A brief video regarding the virtual board meeting, including meeting procedures and helpful information regarding how members of the public can participate and interact with the board during the meeting, was played.

Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m., at which time quorum was established by roll call.

This meeting had a physical location and a virtual location. Chair Yamane, Supervising Executive Officer Fujitani and Executive Officer Ino were in attendance in-person at the physical location. All Commissioners were in attendance virtually and confirmed that they were present and alone.

Chair's Report: The Chair announced that the Commission may move into executive session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with section 92-5(a)(1), HRS, and/or to consult with the Commission's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Commission's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with section 92-5(a)(4), HRS.

Commissioner La Costa was excused from the meeting. Prior notification of her non-attendance was received.

The Chair thanked Commissioner Senter for chairing September's meeting and thanked Condominium Education Specialist Sides and Real Estate Specialists Endo and Jackson for staffing the DCCA/Real Estate Branch booth at the Hawaii REALTORS® convention held at the Sheraton Waikiki on September 15 and 16, 2022.

He reminded everyone that real estate renewals will begin October 24, 2022.

Executive Officer's Report: The Commission shall afford all interested persons an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, in writing, on any agenda item and shall provide all interested parties an opportunity to present oral testimony on an agenda item subject to the conditions set forth in section 16-99-83, HAR. The Commission may remove any person or persons, who willfully disrupt a meeting to prevent and compromise the conduct of the meeting in accordance with section 92-3, HRS. Each speaker will be limited to a five-minute time period pursuant with section 16-99-83 (a)(5), HAR.

Executive Officer Ino stated the "Go Live" date for license renewals begin October 24, 2022.

Minutes of Previous Meeting

Upon a motion by Commissioner Emery, seconded by Commissioner Andrews, it was voted on by roll call vote to accept the minutes of the September 23, 2022, meeting. Commissioners Emery, Andrews, Senter, Ginoza, Love and Abe voted aye. Commissioners Yamane and Kyono abstained from the vote. The motion carried.

Commissioner Senter requested an amendment to the executive session minutes. Upon a motion by Commissioner Emery, seconded by Commissioner Andrews, it was voted on and carried by roll call vote to take the matter under advisement.

Licensing – Ratification Upon a motion by Commissioner Andrews, seconded by Commissioner Emery, it was voted on and unanimously carried by roll call vote to ratify the October 21, 2022, Approved Applications List.

Laws and Rules Review Committee

Program of Work FY 2022-2023 Commissioners' Education Program
Regulated Industries Complaint Office

Commissioner Yamane welcomed the representatives from the Regulated Industries Complaint Office (RICO.) The representatives present are Esther Brown, Complaints and Enforcement Officer; Debora Sanehira, Supervising Investigator for the Consumer Resource Center; Sean Kinilau, Investigations Manager and John Hassler, Supervising Attorney.

Esther Brown thanked the Commission for their service and providing RICO the opportunity to share the functions of their office. She stated RICO is the enforcement agency for the professional and vocational licensing areas within DCCA and the Commission is the final decision maker when it comes to disciplining licensees.

RICO has four (4) major sections – 1) consumer resources center, 2) field investigation, 3) prosecutors in the legal section and 4) admin section consisting of the CEO and administrative/support staff.

RICO has several enforcement tools. Ms. Brown advised the chief enforcement tool is education. The RICO website has a vast amount of information for both licensees and the public. The other enforcement tools include complaints processing and official enforcement action.

John Hassler thanked the Commissioners for their service and volunteering their time. He stated the legal arm of RICO basically functions like a small law firm. There are certain attorneys that specialize in specific fields, but most have a general knowledge of the licensing laws. Prior decisions made by the commission are used as guidelines for negotiations and settlement agreements.

Sean Kinilau stated he is the Investigations Manager for the field investigators statewide as RICO has offices on Oahu, Kauai, Maui, Hilo, and Kona. They handle a wide range of complaints. A few examples are unlicensed activity, fraud, and failure to disclose. Mr. Kinilau provided a brief explanation of their process once the complaints are forwarded from the Consumer Resource Center.

Debora Sanehira thanked the Commission for their time and service. She explained that she is with the intake section otherwise known as the Consumer Resource Center. They are the first contact consumers may have with their division. They handle the intake for RICO as well as the Office of Consumer Protection. Their area consists of two (2) sections – 1) Licensing and Business Information Section (LBIS) and 2) Intake.

LBIS provides licensing information to the public along with complaint histories for licenses or business and whether a business is registered with BREG. The intake section is where the complaints are received. Complaints received that are outside of RICO's jurisdiction, will be referred to the appropriate agency. Many times, complaints can be resolved over the phone by speaking to investigators. Ms. Sanehira gave a brief synopsis of their process when a complaint is filed.

Interactive Participation with Organizations – Association of Real Estate License Law Officials – Report on the 2022 ARELLO Annual Meeting

Commissioner Senter stated that participation in the ARELLO meetings are valuable as it provides an opportunity to hear about laws and legal issues occurring in other jurisdictions, possible trends that will eventually make their way to Hawaii and she noted how willing the other commissioners are to share their views and discuss issues. She recommends attending future meetings.

Chapter 99 Rulemaking – Request to Memorialize Repeal and Replace of Ch. 99

Commissioner Andrews asked for clarification of the memorandum. Executive Officer Ino explained at the December 21, 2018 meeting, approval was given to replace Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 99 with three (3) new chapters, namely Chapter 99.1, 99.2 and 99.3, but the repeal of Chapter 99 was not included within the approval.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Yamane, seconded by Commissioner Emery, it was voted on and unanimously carried by roll call vote to approve the simultaneous repeal of Chapter 99 upon the adoption of Chapter 99.1, Chapter 99.2, and Chapter 99.3 Hawaii Administrative Rules.

It was moved by Commissioner Emery to approve the course "Crypto Certified Agent (CCA)", as a 5-credit hour continuing education elective course under the course categories – contracts, investments, risk management, technology, and the licensee, subject to name change to the course with staff approval. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Andrews. The motion was voted on and unanimously carried by roll call vote.
