may <u>legally offer units for sale</u> is quickly running out, with the extension of selection sections of chapter 514A, HRS, ending on July 1, 2020. The Commission **strongly** recommends developers submit their reports <u>as soon as possible</u> as the review process can be lengthy. Please see the <u>Commission website</u> for more information.
